Axel T. Young was born in Christiana, Norway, on November 8, 1877, son of Esther and John Young. As a youth Axel attended the public schools in Norway for seven years.

At the age of twenty three years Axel came to the United States. After his arrival in New York he came directly to Saint Cloud, Minnesota. Here he was employed by Mathew Breen in the granite quarry. In 1910 Axel organized the Great Northern Granite Company, which he operated until 1915. Shortly after he entered the United Granite Company as a partner, where he has been since.

Axel Young was married December 10, 1910, to Hulda Anderson a native of Sweden. The ceromony was performed at the Salem Lutheran Church in Saint Cloud. Axel and Hulda (Anderson) Young make there home at 817-13 Avenue South.
