SCHUSTER, FRED G.

Fred Schuster was born January 4, 1867 in Bremen, Indiana, son of George Conrad Schuster who came to this country about 1845 from Germany. He came to this country as a missionary from Germany, coming directly to Bremen, Indiana, where he founded the first German Lutheran Mission, which is still existing, after nearly a hundred years. Fred G. was one of a family of six children, he had four sisters and one brother. His sisters are, Rose, who is married and lives in Hutchinson, Minnesota; Mary, married to Dr. H. W. Laniger, of Arlington Heights, Illinois; Matilda, now lives in Elmhurst, Illinois, she is married to F. H. Hield; Elizabeth, who lives in Bremen, Indiana. His brother is also in Bremen, Indiana.

All of Fred G. Schuster's schooling was received in Bremen, Indiana. He went ot school until he reached the eighth grade. As a youth he learned the trade of a sheet metal worker, which trade he has followed ever since.

In 1890 Fred Schuster was married to Milly Miller in Sioux City, Iowa. To them were born eight children, Clara, who is now in Chicago, Illinois; Ella and Laura both in Chicago; Emily, in Burke Hill, Illinois; Maria, in Sauk Rapids, Minnesota; Fredrick, in Bunker Hill, Illinois; and Carl and Emma, in Saint Cloud.

Mrs. Fred Schuster died January 2, 1934 in Saint Cloud, Minnesota at the age of sixty-two years. Mr. (Fred) Schuster is now retired and makes his home with his daughter Emma in Saint Cloud.
