This brief biographical record of Rev. Albertus Van Raalte, the father of Rev. Albertus C. Van Raalte, was probably obtained by the Van Raalte during the summer of 1866 when they were visiting in the Netherlands.

Albertus van Raalte

First he was Pastor at Renswoude from 1794 until 1811.
Then at Wanneperveen from 1811-1820.
He was called from there on December 11, 1819
and installed the 7th of May 1820 by the counselor
Buis Ballot with Coll. 1:20, and preached his inaugural
with 2 Cor. 4:5. In December 1821 he was called to
Rijsoord and environs and preached his farewell on
April 28, 1822 using Heb. 10:23. He took his leave
from Rijsoord on October 23, 1825 using 1 Cor. 16:23, 24,
and was installed at Scherpenisse on October 30, 1825.
He departed from there to Fijnaard and environs after having
received the call on the 16th of May 1828 and having preached
his farewell on July 27. He died at Fijnaard on the 28th of
March 1833, at the age of 61 years and 6 months.

Albertus van Raalte [father of A.C.]

First he was minister in Renswoude from 1794 until 1811. Then [he went] to Wanneperveen from 1811-1820. From there he was called here on December 11, 1819, installed on May 7, 1820 by the "consulent" [moderator] Bart Ballat [?], with Col. 1:20, and preached his first sermon on II Cor 4:5. Was called in December 1821 to Rijsoord c.ei [?]. At the farewell on April 28, 1822, he preached Hebrew 10:23. He took his farewell from Rijsoord on October 23, 1825, preaching on I Cor. 16, 23, 24 and was installed in Scherpenisse on October 30, 1825. He left there for Fijnaard c.ei. after receiving the call on May 16, 1828. He preached his farewell on July 27 in Fijnaard. He died on March 28, 1833, at the age of 61 years and six months.
