

Headlines: Oregon

- As of July 24th: Children age 5 and up are required to wear a mask, face shield or face covering. Face coverings are now required when exercising indoors, plus outdoors when you can't physically distance.
- July 23rd: The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) announced that \$9.4 million in CARES Act funds will be provided more than 170 Oregon Community Based Organizations, including the WOU Foundation, to help respond to COVID-19.
- Testing Locator: OHA has partnered with Google to help individuals find local information about where testing is available. By entering an address, ZIP code, or city, a list of available nearby testing locations is automatically populated. This location system is offered in both English and Spanish and provides information regarding symptoms, costs, and interpreting test results.

Cumulative Confirmed Cases in Oregon by Age, as of July 26th, 2020



Vaccine Update:

Four companies have vaccine trials entering Phase III (effectiveness tests in large study populations): Moderna (National Institutes of Health), AstraZeneca (University of Oxford), Sinopharm (Wuhan Institute of Biological Products), and Sinovac (Sinovac Biotech).

Top 5 Countries Leading in Most Confirmed COVID-19 Cases as of 8/2/2020:

1) USA: 4,523,888 cases, 2) Brazil: 2,662,485 cases, 3) India: 1,750,723 cases,

4) Russia: 850,870 cases 5) South Africa: 503,290 cases

New COVID-19 Hotspots:

- Mexico has passed 40,000 COVID-19 deaths, making it the fourth highest death toll in the world.
 - In the past week, Peru has had over 4,000 confirmed cases per day.
- Germany has entered its second wave this week as confirmed cases have increased to 800 per day from 500 per day.
