Achieving quality is a continuous process starting with finding problems, fixing




Figure 1: High-quality health system framewor

GLOBAL CONGESTIVE HEART FAILURE (G-CHF) STUDY The G-CHF Investigators Meeting, Munich

Heart failure (HF) is a rapidly increasing disease worldwide; there is no global HF study that documents demographics, socioeconomic, clinical factors and outcomes in all parts of the world. Global Congestive Heart Failure (G-CHF) Study is a prospective registry of heart failure with over 32 participating countries. AKU is a National Coordinating Center for this study as well as a recruiting site, the other site being Rawalpindi Institute of Cardiology. The recruitment in G-CHF is well ahead of target in Pakistan and has 421 participants till date. On August 25, 2018, a Global Investigators Meeting for G-CHF was held in Munich, Germany where representatives from all the countries met and discussed study's progress and milestones. Investigators from AKU included Dr. Khawar Kazmi as site-PI and National Lead for Pakistan, Ms. Azmina Artani and Dr. Abid Laghari as co-PIs. The group is dedicated to achieve the next milestone in G-CHF, i.e. initiation of its sub-study in Pakistan by next vear.
