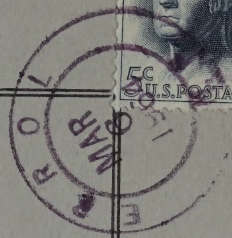

### THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Wentworth Location in the County of Coos in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs :

You are hereby notified to meet at Richard's Turner's Home in said Wentworth Location on Tuesday, the tenth day of March, next at seven of the clock in the evening ,to act upon the following subjects :

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
2. To vote such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.
3. To choose a Delegate to the Constitutional Convention.
4. To vote on the question "Shall sweepstakes tickets be sold in this Town."
5. To see if the Town will vote to spray for insects, and appropriate money for the same.
6. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to take whatever steps necessary to acquire, maintain and operate a Town Dump.
7. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to appropriate for Town Dump.
8. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to appropriate for White Mountain Region Association.
9. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to draw upon the unexpended funds of the Town for the purpose of paying the Town Taxes for the year 1964.
10. To transact any other business that may legally come before the meeting.
