TOWN WARRANT

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Richmond in the County of Cheshire in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at Town Hall in said Richmond on Tuesday, the eleventh day of March, next at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

- 1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
- 2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.
- 3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for highways and bridges, or take any action thereon.
- 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for winter maintenance, or take any action thereon.
- 5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for cemeteries, or take any action thereon.
- 6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for the Library, or take any action thereon.
- 7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for the Fire Department, or take any action thereon.
- 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for Police work, or take any action thereon.
- 9. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for relief, or take any action thereon.

- 10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$40.00 for Publicity.
- 11. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$105.00 for the Elliot Community Hospital.
- 12. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for brush removal, or take any action thereon.
- 13. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate a sum not exceeding \$7500.00 for the purpose of making improvements to the following Class V roads within the Town;

Tucker Hill, Barrus Hill, Bennett Hill, and the road leading from Edward Martin's to the intersection of the road leading past Lane's Mill.

Such sums to be raised through the issuance of bonds or notes under and in compliance with the provisions of chapter 83, Laws of 1951 as amended by chapter 31, Laws of 1953, and to authorize the Selectmen to determine the date and place of payment of such bonds or notes and to determine the rate of interest thereon, and to take such other steps as may be necessary to negotiate such bonds or notes as shall be to the best interests of the Town of Richmond.

- 14. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$488.62, the State to contribute \$3257.45 for T.R.A., so called.
- 15. To see if the Town will vote to allow a discount of two per cent on all taxes paid in full within 30 days of invoice.
- 16. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money for use of the Town in anticipation of taxes.
- 17. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for a War Memorial.
- 18. To see if the Townspeople will vote for a Town Beach for the Townspeople and guests under the rules of the Selectmen, Recreation Committee and Police Department.
- 19. To see if the Town will vote to change the time of the annual Town Meeting.

- 20. To hear reports of agents, committees, etc., heretofore chosen, or take any action thereon.
- 21. To take any other legal action that may come before the meeting.

Forest Fire Prevention Is Everybody's Business

New Hampshire faces a continuing challenge in its forest fire problem — 97 per cent of all our forest fires being man-caused and preventable — a serious indictment of interest in our own welfare and that of our neighbor. Both the State and the towns are striving diligently to effectively meet the challenge through education of the public to the threat fire presents to our woodlands; by maintaining a well trained corps of wardens and deputy wardens in every community. Carelessness and perverseness, however, continue to be the big hurdles.

Thoughtlessly discarded lighted cigars, cigarettes and matches from moving vehicles by hikers, hunters and fishermen; careless burning of debris during hazardous periods in dangerous locations; illegal burning, improperly extinguished debris, camp and cook fires —all result in serious loss of property, disruption of industry and farm work and unnecessary expenditure of town and state funds.

To meet the challenge successfully, the state, your community and your local forest fire warden need YOUR thoughtful and cooperative effort — The rules are simple.

- If you do burn, be sure to secure a written permit from your local forest fire warden when the ground is not covered with snow. Permits are required for open debris fires, home incinerators, outdoor fire places and camp fires. Your warden is instructed to permit burning if weather conditions, site and type of burning are safe.
- Be sure that all lighted material cigars, cigarettes and matches — are completely out before discarding them. Use ash trays in automobiles.
- Make certain that your debris, camp and cook fires are completely out before leaving them.
- Insist that others be careful and comply with burning requirements.
- 5. Call the warden promptly when fire is detected and aid him to extinguish it.

REMEMBER — the fire you prevent might be the one which could burn YOUR property.

Your officers attended meetings of Police Schools held in both Swanzey and Keene.

During the past year your police department has been able to secure uniforms and some equipment through the generosity of the Richmond Fire Company.

We have investigated reports of suspicious individuals at the pond and other localities and 17 break-ins. During the summer we patrolled the Green Woods Road twice a week. We recovered a stolen boat and transported suspicious individuals over the state line.

