

# **Woreda Participatory Land Use Planning for Pastoral Areas in Ethiopia**

**Project Title:** P573 - Activity 4.3.1: Land and resource tenure arrangements and institutional models.

**Description of the innovation:** Woreda Participatory Land Use Planning (WPLUP) for Pastoral Areas is a process undertaken by district-level government experts working with local land users, to develop a land use plan for better managing and protecting rangelands, and for woreda development planning. WPLUP has also been used to prevent rangeland fragmentation, learning from joint village land use planning in Tanzania. A drylands-specific land capability classification is included. ILRI provided significant technical support to the development of WPLUP.
