Ella Elizabeth Barnard was born at Chestfield, N. H. on January 16, 1848.

When she was sixteen years of age she came to Stearns County (1864) and lived with her brother, Stephen G. Barnard, southeast of Sauk Centre.

November 3, 1866 she was married to William Pangburn a returned veteran of the Civil War. The ceremony was performed at her home by Marvin D. Taylor, Justice of the Peace, and cousin of the bride.

Ten children were born to Wm. and Ella E. (Barnard) Pangburn, three of whom died in infancy. The surviving children are: Minnie (Mrs E. Barnard) living in Portland, Oregon, Frank T., of Sauk Centre, Ralph of Sauk Centre, Jessie (Mrs. Michaelson) of Portland Oregon, Leon, of Eckleson N. D.; and Maude.

Ella E. (Barnard) Pangburn went thru the vigors of pioneer life and raised an excellent family. She was a member of the Methodist Church.

Ella E. (Barnard) Pangburn died on October 1, 1930.
