President fires Elders

WASHINGTON (AP) — The foes of Surgeon General Joycelyn Elders' social views are celebrating her firing by President Clinton. But Elders, defiant to the end, said she does not regret saying school children should be taught about masturbation and suggested that her remarks were misinterpreted.

"People have taken a lot of things I've said in a most unusual way," she said Friday in a telephone interview from her home outside Washington.

Incoming House Speaker Newt Gingrich, who has repeatedly assailed Elders' views, called her "a remarkably destructive person" who has long deserved removal from office.

And Rep. Marge Roukema of New Jersey, the most senior Republican woman in the House, said, "Great! What took her so long?" after Clinton demanded and received Elders' resignation.

White House Chief of Staff Leon Panetta said Clinton acted because Elders had ignored repeated warnings from administration officials to moderate her public statements. "This was one too many," he said.

He cited previous Elders statements in which she said the government should consider legalizing drugs, consider "teaching five-year olds to use condoms" and for saying that anti-abortion Catholics have "a love affair" with fetuses.

Her firing stemmed from her remarks Dec. 1 at a World AIDS Day conference in New York, when she was asked whether taboos about the public discussion of masturbation should be lifted.

Elders said: "As per your specific question in regard to masturbation, I think that is something that is a part of human sexuality and it's a part of something that perhaps should be taught. But we've not even taught our children the very basics. And I feel that we have tried ignorance for a very long time and it's time we try education."

Elders said on Friday she had intended to explain her belief that masturbation is a natural act that would have to be included in any comprehensive discussion about human sexuality. But she does not believe young people should be taught how to masturbate.

LBL now has guidepost for land management

It may have taken 5½ years, but officials at Land Between the Lakes have given birth to a 6-pound, 5-ounce plan for managing natural resources that will guide them through the next decade.

"The process we went through to develop this plan was very important," said John Mechler, manager of resource management at LBL. "We took a very critical look at what had been in place essentially since 1964."

LBL is a 170,000-acre outdoor recreation and environmental education area in west Kentucky and Tennessee.

The final environmental impact statement was signed by Kathryn Jackson, senior vice president of the Resource Group Dec. 6.

"This plan represents a framework for us that is flexible," Mechler said. "It is not set in concrete so that we wouldn't be able to look at other methods or put a new trail in an area."

The draft statement was released in November 1993 and

was then subject to a public hearing. From there, changes were made in response to more than 2,900 letters prior to completing the final plan.

The plan calls for an increased emphasis on scenic beauty, sight-

seeing, wildlife viewing and a more natural appearance of the forest as part of a new approach to natural resources management.

The controversial part of the plan deals with timber harvesting, which has not been practiced at

LBL since September 1992.

Commercial logging was suspended after environmentalists threatened a lawsuit. LBL paid more than \$850,000 to settle canceled logging contracts.

The new plan replaces one that pro-logging forces objected to last fall — one that emphasized "scenic vistas" and "visual corridors."

After the protests, LBL officials went back to the drawing board and made changes.

"I'm very comfortable with the

changes that were made," Mechler said. "Increasing the amount of land for the biosphere reserve is good, as well as making provisions for improving the visual quality."

Under the new plan, timber harvesting would be reduced. Each year, even-aged harvesting would be conducted on 1,110 acres and uneven-aged harvesting on 1,070 acres, with an approximate 20 percent reduction in the amount of timber removed as

Student faces lesser charge

Indictments returned by grand jury

The Murray State University student charged with attempted murder after firing a shot at another person was indicted by a Calloway County grand jury Friday on a lesser charge.

Dennis B. Park, 25, Farmer Ave., was charged with second-degree wanton endangerment, a Class A misdemeanor.

A female, who was with Park when the incident occurred at approximately 1:30 a.m. Oct. 31 near the intersection of 15th and Main streets, was not indicted.

Police charged Jessica Wilson, 19, Springfield Hall, with attempted murder, but the grand jury

returned a "no bill" against her, which means charges are dropped.

Dave Brodsky, 25, Madison, Tenn. is the alleged victim in the incident. Reports indicate that Brodsky and Wilson were acquainted.

The cases against Park and Wilson were sent to the grand jury after a preliminary hearing. District Judge Leslie Furches determined that there was sufficient evidence to send the case forward.