During the school year an officer has stood duty at the Four Corners twice a day to protect our school children.

To the inhabitants of the School District in the town of Richmond qualified to vote in district affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said district on the eleventh day of March, 1958, at one o'clock in the afternoon to act upon the following subjects:

- 1. To choose a Moderator for the ensuing year.
- 2. To choose a Clerk for the ensuing year.
- 3. To choose a member of the School Board for the ensuing three years,
 - 4. To choose a Treasurer for the ensuing year.
- 5. To hear the reports of Agents, Auditors, Committees, or Officers chosen, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 6. To choose Agents, Auditors, Committees in relation to any subject embraced in this warrant.
- 7. To see what sum of money the district will raise and appropriate for the support of schools, for the salaries of school district officials and agents, and for the payment of statutory obligations of the district, and to authorize the application against said appropriation of such sums as are estimated to be received from the state equalization fund together with other income; the school board to certify to the selectmen the balance between the estimated revenue and the appropriation, which balance is to be raised by taxes by the town.
- 8. To see if the district will vote to authorize the school board to make a contract with the Union School District of Keene for high school instruction for 1958-1959 at a rate of four hundred forty-nine dollars (\$449.00) per pupil.
- 9. To see if the district will authorize the school board to make application for and to receive, in the name of the district, such advances, grants-in-aid or other funds for educational purposes as may now or hereafter be forthcoming from the U.S. Government and/or State Agencies.
- 10. To see what sum of money the district will raise and appropriate for the purpose of erecting a two room school and for the further purpose of furnishing the same with equipment of a lasting character; and in order to provide funds for such purposes, to authorize the school board to issue and sell notes or bonds in the name of and on the credit of the district under and in accordance

with the Municipal Finance Act, and any amendments thereto; and to delegate to the school board authority to fix the date, maturities, denominations, the interest rate, or discount rate in the case of notes, and to provide for the sale thereof, and to take such other action in respect thereto as may be necessary or advisable, all in accordance with the laws of the State of New Hampshire.

The conclusion reached in last year's report that enrollments in the first four grades would tax to capacity the facilities of the North Richmond School for this school year and for next year has proved to be correct. Thereafter, for the years 1959 through 1963, the above table indicates that the enrollments in the first four grades will be progressively 34, 29, 24 and 19. If the North Richmond

mond School continues to house the first four grades, the reduced numbers of pupils will be more adequately accommodated.

Richmond is still faced with the problem of how to plan wisely for the future. Advice from the State Department of Education showed the futility of spending the \$2,500 appropriated at the last annual meeting for improvement of the North Richmond School. To do the job thoroughly as it should be done would require a much more substantial sum.

A new two room school for Richmond would be an expensive undertaking. The school district's latest assessed valuation as equalized is \$748,027. The long-term borrowing capacity of the district would be 4.0% of this assessed valuation as equalized or \$29,921. With special permission granted after a state investigation this amount could be increased to 6.0% of the assessed valuation as equalized or \$44,882. The lower figure is too small for the cost of really adequate construction of a wooden two room building. It is conceivable that it could be built for the larger figure.

However, it is questionable if a new two room school is the ultimate answer to Richmond's problem. The maintenance of such a school would be entirely different from that of the present one room school. The expense of operation would be considerably more. Budgetwise, the cost would probably exceed that of sending all of Richmond's pupils to Swanzey and Winchester. Educationwise, there really is no comparison. The advantages to be gained in sending all the pupils to Swanzey and Winchester are far greater than those to be derived by a new school building in Richmond.

It would be to Richmond's advantage to conduct a comprehensive study of the possibility of the formation of a cooperative school district with the other towns in this supervisory union. This perhaps could be the most sensible approach to be followed. Most certainly all avenues should be explored before any substantial sum of money is spent on something which later would be found to be entirely inadequate for Richmond's needs.

In conclusion, I wish to express my appreciation to the teachers, pupils and parents, the School Board and the patrons of our school for their cooperation.
