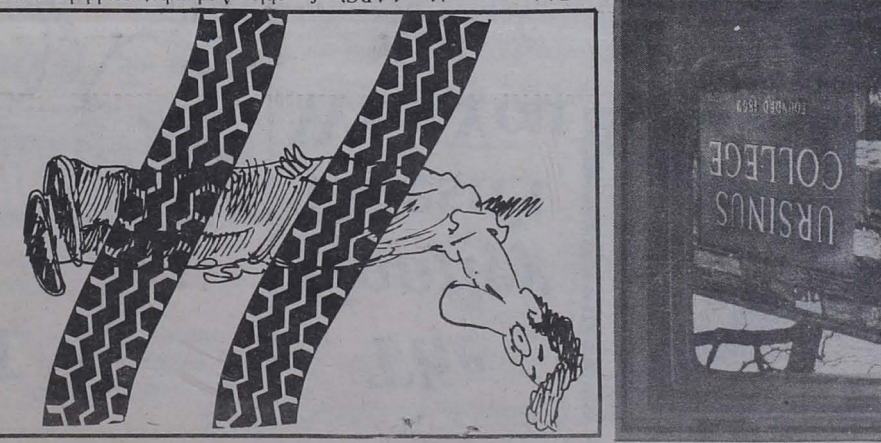

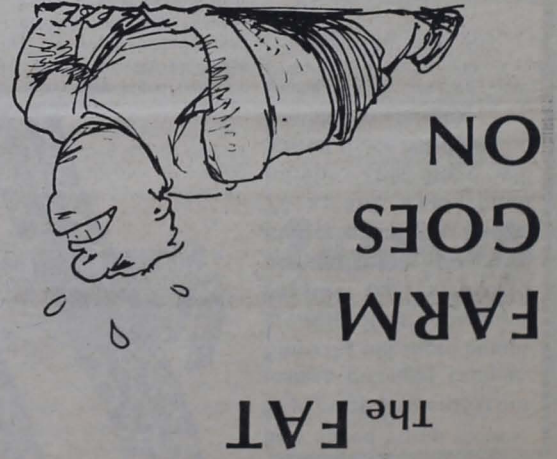

Modern art is supposed to reject, threaten public values. "The reaction of the NCAA came as no surprise to anyone.
