Dear Sir

Enclosed please find Duplicate Bills, and  
order in favor of Mr H Pitcomb Cash; Rockland Bank  
Rockland - as requested - I sent him at the time a Duplicate  
Bill, receipted, to be given up on payment of the amount supposing  
that would be the proper course - Major Kelley as you are  
doubtless aware is alive & doing well - John Goddard informs me  
that his arm was not taken off, as stated to me by the men who were  
with him at the time, but he will probably lose the use of it -  
The Residents of Maine in this City have had a meeting and  
taken the preliminary steps to form an organization for the relief  
of our sick & wounded Soldiers confined in the Hospitals in  
this District - I have no doubt much good will result from  
it