According to police reports, Park and Wilson followed Brodsky from a party and allegedly threw a bottle at Brodsky's car. When Brodsky stopped the car, Park hit the rear of Brodsky's vehicle.

The couple approached Brodsky when the vehicles stopped, and Wilson allegedly began striking him.

'Night Before Christmas' manuscript auctioned off

NEW YORK (AP) — "Twas right before Christmas, and for one famous poem, a man paid big money, and then took it home.

Ralph Gadiel won a bidding war Friday, paying \$255,000 for a rare handwritten copy of "A Visit From St. Nicholas."

The famous 56-line poem was written in 1822 by Clement Clarke Moore. The copy being auctioned Friday — one of just three surviving handwritten copies — was transcribed by Moore at the request of an admirer in 1860 when he was 81 years old.

Christie's auction house had estimated that the poem, written in brown ink on a single 8-by-5-inch piece of paper, would sell for between \$70,000 and \$90,000.

But a bidding war drove the price up. Gadiel said he was determined to have it at any price.

Gadiel, an entrepreneur from Northbrook, Ill., whose company sells gifts and collectibles, plans to market a limited edition of copies of the manuscript in time for next Christmas.

He already is manufacturing a miniature house like the one described in the poem.

"It has Santa and his reindeer on the roof, and the father throwing open the sash," Gadiel said. "The house can be opened, so you can see the children 'nestled all snug in their beds.'"

Legend has it that Moore came up with the poem while he was out buying a turkey for his wife to roast on Christmas Eve and give to the poor of the local parish.

He jotted the verses down when he got home, and the following Christmas, a family friend sent a copy to the editor of the Sentinel newspaper in Troy, N.Y. It was published in 1823 and reprinted anonymously in newspapers and on broadsides until 1837, when Moore made his authorship public.

Kuttawa foundation falls under scrutiny

KUTTAWA, Ky. (AP) —

Nearly all land that's not owned privately in Kuttawa belongs to a foundation that exercises substantial influence over the sixth class city's affairs.

The Kuttawa Relocation Foundation's finances are cloaked in mystery. It refuses to allow public inspection of its records. Until new directors were named this fall, the board seldom, if ever, met.

Critics accuse the foundation of stifling development — especially development that might compete with established interests.

The foundation was established in 1960 by local civic and business figures to help move the small town (population 535) when Lake Barkley was impounded.

"It's a closed society," said Clyde Adams, a Kuttawa City Council member who is developing a retirement center. "Nobody knows when they meet or what

they do. Nobody knows about their money."

Foundation President W. G. McConnell said "we have never discouraged business from coming here, but we have asked people what they want to do with land they want to buy."

In the past four years, according to records at the Lyon County Courthouse, the foundation has sold 21 tracts for \$138,450, mostly to individuals for home sites.

No one, including McConnell, seems able to explain why Kuttawa hasn't grown appreciably in 30 years, while nearby Eddyville has.

The two largest buildings, a former grocery and a hardware store, are vacant.

Aside from two gas stations and a branch bank, the primary businesses are McConnell's drug store and the small insurance agency that bears the name of

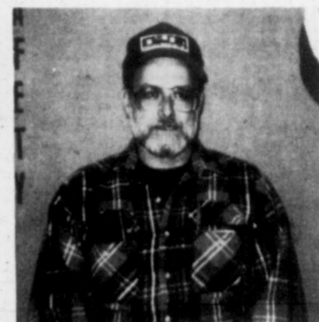

Tigers take second win at Hickman

Foster goes for 19

CLINTON — James Foster scored 19 points to lead all scorers and pace the Murray Tigers to their second win in as many nights, a 49-42 victory over Hickman County on the road Friday.

The teams were tied 5-5 after one quarter, but Murray took a 20-14 lead at halftime to take control of the game. The Tigers' edge stood at 32-23 at the third quarter stop.

