**This Indenture**, made the *Fifth* DAY OF *March* in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and forty-*nine* between *Albert Kleis and Geesige Klomp his wife of Holland* in the County of *Ottawa* and State of *Michigan* of the first part, and *Albertus C. Van Raalte of the Town County & State aforesaid* of the second part, WITNESSETH, that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of *Ten dollars* to them in hand paid, by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, remised released, aliened and confirmed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell remise, release, alien and confirm unto said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns FOR EVER, all that certain tract or PARCEL OF LAND situated in the Township County and State aforesaid and described as follows- viz: — The West half of the South East Fractional Quarter of Section No. (22) Twenty Two and the North East Fractional Quarter, (including all of the East half of said Quarter North of the Black River) of said South East Quarter of Section Twenty two all in Township Two north of Range Fifteen West

And the said Albert Klei and Geesje Klomp his wife for themselves and for their heirs, executors and administrators do covenant, grant, bargain and agree to and with the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, that at the time of the ENSEALING AND DELIVERY of these presents they were well seized of the premises above conveyed, as of a good, sure, perfect, absolute, and indefeasible estate of inheritance in the law IN FEE SIMPLE, that they are free and clear from all encumbrances, and that the above bargained premises, IN THE QUIET AND PEACEABLE POSSESSION of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns against all and every person or persons, lawfully claiming or to claim the whole or any part thereof they will forever WARRANT AND DEFEND.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the said parties of the first part have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written.
