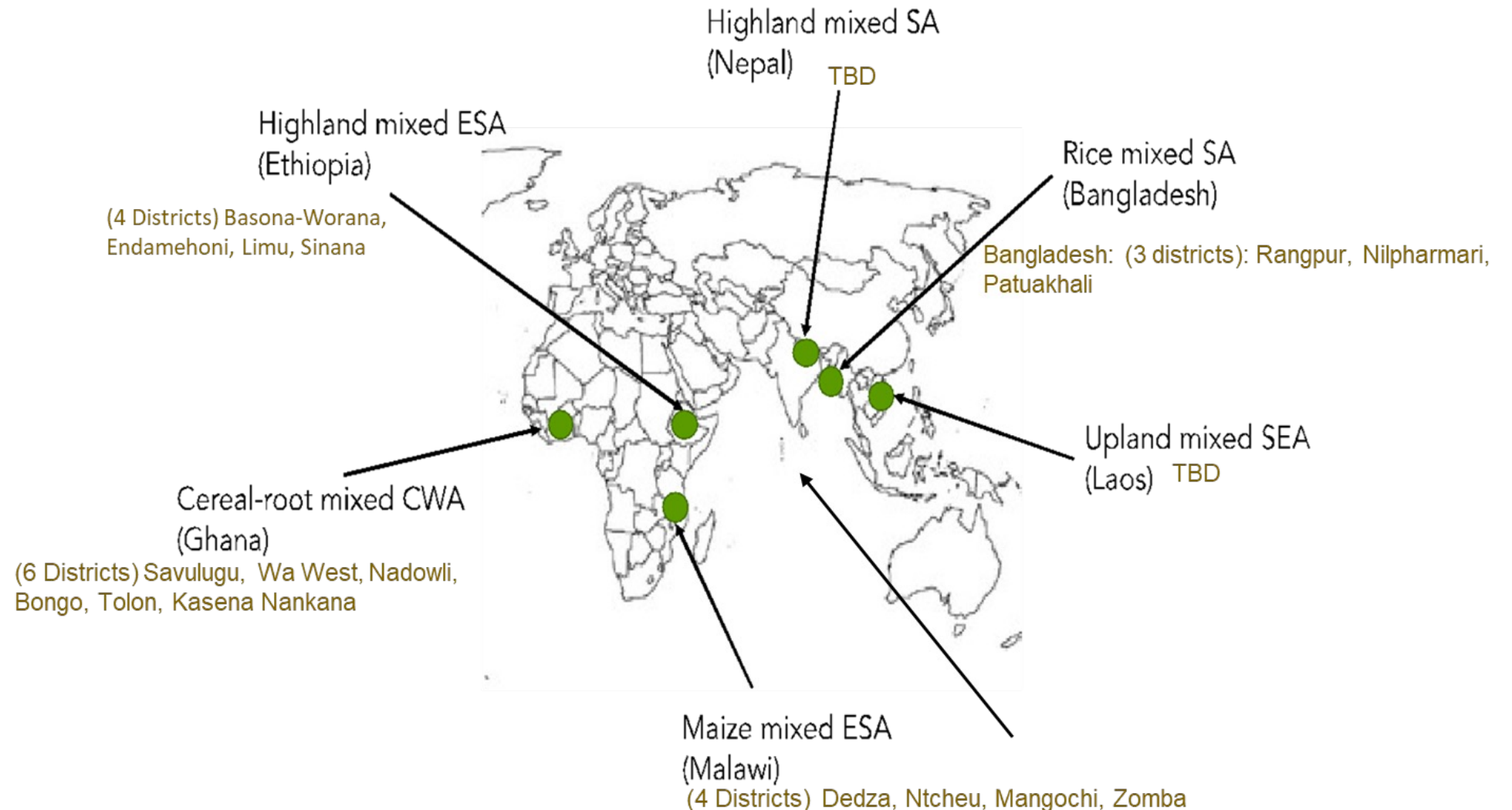

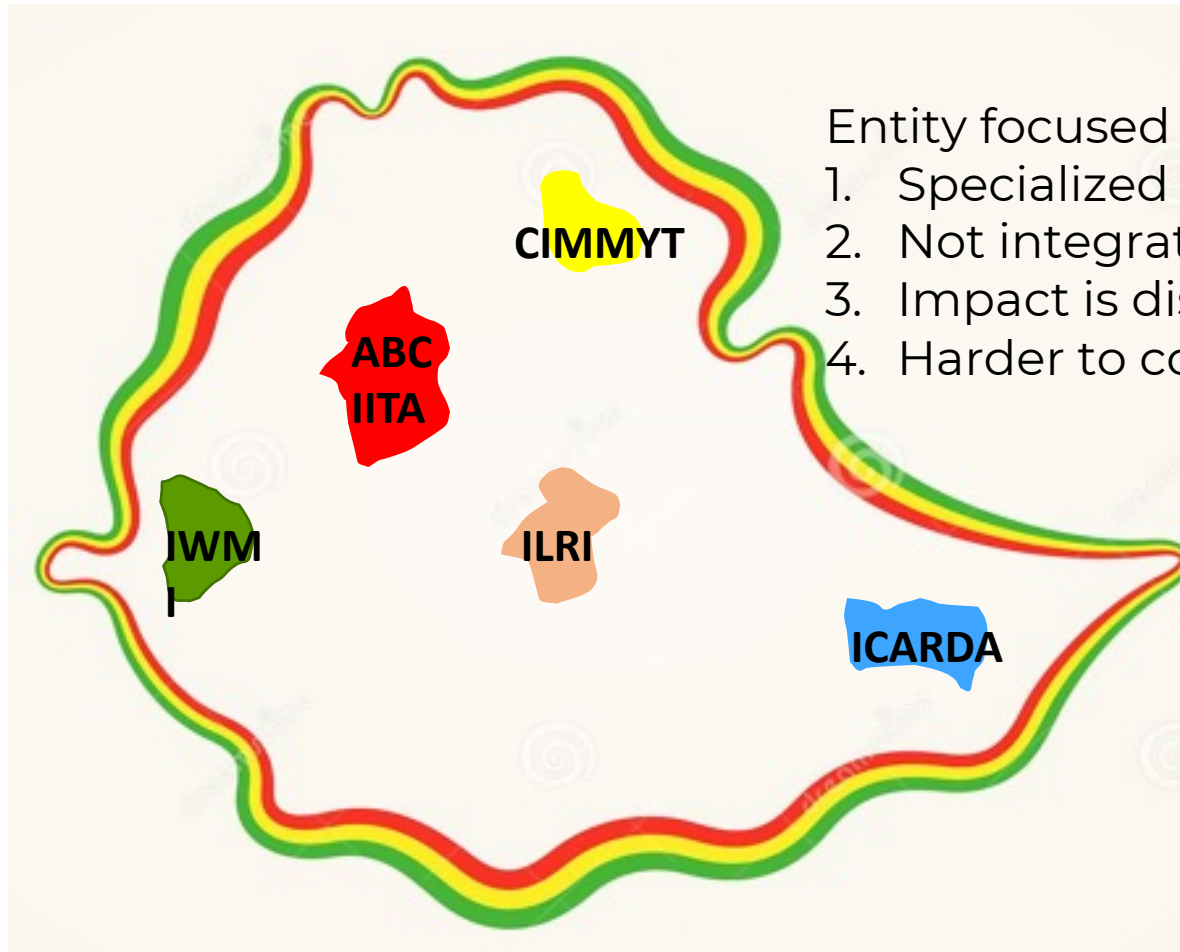

