FAHRENHOLZ, AMELIA (FEABEALKORN) (MIELKE)

Amelia (Feabealkorn) Fahrenholz was born in Schoenfelt, Germany, February 28, 1861, a daughter of Michael and Louise Faebealkorn, who were natives of Brantenberg, Germany. Amelia attended the rural school in Germany, until she was fourteen years old, and then helped her parents with their work at home. In 1884 the Faebealkorn family came to America and came directly to Stearns County, and settled on a farm near Fair Haven.

This farm the Faebealkorns improved and farmed until their death. Michael Feabealkorn, the father of Amelia, died August 21, 1932 at the age of 85, and the mother, Louise Feabealkorn, died July 26, 1912 at the age of 75 years.

Amelia Feabealkorn was married to William Mielke at the Evangelical Lutheran Church in St. Cloud, March 7, 1885. The marriage was performed by Rev. G. J. Schmit. William Mielke was a son of Christian and Mary Mielke, who also were natives of Pummer, Germany, and came to America in 1883, and settled in St. Cloud, Minnesota.

To William and Amelia (Faebealkorn) Mielke were born three children: Anna, Mrs. August Haift, of Kimball, Minnesota; Edith, Mrs. Leonard Spaulding of Waite Park, Minnesota; William Mielke Junior of St. Cloud; William Milke Senior died June 20, 1896, at the age of 43 years.

On September 19, 1897 Amelia (Faebealkorn) Mielke was married to Godfried Fahrenholz who was a native of Germany. Godfried Fahrenholz worked for the Great Northern Railway Company, for a few years, and then moved on a farm in 1915. At the end of four years they returned to St. Cloud, and retired.
