1862-12-21 Lieutenant Colonel Douty acknowledges discharge of George Prince and makes recommendations for promotions

To His Excellency
Governor Washburn

Dear Sir

I have the honor, to inform you of the receipt, at these Hd Qrs, of an order from the Head Quarters of the Army, Adjutant General's Office, Washington Dc November 29. 1862 - honorably discharging Captain George Prince, Co "K", 1st Maine Cavalry, from the Military Service of the United States, to take effect October 31st 1862, and to respectfully recommend, for the interest of the service, that the following promotions may be made to fill vacancies in Co "K" 1st Maine Cavalry, occasioned by the honorable discharge of Captain Prince.

1st Lieut George Cary. - Haulton - to be Captain vice Prince disch.
Superior Lieut Charles W. Ford. - Bristol - to be 1st Lieut vice Cary promoted.
