NOHNER, JACOB

Jacob Nohner a native son of Stearns County was born in Eden Valley, Minnesota, July 8, 1887 a son of Peter and Catherine(Hammes) Nohner. Peter Nohner came to America from Germany when he was eight years old and attended the country grade school in Eden Lake Township, and after completing his school years he worked on his fathers' farm, and after a number of years his father retired, and then sold the land to Peter Nohner which he operated until his son Jacob Nohner was finished with his grade school education, and then Jacob Nohner operated this farm, keeping this land in possession of the Nohner's for three generations. In 1908 Jacob Nohner quit farming and came to St. Cloud, Minnesota, and was employed by the Great Northern Railway Company.

Jacob Nohner was married in Eden Valley, Minnesota September 1st, 1908 to Leana De Morrett a daughter of Henry and Mary De Morrett, both parents were natives of Germany. The father, Henry De Morrett, came from Christnach, Germany, and the mother coming from Luxemburg, Germany. The De Morrett family settled in Dakota County on November 18, 1883, and then later moved to Stearns County and settled on a farm near Eden Valley, Minnesota. The marriage of Jacob Nohner to Leana De Morrett was performed by Father Peiffer pastor of the Catholic Church of Eden Valley, Minnesota.

To Jacob and Leana (DeMorrett) Nohner were born eight children:- Seven of which are living: James Mathew Nohner died March 11, 1928. Veronica, Mrs. Bernard V. Danzl, of St. Cloud, Minnesota, Mildred, Mrs. Elroy Erie, of Waite Park, Minnesota. Edmund Nohner of St. Cloud, Minnesota, Irene, Mrs. Eugene Mertés of South St. Paul, Minnesota.
