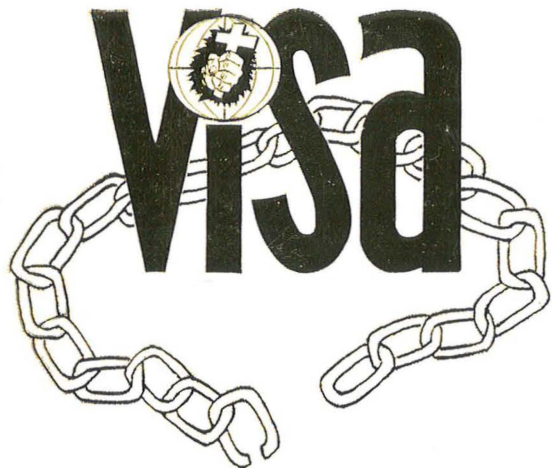
# What is VISA?