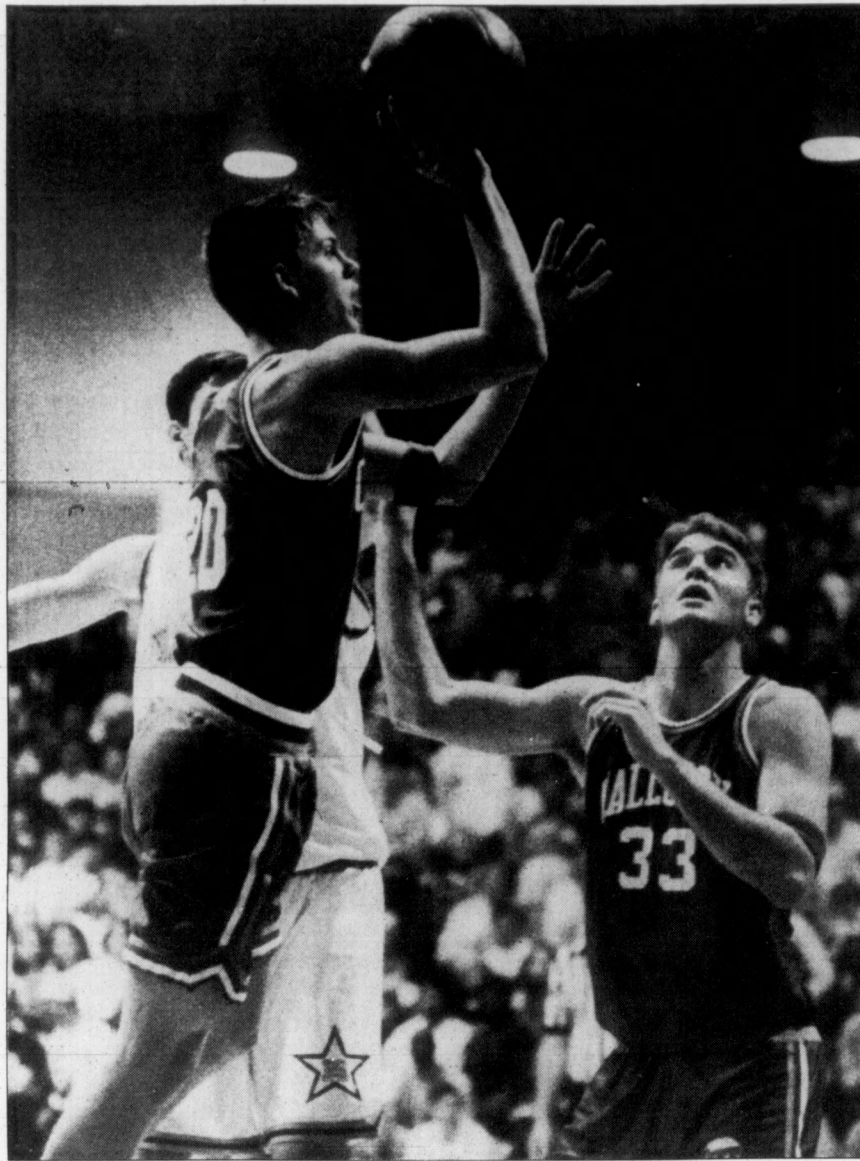
Chris Cheaney backed Foster with 12 points while Jason West scored eight, Jeremiah Rayburn tallied six and Robert Weatherly contributed four to account for all of Murray's scoring. The Tigers were 17 of 37 from the outside, two of nine from three-point range, while connecting on nine of 18 free throw attempts. Murray outbounded Hickman County 28-17 with Foster grabbing 13.

Josh Samples paced Hickman with 11 points. The Falcons made good on eight of 13 free throw attempts.

"In the first part of the game, the game went a long time with no score; we were getting some good shots, but we couldn't get any of them to fall," Murray coach Cary Miller said. "It was a typical early game where the defense is ahead of the offense. But we're glad to get the win because Hickman County is a tough place to play."

Even though Murray's starting five accounted for all of the team's scoring against Hickman County, Miller said he isn't too concerned about it this early in the season.

Laker glass act comes up short at Marshall Co.

Hot Herndon bolts off bench to throw in 21

DRAFFENVILLE — Jay Paul Herndon tried to give his Laker teammates a lift up, but the hole was just too deep.

Herndon came off the bench to score 21 points in the final 10 minutes of Friday night's game at Marshall County, but the Lakers came up short in a 71-65 defeat.

Calloway (4-1) suffered its first loss of the season in their Fourth District opener. Marshall improved to a perfect 4-0 on the season by using a 22-8 lead after the first quarter.

