

Cage farming of Pompano at Mandapam



Cage farming of pompano

Cage farming of Pompano (*Trachinotus blochii*) was experimented for the first time in India at Mandapam Regional Centre of CMFRI from the hatchery produced fingerlings. The fingerlings were stocked after nursery rearing in September, 2011. The length ranged of fingerlings stocked from 6.0 to 7.0 cm and weight ranged from 12 to 14 gms. The fishes were fed with trash fish *ad libitum* twice in a day.
