For his visit with Republican Congressman Usher L. Burdick in Washington Frank Heart shows up in the full regalia of his office as one of the Chiefs of the Three Affiliated Tribes. With him, to discuss with Burdick some of the problems of Indians on North Dakota's Fort Berthold Reservation are, from the left, John Wilkinson and Carl Whitman. At Burdick's left on the picture is B. J. Youngbird, Chairman of the Stockmen's Association at Fort Berthold. Much of the discussion was carried on in the Sioux language, which Mr. Burdick speaks fluently.
