Sept. 17th 1861.

J. - Jonathan Bigelow of Co. "G" joined the Regt in Boston, on its way to Washington. My place of residence is Bloomfield Somerset Co. Maine. The other J^{rs} M. Graves of the same Co

President of Bowdoinham, enlisted the same day the Bonnetts were given but after they were made

I wish you would instruct us how to obtain our due as soon as is convenient
