A Concurrent Resolution drafted and passed by the members of
The Association For Advancement of American Indians of North
Dakota, June 22, 1953.

WHEREAS: The Indian members shall be free from the arbitrary
powers and paternalistic Indian Bureau at the earliest possible
date.

WHEREAS: The Indian members shall use their own judgment in
deciding the use of their own money derived from the taken area
of the Oahe Dam Reservoir.

WHEREAS: The Indian members shall repeatedly oppose communistic
group system of enterprise in a long range rehabilitation program
submitted and requested by the Standing Rock Tribal negotiators
to prolong the life of the Indian Reservation System.

Be it Resolved by the Senate of the United States, The House of
Representatives concurring therein, That the Congress of the
United States respectfully and earnestly grant: The American
Indians the freedom of thought and choice.
