SUPPLEMENTARY FILE 1: FAAK CAVE CATALOGUE

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This catalogue presents descriptions on 16 diagnostic shards: rims (11), decorated rims (3), and decorated body shards (2) from the Faak Cave. It provides details on each rim consistent with standard analytical methods for documenting rim forms (Best 1985; Galle and Neiman 2016; Rice 1987). The catalogue features macroscopic observations and descriptions including:


- photographs
- reference and excavation details
- lip profile—round, round-pointed, pointed, flat, flat-horizontal
- rim direction—direct, incurving, outcurving, inverted, everted
- key measurements—weight, thickness at lip and rim
- fabric type—fine, medium-fine, medium, medium-coarse, coarse
- preservation condition—fresh, average, worn, very worn
- firing—even, uneven
- color—Munsell (2000) reference and color
- surface treatment—none, (description of applied color).

Photographs of rim forms show interior surface view (left), exterior surface view (center), and rim-lip profile (right). Rim lips are oriented to the top of photographs.
