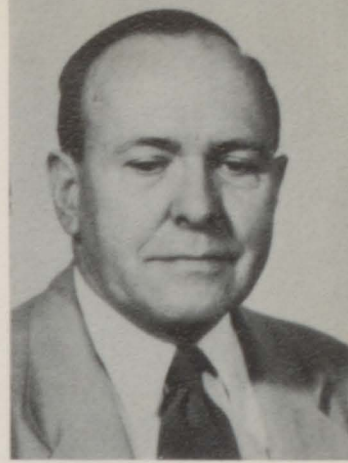
We believe in the Breckinridge Training School. We believe in it as an institution which upholds the highest ideals, practices democratic principles, and furthers activities for the betterment of the individual.
