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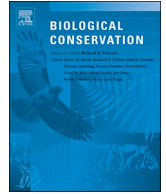

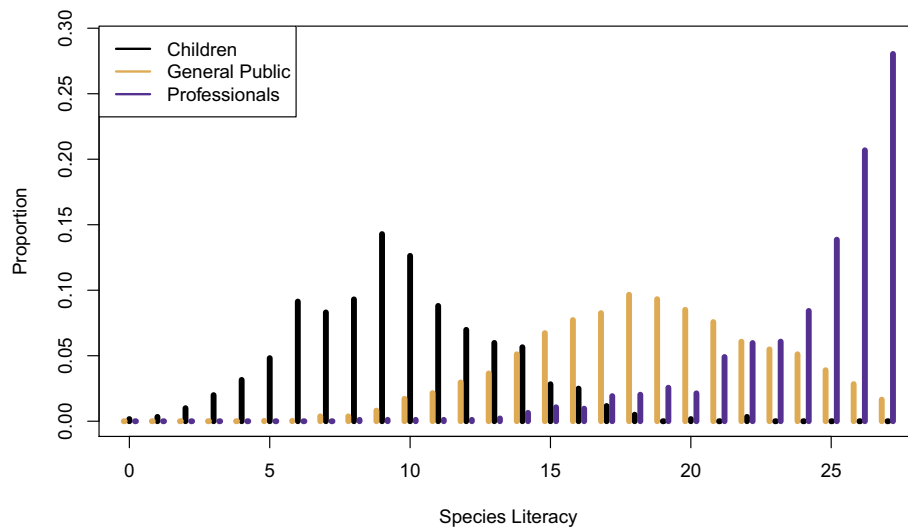


Fig. 3. Distribution of species literacy in the three target groups (i.e. the proportion of each target group achieving a certain identification score).

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
