NETC Needs Accurate Feedback

- The Naval Education and Training Command (NETC) is committed to producing the best possible Sailors for the fleet
- Doing so requires feedback on how its schools' graduates are performing once reaching the fleet
- Even more important as Ready, Relevant Learning project causes significant modifications to traditional methods of instruction

Problems with Current Methods

- Poor return rates
- Restrictions on when/how the surveys can be administered
- Difficulty in locating the actual supervisors of the Sailors
- Sailors performing other tasks outside NEC (e.g., mess cranking) prior to using skills learned in training pipeline

Recommendations

- Have students provide the study directly to their seniors rather than relying upon chain of command
- Examine demographic description of those responding to determine whether the sample is representative of the population



- Provide an incentive for Sailors returning the surveys
- Inform respondents of any changes made as a result of their answers
- Reword the questions to better reflect the desired information
- Provide a link on each question which explains each response option
