President's Special Recognitions

Gunnell Jorden, as a young girl, emigrated with her parents from Sweden to Canada. After having taken work at Canadian Nazarene College, Northwest Nazarene College and Pasadena College, she received her B.A. degree from Olivet in 1959. Prior to this she had served as the wife of a pastorprofessor for 22 years.

Following the untimely death of her husband, Dr. Eric Jorden, Mrs. Jorden enrolled at the University of Oregon and received the Master of Arts degree in 1966, the year she joined Olivet's faculty.

In addition to her involvements in several professional organizations such as the Modern Language Association and the National Council for Teachers of English, Mrs. Jorden has conducted two study tours for Olivet students to England and Scotland. For many years she has served on the board of College Church, and for five years taught the College Senior Sunday school class.

As a speaker, Mrs. Jorden is in demand for laymen's retreats, women's clubs and pastor's wives retreats. In July 1978 she was a featured speaker at the International Nazarene Laymen's Conference in San Diego. In the summer of 1979 she spoke at two of the regional WILCON sessions for wives of Nazarene ministers.

Mrs. Jorden has two daughters, both involved in Nazarene higher education. Mrs. Marcia Olsen is the wife of the business manager at Northwest Nazarene College, and Kathryn Jorden is a teacher of English and Teacher Placement Director at Point Loma College.

Pat Duncan is a congenial director of financial aid who manages what a federal auditor called "the most effective and complete office I have ever seen." Through thousands of personal interviews each year with students, parents and pastors, Mr. Duncan deals with intimate and individual financial details of family life in a manner that is both personable and confidential. He is generous in distributing aid to those in need, and vigorous in obtaining additional grant and loan money.

The Duncan family came to Olivet from Waverly, Ohio, in 1976. Pat was our chapel minister of music, and was involved in recruiting students through a weekend ministry of music in churches. While he was an executive with Mead Paper Company, he felt God was calling him to a new area of ministry.

His family is deeply involved at Olivet. His

wife Shirley graduated *summa cum laude* and is now in graduate studies here. Their son John was student body president, and is now a law student at Northwestern University. Their daughter Brenda is now a junior, and their son Ron is a former student and employee of the college.

Pat has been successful in gaining increased funds for Olivet students. Last April he filed a timely appeal regarding our allocation of aid funds, and gained a 20 percent increase for this fall. The total financial aid program of grants, loans and scholarships has risen from \$2.1 million in 1976 to \$5.2 million in 1981.

His effectiveness may be in his feeling of ministry to the 2,000 families a year he serves, each with unique situations, as he helps them cope with financial needs and gain an increasing sense of responsibility for financing "An Education with a Christian Purpose."
