The undersigned, Carel Godefroi de Moen, manufacturer, conducting business under the name of De Moen and Comp., living in the town of Ommen, Province of Overijssel, declare with this that he, in sole ownership, to have sold to Mr. Dirk Blikman Kikkert, ship broker and manager of import and export documents, living in Amsterdam, who declares to have bought the following:

The undivided half of the goods, enumerated later, which the seller, with his partner, Mr. Albertus Christiaan van Raalte, manufacturer, also living in Ommen, mutually own, to wit:

1. The right of building on a corner lot, at the Ommermars, in the town of Ommen, c. 28 rods, being a portion of a lot which is meadowland, registered Sub Section B. No. 9, altogether forty hectares, forty-two rods, sixty yards, as well as the right to the road, six yards wide, in order to enter the public road, at the front of the corner lot, and since this road is located within the said lot, Section B. No. 94. And such on equal conditions and with the same stipulations with the right of building on it when it was bought by the seller and the aforementioned co-owner from Mr. Elias Ravenshorst, [wool]card maker, private deed of 18 December 1840, on 30 December in Ommen, properly registered,

and on 22 February following, copied in the office of the mortgage registry [Kantoor der Hypotheken], in Deventer, Vol. 14, No. 12.

- 2. The right of building on the corner lot, situated east of the mentioned "sub-prima" corner lot, c. 18 rods, and similarly, consisting of a portion meadowland, registered as sub section BM [Ne?] 94, amounting in its entirety to 40 hectares, 42 rods, 60 yards. And having obtained this with the same conditions and stipulations concerning the right to build on it by seller and his aforementioned co-owner, from the "Markenrigter"² of the Mark of Ommen, with a private deed of 5 July 1840, registered properly on 4 October of the following year in Ommen, on the 20th of that month copied in the office of the mortgage registry in Deventer, Volume 17, No. 64.
- 3. The following buildings and constructions on the corner lot, mentioned earlier, are:
 - a. A double barn to dry shingles
 - b. A shingle oven, located in a building also suitable for storing peat
 - c. A laborer's cottage, next to the shingle barn
 - d. A Frisian ceramics factory annexed barn, across from the double barn

- e. A Venlo's earthenware factory and annex barn
- f. Another barn
- g. An office next to that.
- 4. The following land, situated in the "township" of Lemele, belonging to district Ommen, as

- a. A little lot, situated near the farmyard of Huismink, called "de oude Hof", planted with young oak trees, registered as sub-section G. No. 490, thirty-two rods, seventy yard
- b. All the oak trees, located on the "brink" of Lemele, and planted there with permission of the heirs
- c. Arable land, in the "es", 4 called "Broddenhegge", 44 rods, and 90 yards, registered under sub section G. No. 766.
- d. And the same "es," called the large Zwolsche⁵ land, 41 rods, 90 yards, registered under sub section G. No. 768.
- e. Arable land, in the small "es," named the small Zwolsche land, 25 rods, 70 yards, registered under section G. No. 772.
- f. Half a share in the Mark of Lemele in the Dalmsholte, having belonged to the homestead of Velthuis in Lemele.
- g. A fourth share in the Mark of Lemele in the Dalmsholte, having belonged to the homestead of Kleinhuismink in Lemele.

And such, with the same conditions as these seven sections, were bought by the seller and his often named co-owner, Mr. Albertus Christiaan van Raalte from Mr. Arnoldus Johannes Helmick, JD, Councillor in the Provincial

Court of Overijssel, living in Zwolle, in private deed of December 23, 1840, duly registered on the 25th of that month in Ommen, and, copied on the 22nd of February following in the office of the mortgage registry, Deventer, Vol. 14, No. 27.

- 5. Obtained fourth share, in the Mark of Dalmshalte, belonging to the farmstead Groothuismink in Lemele, the same, received in exchange by the seller and his co-owner, from Egberdina Nijenhuis, farmer, living in the aforesaid township Lemele, and consorts, with private deed on the first of July, last, duly registered on 29 September following, and copied in the office of mortgage registry in Deventer, on the 20th October of this year, Vol. 17. No 63, and in the office of the mortgage registry in Zwolle, on 10 November following, Vol. 29, No. 71.
- 6. The buildings and constructions, located on the Lemeler Berg [hill], and the brick, shingle and tile factory already constructed there, consists of:

- a. Three laborer cottages
- b. An office
- c. A horse barn, and a small barn for wagons
- d. Two brick ovens, of which one is covered.
- e. Two movable barns to store bricks

belonging to the lot on which these buildings

are located on the Mark of Lemele, and known in the registry as Sub Section G. No. 741a.

Half of all the right and goods mentioned above—which can be accepted immediately, sold for an already paid sum which, I, the seller acknowledged to have received and which has been settled.

Having relinquished and carried forward, I, the seller, with that which was purchased, with all profits and taxes, rights and entitlements to the compliant buyer, to vouchsafe him from all eviction and compromises according to rights.

Of which two copies have been made and signed by both in Ommen, December 7, 1841.