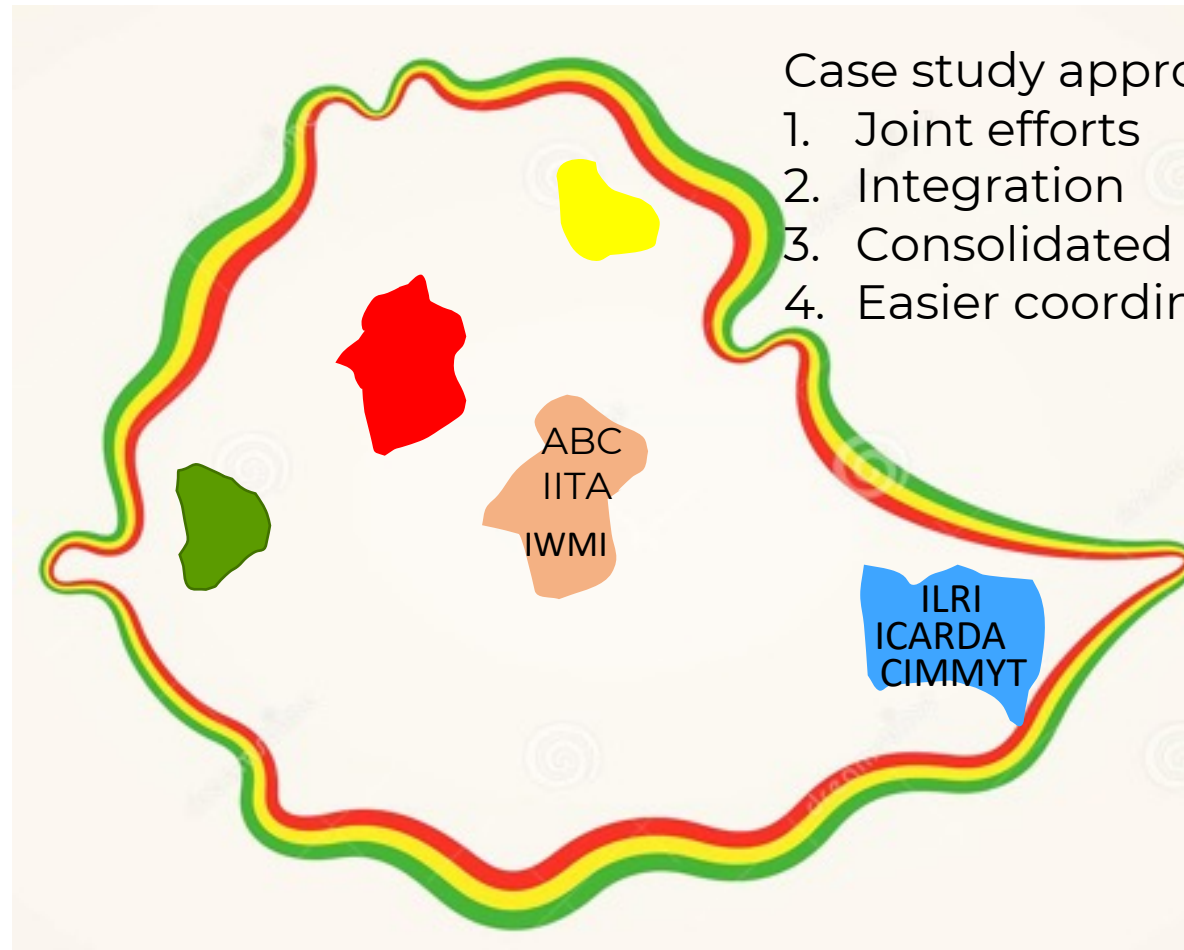
Entity focused approach:

