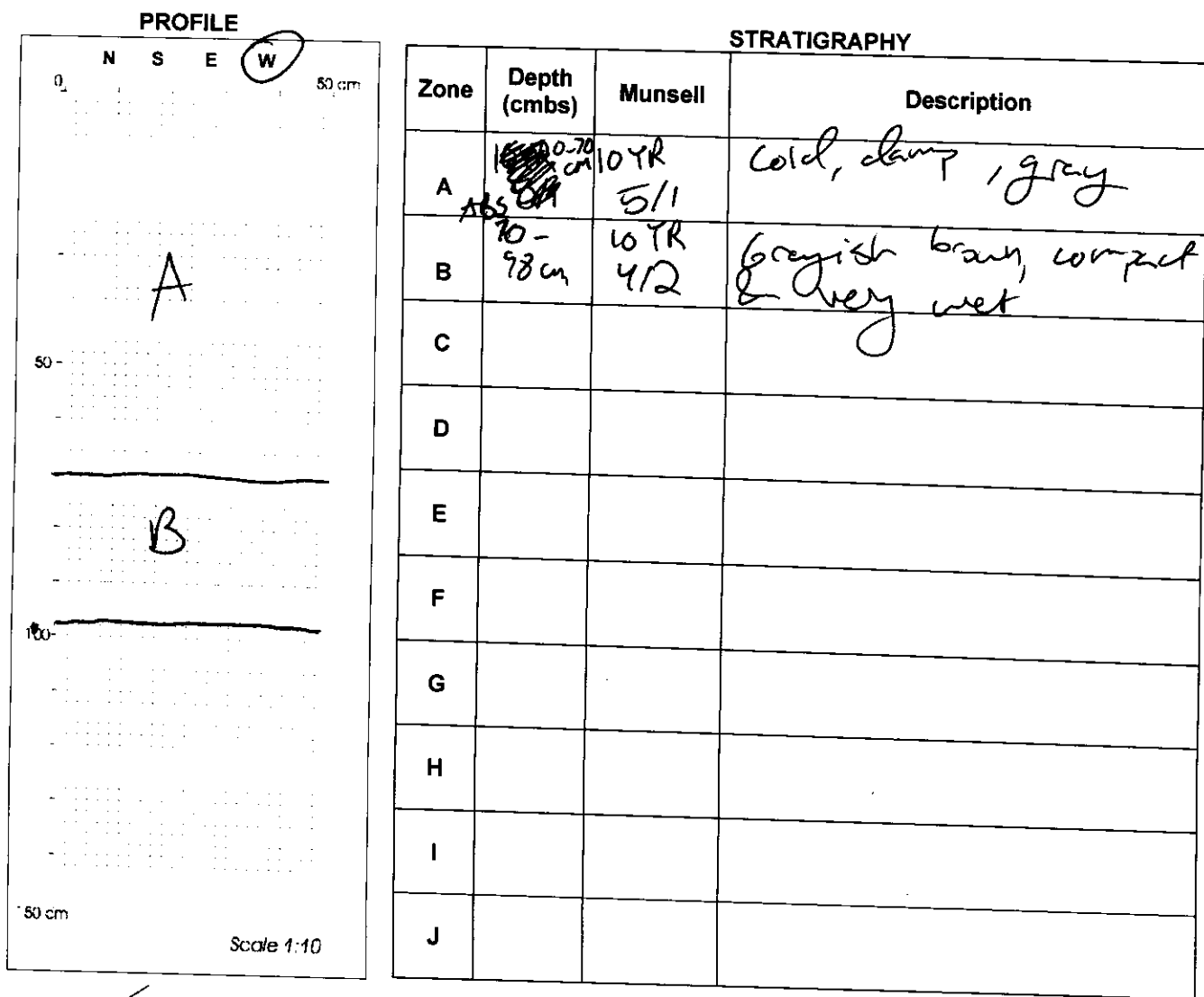

We moved 40 cm west when hole was barely 5 cm deep because of a large root

- Chumpy soil & lots of root inclusions  
- we had to move again 27.5 cm east because of a much larger root

- Small clumps of soil in this hole, not very deep  
- Charcoal & shell found at approx 27 cm deep  
- Compacted sand found at approx. 30 cm deep

- At around 88 cm, soil is chumpy & feels very clumpy  
- Soil is very compacted & feels & looks kind of like clay

