Those manuscripts recommended for publication in CPR will be processed by CPR Editorial Office and published in October 2017.

## Guidelines for the authors

The manuscripts (full papers) must fit general guidelines of Czech Polar Reports (*see* http://www.sci.muni.cz/CPR/). For the CPR-ASSW special issue, several specific recommendation should be followed:

(1) The manuscript must have a common structure (Introduction, Material and Methods, Results, Discussion, References).

(2) Except of References, the length of the manuscript should not exceed 22 thousand characters (including spaces).

(3) Maximum number of Figures is 4.

(4) Maximum number of Tables is 2.

(5) Number of references should be higher than 15 but lower than 40.