"We got in a big hole," said Calloway head coach Ron Greene. "I kept thinking we'd get back in it, and I felt good down the stretch. We got the ball in the hands of our shooters, but I think we might have gotten a little tired."

"I'm proud of the guys' effort tonight. It was a gutsy performance."

After trailing a tall and powerful Marshall team by as much as 16 with three minutes left in the third quarter, Herndon came on the scene with his rescue equipment.

Seeing his first action in the final two and a half minutes of the third quarter, Herndon hit his first 3-pointer with 2:36 left to pull Calloway within 13, 49-36. He would finish hitting 5-of-7 from long range but it wouldn't be enough.

Marshall hit 6-of-9 free throws in the final minute to seal the win after Calloway got as close as three, 61-58, with three minutes left.

"We laid it all out on the floor in the second half," said Herndon, a senior. "We know we've got a long way to go, but they have to come to our place twice."

Herndon was referring to Marshall's visit to Calloway on Jan. 31, as well as the Fourth District Tournament which will be held in Jeffrey Gymnasium.

Greene hopes the Lakers are as hot then as Herndon was on Friday.

"He's instant offense," Greene said of Herndon. "He does that in

Howard's 28 downs Lady Lakers

DRAFFENVILLE — Turning the ball over to a team with the experience and talent of Marshall County is just asking for trouble.

Calloway County's Lady Lakers asked for some Friday night. Calloway, after trailing Marshall by just two points at the end of the first quarter, committed eight turnovers in the second frame and Marshall took advantage, outscoring the Lady Lakers 18-5 in the first few minutes of the period to take an 18-point lead.

And though the Lady Lakers took better care of the ball in the second half, it was too late at that point as Marshall claimed a 72-56 Fourth District win Friday at Draffenville.

Marshall's Brigette Howard was a one-woman wrecking crew Friday. The 5-4 dynamo twisted, turned and simply ran by the Calloway defense for 28 points, 20 of those coming in the deciding first half.

"We played with them in the first quarter, we beat them in the third and we played even with them in the fourth, but they destroyed us in the second quarter," Calloway coach Peter O'Rourke said.

Calloway actually opened the second quarter on a good note with Linda Stubblefield sinking

one of two free throws to cut Marshall's lead to a single point, 14-13.

But that's when all the trouble started.

Howard scored inside, followed by two Heather Hill free throws, a Shana McDougal layup and Howard three-point shot to make it 23-13.

Following a Stubblefield basket, Howard registered back-to-back scores for a 27-15 edge,

and after Stubblefield scored again, Howard canned a free throw and Amy Moore converted two straight Calloway turnovers into layups to give the Lady Marshals a 32-17 edge.

"We had 18 turnovers for the game, and seven of them were in the second quarter; their press was effective," O'Rourke said. "I felt like we were ready for their press, but we didn't do in the game what we did in practice. We just got nervous and we got our heads down in the second quarter."

Lady Racers meet Billikens

Murray State seeks win No. 1

Coach Eddie Fields and his Lady Racer basketball team return to action on Saturday when they meet Saint Louis University at 5 p.m. in St. Louis, Mo.

Murray State enters the contest looking for their first win of the

season after starting 0-4 on the year, including Tuesday night's disappointing 74-46 loss at Southern Illinois.

In the game with SIU, Lady Racer Chasity Fields poster her second double-digit night (21 points, 11 rebounds) of the season and became the first MSU player to score over 20 points this year.

Saint Louis (1-2) will be facing its third member of the OVC this season, having posted a win over Southeast Missouri (64-54) and a

loss to UT-Martin (73-70).

The Lady Racers, who have been plagued by injuries, look forward to the return of both junior Stephanie Gray (flu) and freshman Mica Paige (back injury) to the team. Gray is MSU's top returnee from last year and Paige is a promising post player.

Indiana tops Morehead 79-62

BLOOMINGTON, Ind. (AP) — Alan Henderson flexed his muscles and kept Indiana's nation-best home winning streak intact.

Henderson scored 20 of his 33 points in the second half Friday night to lead Indiana to a 79-62 victory over Morehead State in the first round of the Indiana Classic. The Hoosiers have won 45 in a row at Assembly Hall.

