Patrick Henry Flyn was born in Huntington, Quebec, Canada, on October 24, 1862.

In 1855, he came to Iowa with his parents, and located on a farm between Marble Rock and Rockwell.

In 1882, Patrick Flynn was married in Iowa to Georgianna Barragg. She died October 5, 1905. Six sons were living in 1932. They were John and LeRoy of St. Paul, Carl and Ray of Chicago, Victor of Morris, and Weldon of Minneapolis.

Patrick Flynn came to Sauk Centre many years ago and moved away in 1921. Later he returned for a year. In November 1930, while in Sauk Centre he was taken ill with double pneumonia, but recovered. He left Sauk Centre in July, 1931, and went to St. Paul to live.

On March 18, 1932, Patrick Flynn again was taken ill with pneumonia. He died on March 28, 1932. He is buried in the Cavalry Cemetery in Sauk Centre from the Lady of Our Angels Church.
