1. The Dutch gender system is extremely non-transparent and asymmetrical and hence particularly difficult to acquire, especially in comparison with many other European languages (e.g. Romance languages).

2. Native Dutch speakers can rapidly use common, but not neuter gender-marking, to facilitate language comprehension by predicting upcoming words. Furthermore, gender processing is speeded up for highly predictable nouns.

3. Despite the skewed distribution and the unreliability of gender agreement cues in the input, native Dutch speakers have a very stable representation of gender, as revealed by a robust effect in response to both common and neuter gender violations.

4. Input frequency, cue reliability and amount of exposure are crucial in the acquisition of a non-transparent and asymmetrical gender system, particularly at later stages in life. This is clear from the fact that the relatively frequent and reliable common gender can eventually be acquired, but the use and processing of the less frequent and unreliable neuter gender category remains problematic even after years of exposure.

5. Late Polish L2 learners of Dutch cannot pre-activate L2 gender information to facilitate comprehension, but, given enough time and exposure, highly proficient L2 learners are able to process and re-analyse violations of common gender-marking in a way similar to native speakers.

6. L1 transfer of lexical gender categories to the L2 does not take place when the mother tongue is typologically different from the second language.

7. L2 proficiency is at the core of second language research. It is therefore remarkable to see that this aspect does not always receive the attention it should receive.