"That's a major Division I

body, and I think after a while it wears on you," Eagle coach Dick Fick said of Henderson. "That's why he's such a good player."

The Hoosiers (3-4) pulled away from a 33-33 halftime tie by pounding the ball inside on the smaller Eagles. Forwards and centers scored 60 of Indiana's 79 points.

apiece for the Hoosiers. Evans had a team-high nine rebounds.

"In the second half, we basically took advantage of Henderson's size inside and got the ball inside to him," Knight said. "It wasn't a complicated offense to look at."

Indiana opened the second half with a 27-10 run. Henderson keyed the run with 10 points on two dunks and three jumpers.

Crappie fishing best in years

Most of the local crappie anglers are enjoying some of the best fishing they've had in years. Since most of the moss beds are gone, the big crappie have gone back to our old brush piles and dropoffs to hang out and feed around.

The influx of water from Tennessee and Alabama for the past two weeks has brought the temperature up about three degrees and I think this is one reason the fish are staying shallow.

Another reason could be the complete cloud cover which has lasted so long. If the baitfish will stay shallow, then the gamefish will do the same.

As we said earlier, the fresh water coming in from the South is warmer and it is carrying silt or mud and this "color" acts much the same as a curtain. I'm sure you have noticed whenever you catch a fish that it is lighter in color if it has been in muddy water for any length of time. This acts like a camouflage, so the predator can get closer to the prey and exert only a minimum

amount of energy.

It is tougher to fish out on the main lake when water is coming through this fast, but you can find some fish willing to eat. They may not stay very long, so be prepared to look around some.

Minnows are working better this season than usual, so be sure and include a bucketful if you are after crappie.

We are using a 1/0 hook with a single split shot and it is working a lot better than a two-hook rig. Another group of anglers who is having a great season so far is the sauger men. A current is what we look for, so the baitfish will

be swept along the bottom where the sauger feed easily.

The cloud cover works better for these fish too, so everyone has caught some good sauger.

Most guys use a one-ounce lead head jig with a plastic minnow or grub attached. In addition to all of this, put a large minnow on the hook and a stinger hook through its tail.

The stinger hook is very important because most of your fish will be caught on it! A number six or eight works great.

If you are fishing an area directly in the current, you may

want to tie on a heavier jig. Benson Sporting Goods has a very good selection to choose from, especially in the ounce-and-a-quarter size.

Colors change as the depth and light changes, so get a good selection and be prepared for anything.

You need to check the tops of the ledges or flats the first thing in the morning and see if the sauger are on the top to feed.

They may be down on the deeper steps waiting for the bait or the time frame to get in the right position.

After the sun comes up they usually move out and down, so don't fail to check these places out.

Black powder season opens again Saturday, so be aware that there are deer hunters out again for another week.

This should be a better season since the rain has cooled everything off.

Always be careful and respect the landowners!

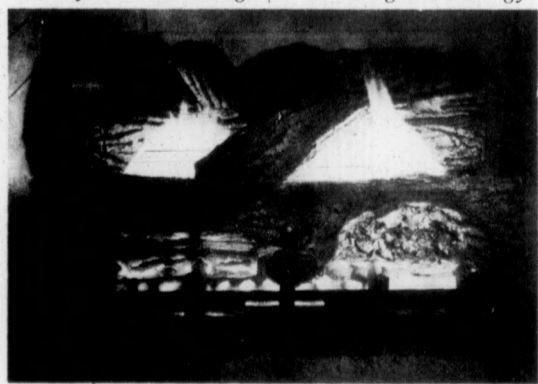

Kentucky's duck population has increased

Today marked the opening day of Kentucky's second duck season. Hunters have heard all summer that duck populations are as high as they have been in the past 20 years. The number of mallards, pintails, gadwalls and widgeon were some of the most successful species. Biologists hope that this is the beginning of better things to come. Duck numbers have been at all time lows for the past decade, and duck hunters had to cut back on limits and the number of days to hunt.

With this good news in the increase of duck populations, biologists were careful in not allowing any increase in limits, but they did increase the number of days from 30 to 40. This careful planning will allow a better chance for more birds to return north to breeding grounds to hopefully continue the up swing in duck numbers. Counting these

ducks is an important part of the management of ducks. One local biologist does just that.