4. Harder to coordinate

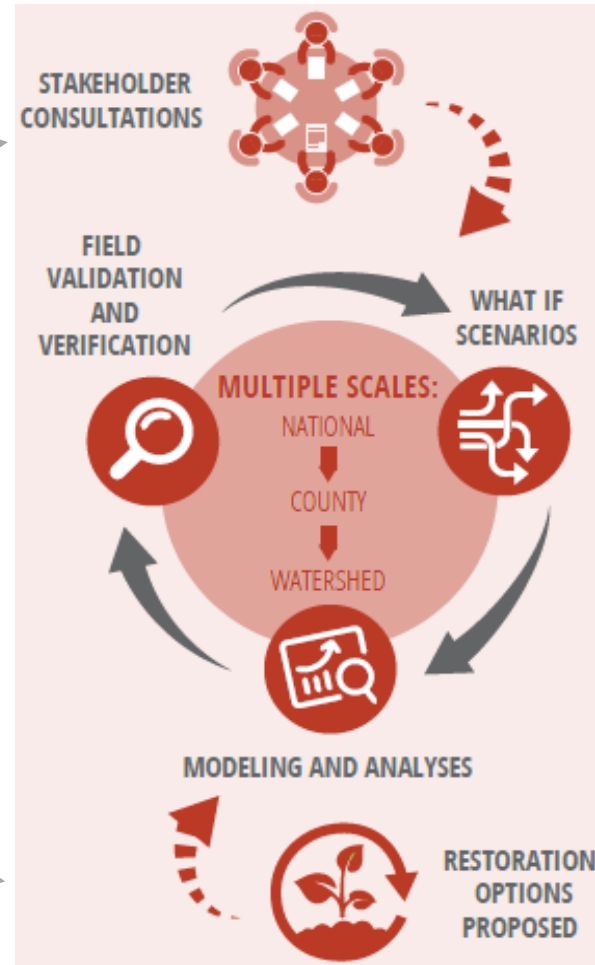


