VAN HEEL, FRANK

Frank Van Heel, son of one of our pioneer families, was born near Freeport, Stearns County, September 14, 1887. He was a son of Andrew and Gertrude (Woeste) Van Heel. The father come from Holland, and the mother was a native of Carver County, Minnesota.

Andrew Van Heel came to America with his parents when he was a small boy about three years, and they settled in Carver County on a farm, where he was raised to manhood. When Andrew was about eighteen years old he came to Stearns County and started farming, in Krain Township and continued to farm all his life.

Frank Van Heel attended the village school in Freeport, until he was about fourteen years old, and then worked for his father on the farm until time he started farming for himself.

After a few years as a farmer, Frank left and came to St. Cloud, where he followed the granite trade in which he is engaged at the present time.

Frank Van Heel was married to Clara Fischer, June 8th, 1909 at Freeport, Minnesota, by Rev. L. Kaefler. Clara Fischer was a daughter of Moritz and Maggie (Kvell) Fischer, neighbors of the Van Heel family near Freeport, Minnesota

To Frank and Clara (Fischer) Van Heel were born three children: Loretta, was born December 6, 1911, Alvina, was born June 5, 1914, and Irene, was born May 27, 1916, all living at home.

On March 8, 1918, Mrs Clara (Fischer) Van Heel died at the age of 28 years. Her body was laid to rest in the Freeport Catholic Cemetery.

On September 2, 1924 Frank Van Heel married Cecelia Kockler who was a daughter of Nicholas and Barbara Kockler pioneer residents of St.
