Fragment is of facial features from a large figurine. Whole nose w/ applied nostrils is preserved... + whole mouth + chin. Mouth consists of both upper + lower lips + perhaps upper teeth, yet none are distinct w/ incised or excised lines... only a bar that looks as if it is a row of teeth. There are 2 holes

The item is: not eroded - slightly - moderately - very - extremely eroded. on the side that appear to have been excised out to create

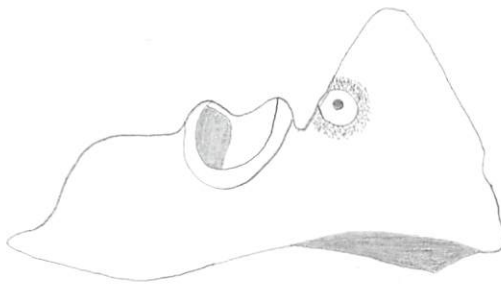
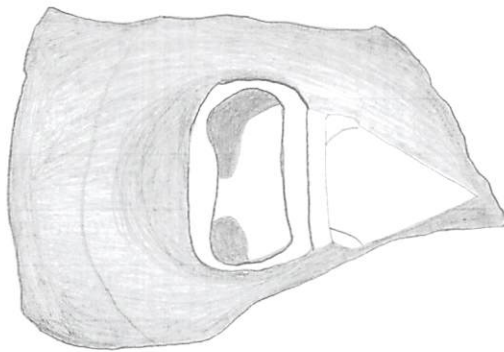

space to make the mouth look open. Or perhaps the look of incised teeth(?) Nostrils on nose are applied... appear similar to an →

earspool w/ an incised hole in the middle. The chin is rounded + smoothed + a little extends down to a neck area. No other facial features are preserved. Face is overall, smoothed. Nose as a whole may have been appliqued on... but the area around the nose is where this fragment broke off... so its a little difficult to see the connection.
