Pittsburg June 9th, 1808

We the Subscribers hereby engage & bind ourselves unto Geo: C. Sibley to labor faithfully and diligently as oarsmen on board of his Boat from this place to St. Louis in Terr^y of Louisiana to perform all the duties, that good Boatmen are accustomed to perform, & to continue with him until discharged- It being left optional with the Said Sibley to discharge either or any of us or not at any time or place (between here and St. Louis) that he may think proper, he Settling fairly & justly with us- It is understood that we only engage ourselves to go to St. Louis.
