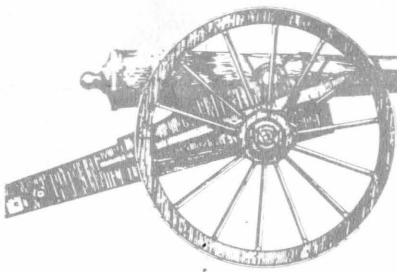


Dear Dr. Murphy:
