The data for this paper were collected by Dr. Haeberlin during the years 1916 and 1917. The work was interrupted by illness followed by the author's death in 1918. The field notes were turned over to Mrs. Erna Gunther Spier who arranged the matter for printing. The material relates primarily to the Snohomish, Snoqualmie and Nisqually though some observations upon the Skykomish and Skagit tribes are interwoven. The paper contains more than one hundred fifty footnotes, furnishes a bibliography, and employs the Boas system of phonetics.
