I have the honor to state that, agreeably to your request, a meeting of the Company Commanders of my Regt was called Tuesday evening last, and the following nomination for Chaplain was unanimously made,

Rev. A. H. P. Small of Bangor,

There being no field officers now with the Regt, I called in Capt. Smith, now Provost Marshal of this City, and Boothby Condit, Provost Guards, while only Co. was represented by its actual commander.

First Lieut. George Weston resigned Oct. 10<sup>th</sup> on account of continued ill health; and First Lieut. John R. Webb Co. B. Oct. 14<sup>th</sup> for same cause.

I respectfully request that 2<sup>d</sup> Lt. Taughan Co. D. be promoted to 1<sup>st</sup> Lieut. vice Weston, and that 2<sup>d</sup> Lieut. Hall Co. B. be promoted to 1<sup>st</sup> Lieut. vice Webb. Private Wm. F. Stone Co. F. - actg. ret. sergt - to be commissioned 2<sup>d</sup> Lieut. Co. B. vice Hall promoted; Capt. Summat desires the latter for 2<sup>d</sup> Lieut.
