Julius Kindler was born in Baden, Germany, March 12, 1848.

He received common and military schooling in Germany and came to America in 1866. Settled in St. Cloud and learned harness and leather trade from Peter Hansen. Mr. Hansen was a veteran harness maker of United States Government service during the Civil War.

In 1869 he married Katherine Rausch of St. Martin. They were married at St. Martin. Miss Rausch was a native of Germany also, and came to America when she was four years old. The same year Mr. Kindler established a business of his own on the same site where the present one stands. He operated this business successfully and erected the present building in 1886 and managed the establishment until his death in 1899.

To this union there was born three sons, John, Joeseph and Charles. John and Joseph succeded their father until Joeseph's death in 1911, then John operated the business and employed Charles as an apprentice.
