My dear Sir

Your favor of 25th March is received with the Mortgages for Mr Snyder and me. Mr Snyder's Mortgage I have given to him. You omitted sending the notes which were to go with the mortgages - Enclosed are two notes which please sign and return to me. With this I hand you Bond & Mortgage to Courtland Palmer; and his assignment of the same; and a satisfaction piece ^{with} which you are to cancel the Mortgage on your County Book of Records.

I am glad to see that you are going to build the Seminary of Puck - And hope soon to see you this way again, going through the churches; and ~~trust~~ you will easily raise the money wanted.

It will probably help recover your health.

The medicine you speak of, is called, Anderson's Rheumatic Balsam, ~~is~~ prepared by us, and is only to be had at our store, being unknown elsewhere.

It is pleasant to hear that the presence of the Spirit of the Lord is felt in any of our churches - May His influences extend to them all!