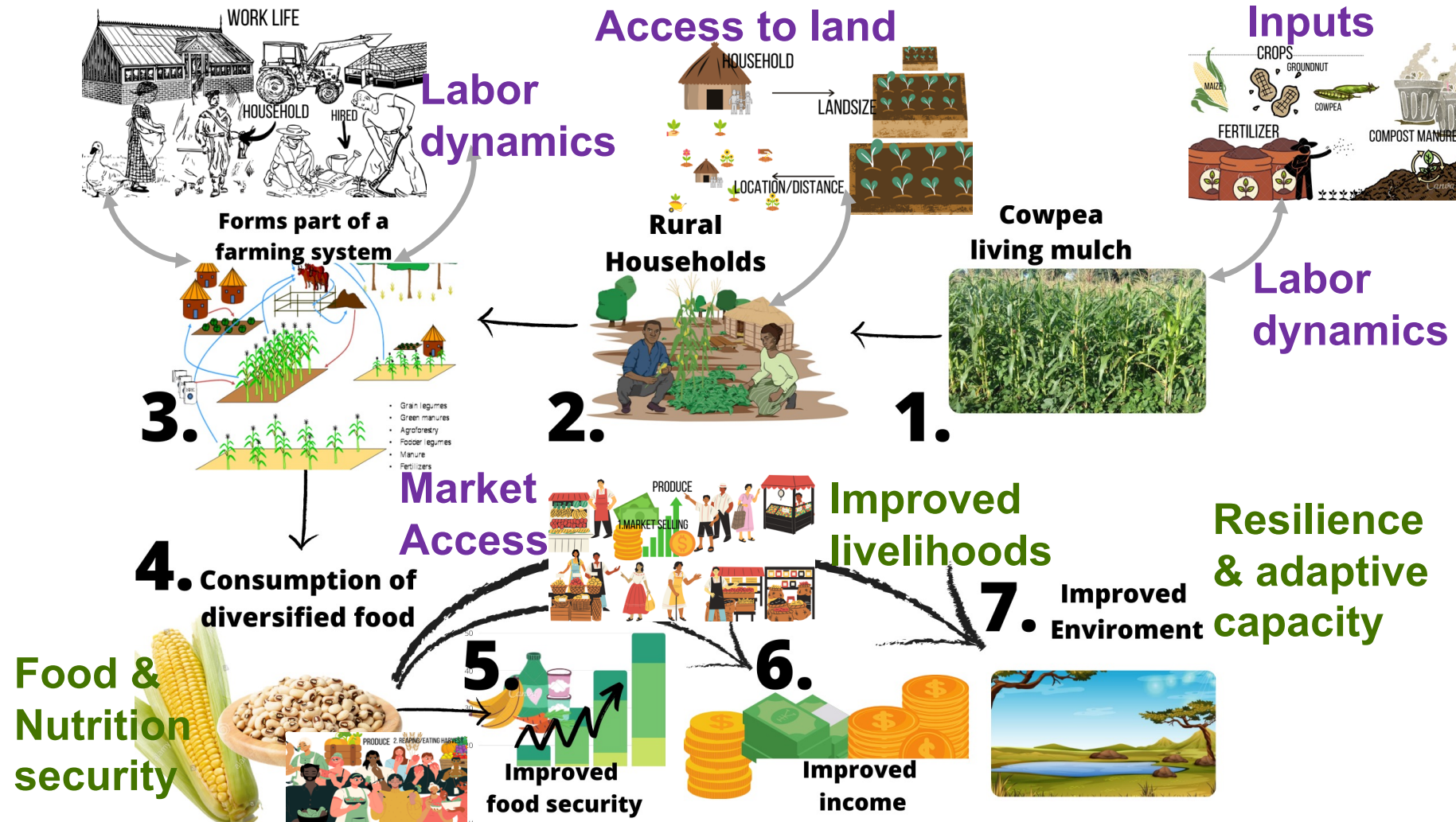
- Case study approach:
