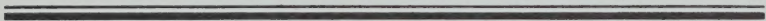

WARRANT for the ANNUAL TOWN MEETING

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Webster in the County of Merrimack in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at Grange Hall in said Webster on Tuesday, the 12th day of March, next at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.
3. To raise and appropriate such sums of money as may be necessary for maintenance of highway and bridges.
 - a. Summer Maintenance
 - b. Winter Maintenance
 - c. Tar Roads
 - d. General Expense of Highway Department
4. To raise and appropriate the sum of \$581.12 for class V road construction.
5. To raise and appropriate such sums of money as may be necessary for Public Welfare.
 - a. Town Poor
 - b. Old Age Assistance
6. To raise and appropriate such sums of money as may be necessary for the support of the Town Library.
7. To raise and appropriate such sums of money as may be necessary for Patriotic purposes.
 - a. Old Home Day
 - b. Memorial Day
8. To raise and appropriate such sums of money as may be necessary for the support and maintenance of the Hy-Mar Fire Department, including forest fires.

9. To see what sum the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the care of cemeteries.

10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$91.20 for use in connection with the state program for the eradication of White Pine Blister Rust.

11. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$29.00 toward the operating deficit of the Concord Hospital this being based on the number of patients admitted from Webster.

12. To authorize and empower the Board of Selectmen to borrow for the Town, by issuance of notes, a sum not exceeding \$50,000.00 in anticipation of taxes for the year 1968, said notes payable from said taxes within one year of issuance, and to authorize the Board of Selectmen to determine the rate of interest on such notes and to provide for the sale thereof.

13. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$300.00 for the maintenance of the playground.

14. To see if the Town will vote to raise \$25.00 to be expended in cooperation with the New Hampshire Forestry and Recreation Commission for the opening and maintaining of the old roads and old trails for forest fire protection. The New Hampshire Forestry and Recreation Commission to provide a matching sum.

15. To authorize and instruct the Selectmen to carry out the purchase of the Grange Hall of the Daniel Webster Grange, as voted under Article #19 of the warrant for 1967, at such time as the seller presents a satisfactory survey of the lot, by a registered surveyor, and the Selectmen with the advice of Town counsel are reasonably satisfied with the sellers title.

16. To see what sum of money the Town wishes to raise and appropriate for the rent of Grange Hall for year 1968 and Town Meeting 1969.

17. Resolved, that the Town continue the practice of snow plowing private driveways provided that such service shall be performed at times and in a manner always subordinate and incidental to the regular winter maintenance of the public town high-

ways and that the Board of Selectmen be authorized and directed to institute a scale of rates for such service based upon the cost of service as determined by them and the road agent be authorized to give priority to occupations directly concerned with the public health and safety.

18. To see if the Town of Webster shall adopt the Australian type of ballot voting.

19. To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.