Vernon Anderson, Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife district biologist, twice a month takes waterfowl surveys by airplane. He takes his count in western Kentucky that extends from the Mississippi River to the Smithland Pool.

A few years ago, while a student at Murray State, Vernon invited me to go on one of these surveys. We started on Kentucky Lake, crossed over to Barkley and then up to the Smithland Pool. We then came back down the Ohio River to the Mississippi River and stopped the survey at the Kentucky-Tennessee line. It is impossible to count each individual duck, but a method called block counting is used. Vernon, along with other biologists, is trained to count in blocks of hundreds, and this method is remark-

ably accurate. That day, we counted over 10,000 ducks and 4,000 geese.

The survey is done twice a month on the first and 15th in the fall and winter months. Surveys are funded by the Pitman Robertson Act. These surveys tell biologists duck migration movements, as well as individual species' numbers. When Anderson conducted the survey on Dec. 1, duck numbers were not impressive in western Kentucky.

Swan Lake led the way with 7,500 ducks and 100 geese. Ballard County Wildlife Refuge had 2,600 ducks and 2,500 geese. Along the Mississippi River from Barlow to Fulton, there were 800 ducks and Kentucky and Barkley had around 4,000 ducks and 325 geese. Anderson said that the last big migration we had was on Nov. 27 and since then, duck movements have come to a halt.

There were some impressive numbers at Reelfoot Lake with 200,000 ducks with 75,000 of these mallards. Northeast Arkansas had almost 1 million mallards on the last count. Central and southern Illinois also counted around 500,000 birds. There is still plenty of waterfowl north of us. All we need is a little cold weather to push another migration through our area.

Traditionally, Kentucky and Barkley lakes will not hold many ducks until most of the shallow lakes and sloughs are frozen to the north of western Kentucky. If this happens this year, duck hunters can expect one of the best seasons in recent memory.

I will try to keep waterfowl hunters up to date on the numbers of ducks and geese throughout the season.

Be careful and enjoy your hunt.

Selecting a proper Christmas present for outdoor lovers

ATLANTA (AP) — There are two categories of gifts to give anglers, birders, hunters or others who enjoy the outdoors.

If the recipient is a novice, such as a child, give a quality item that is needed.

If the recipient has a closet jammed with gear, listen first. Those descriptions of a piece of gear a buddy just bought are verbal wish lists.

If there's nothing obvious, look for a high-quality item or a gadget that the recipient might not normally buy.

Don't buy firearms. They should be held and studied by the prospective buyer as the stock length and other measurements

are determined to be right for the individual.

Of course, there's always the possibility of a gift certificate from a favorite gun shop.

A young person can be started on a life of outdoor adventures with a first fishing kit. The basics are a rod and reel, a tackle box with goodies, and some line.

It's best to buy a rod and reel in a set. Expect to pay \$20 to \$50. A spincasting set is the best for starters. Its line release operates simply with the thumb.

Get a traditional tackle box with trays, about \$10 to \$15. Stuff it with a spool of 8-pound line and a spool of 12-pound for bigger fish. Add some hooks, 2/0 for bass or walleye, No. 4 or No. 6 for panfish, split shot sinkers of various sizes, up to one-half ounce, and several sizes of round plastic bobbers.

Include some small jigs — the little hooks with lead heads and a bit of feather or thread wrapped to them, in different sizes and colors.

For adults, a high-quality graphite rod is an excellent gift. Expect to spend \$100 or so. For those who want to splurge, buy a matched top-line reel for about \$65 to \$200.

South dealer. Both sides vulnerable. NORTH: ♠ K 9 5, ♥ K 10 6, ♦ 5 2, ♣ A Q 7 6 3. WEST: ♠ Q J 10 3, ♥ 9 7 5, ♦ K J 8 4, ♣ 9 2. EAST: ♠ A 8 6, ♥ 3 2, ♦ Q 10 9 7, ♣ J 10 8 4. SOUTH: ♠ 7 4 2, ♥ A Q J 8 4, ♦ A 6 3, ♣ K 5.

The bidding: South West North East 1♥ Pass 2♣ Pass 2♥ Pass 4♥ Opening lead — queen of spades.

There are hands where declarer has hope for a 3-3 split in a key suit. But because that division occurs only 36 percent of the time, he should not accept these odds without first looking for a way to improve on them.