- stopped at 98 cm because of harder layer

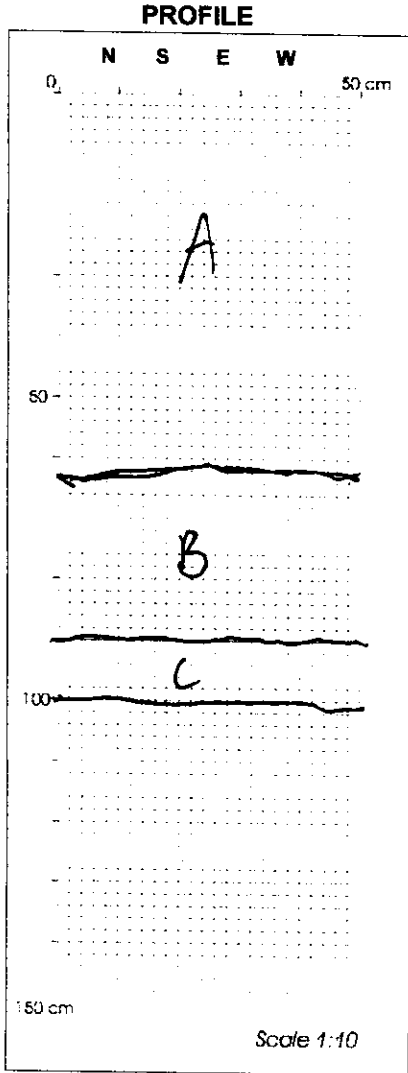

- Found pottery at about 61 cmbs
- Also found some bone, also at 61 cmbs, continuing to find charcoal.
- Possible soil change at around 70 cm, feels cold and stiff.
- Large piece of charcoal found at same depth.
- Past 80 cm finding a few pieces of shell
- Soil starting to feel wet and a little more compact at 99/100 cm
- Charcoal found nearly all the way through

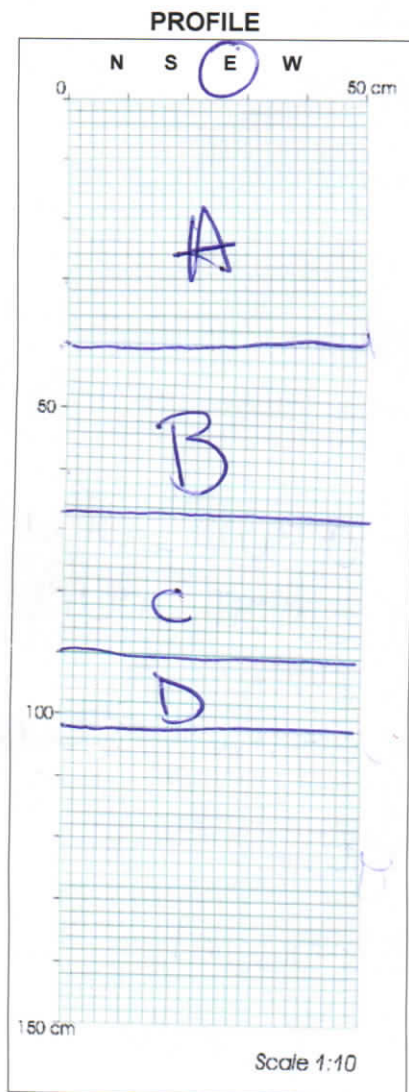

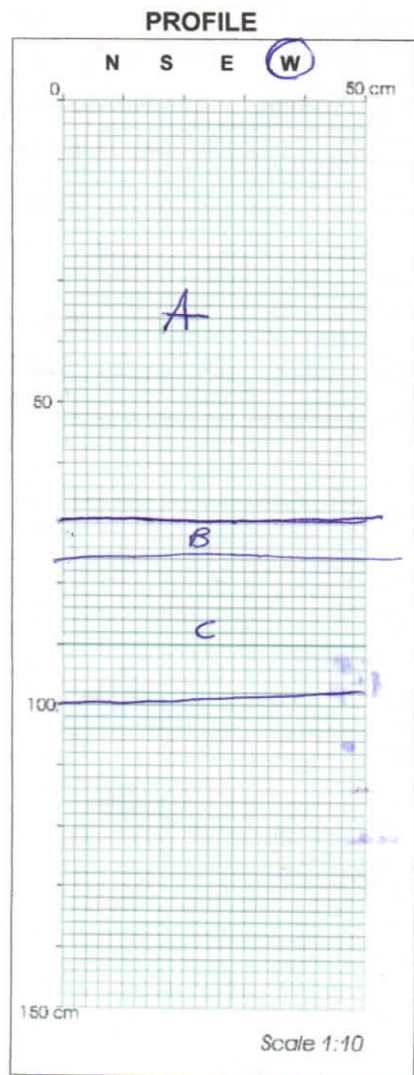