South neglected to make that effort on this deal. He played low from dummy on West's first two spade leads, hoping East had started with the singleton or doubleton ace, but East took his ace on the third round and shifted to a diamond.

South won with the ace and played five rounds of trumps, hoping for a 3-3 club division or a discarding error by the opponents. But East retained all his clubs and declarer eventually lost a diamond trick to go down one.

South could have improved his chances considerably had he taken steps to guard against a 4-2 club break. After winning the diamond return, he should cash the A-K of trumps and K-A of clubs. He next ruffs a small club high to prevent a possible overruff by West. South then enters dummy with a low trump to the ten, simultaneously drawing West's last trump, and cashes the Q-7 of clubs to make the contract.

Note the importance of ruffing the third round of clubs instead of trying to cash the queen first. This protects against the possibility of either defender having started with a doubleton club and three trumps, as in the actual deal.

It is true that if the clubs are 3-3, this extra effort proves unnecessary. But if the clubs are 4-2 — a division that occurs 48 percent of the time and thus brings the total odds favoring declarer to 84 percent — the recommended line of play rewards South handsomely for his additional expenditure of energy.

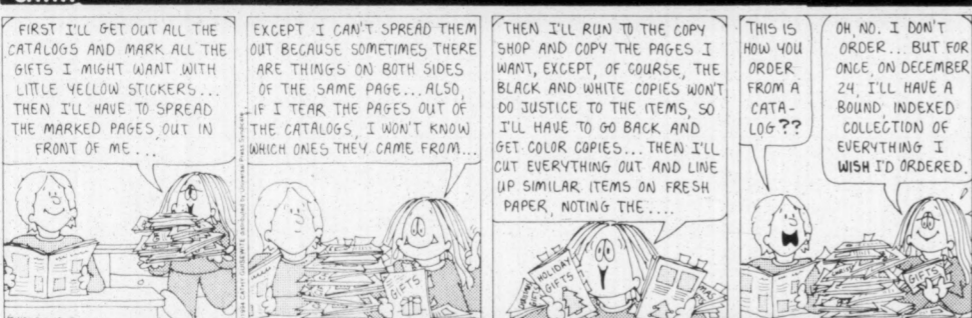

DR. GOTT

DEAR DR. GOTT: My husband uses the herb rutin to relieve hemorrhoid discomfort. Is this appropriate?

DEAR READER: No, it isn't. Herbal remedies have not been shown in medical studies to be as effective as medicated suppositories. Severe hemorrhoids that bleed or cause chronic pain may need surgical treatment.

DEAR DR. GOTT: I'm 16 and suffer from hypoglycemia. I can't get much information about my problem around here and would like to know more about it.

DEAR READER: Hypoglycemia (low blood sugar) is defined as a blood sugar level below 45 milligrams per deciliter in conjunction with symptoms, such as hunger, faintness, palpitations, and weakness. Also, the symptoms have to be corrected by consuming sugar in order to establish the diagnosis.

True hypoglycemia is very rare and is usually due to a glandular imbalance. In the past, hypoglycemia was a "fad" illness, used to explain chronic fatigue and other vague complaints. Therefore, most reputable practitioners are loath to diagnose this ailment without careful documentation.

If you do, indeed, suffer from hypoglycemia, you need further testing to define the cause. Such blood tests can be coordinated by an endocrinologist, a specialist in glandular disorders, who will also prescribe a low-sugar, high-protein, frequent-feeding diet.

DEAR DR. GOTT: Curvature of the spine runs in my family. I'm over 70 and take 1,500 mg of oyster shell calcium with vitamin D daily. Because my fingernails break all the time, a friend suggested I take KAL bone meal with vitamin D. I now take one tablet daily but am unsure of the dosage. Am I taking too much calcium and is bone meal safe? Sign me "your favorite reader."

DEAR FAVORITE READER: Bone meal with vitamin D is safe to take along with your present calcium supplement. However, because you're unsure about the dose, I suggest that you ask your doctor about this.

Most experts recommend 1,500 to 2,500 milligrams of calcium supplements daily for post-menopausal women at risk of osteoporosis. (Women during their reproductive years need less; pregnant women need much more.) Although calcium supplements are harmless, it is not a guarantee that you'll avoid spinal curvature as you age.
