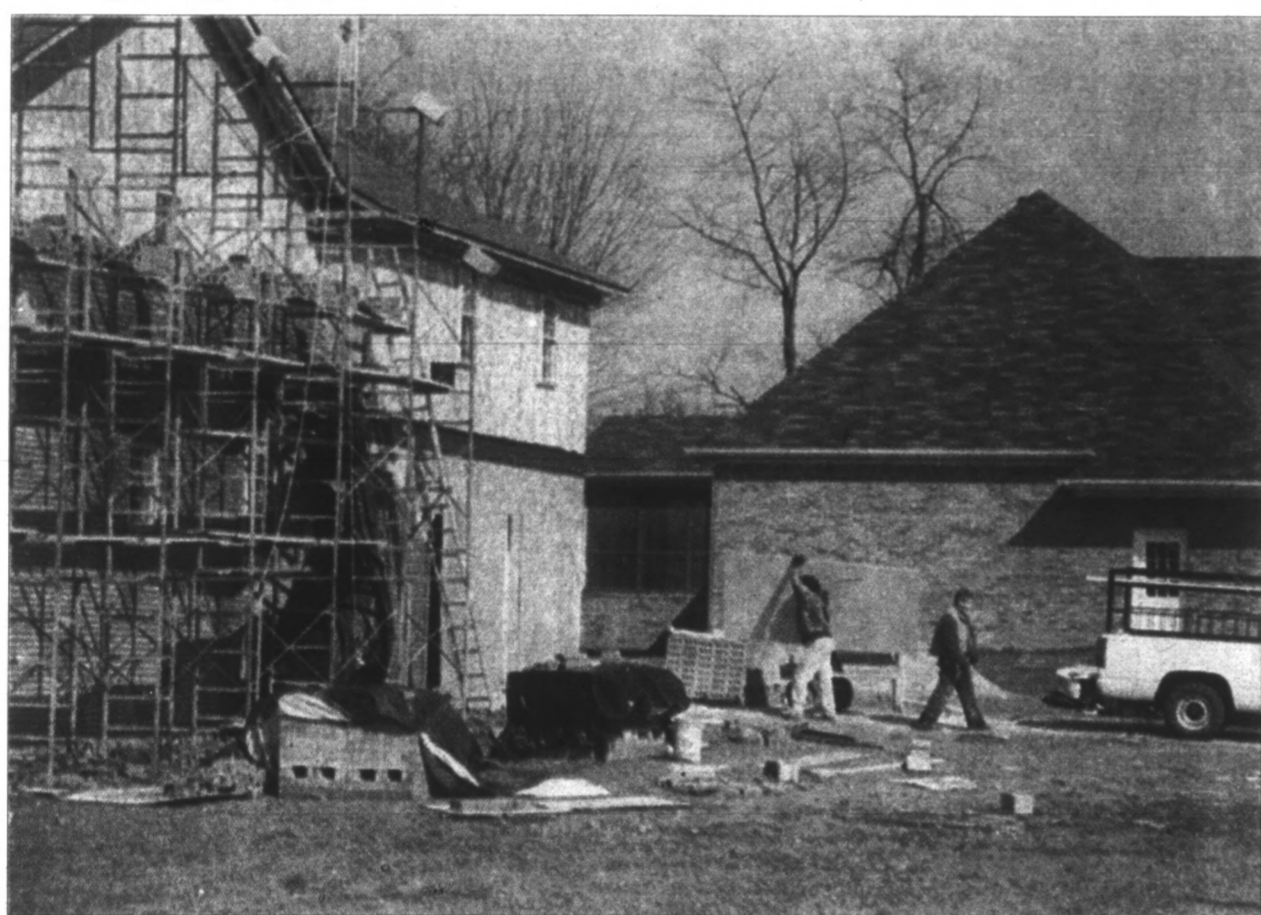

City boasts growth

While officials in other cities may have to scramble to provide services as the number of residences increase, Murray officials are confident that they can accommodate the influx into the community.

"As people move in and the population grows, we have to stay ahead," said Mayor Bill Cherry. "We have to keep the infrastructure in class 'A' shape."

In keeping with that philosophy, City Planner Don Elias said that the city is in good shape in terms of utilities.

"We built our water and sewer treatment plants so they could be expanded," Elias said.

Water plant operations began about two years ago and wastewater expansions were completed in 1993. The water plant can treat seven million gallons of water per day, compared to the former plant which could treat only five million.

"We continue to look at expansion of our utilities," Elias said. "We constructed sewer lines in 1994. As you get sewer and water lines available, people snap them up. We continue to look at what plans we need to make to support new growth."

Murray was propelled into the limelight after being designated the number one retirement spot by Rand McNally in 1987 — a designation that still draws people to the area, Elias said.

"That designation was very important to us," he

said. "Other factors regarding why people move to Murray are low interest rates and the low crime rate."

According to figures provided by Elias, from 1990 to 1994, a total of 115 construction permits for new single family residences was issued.

In comparison, from 1980 to 1984, only 35 were issued.

"In 1994, for every one home built in the city, there were three built in the county," Elias said. "We continue to hear that young couples are looking for homes that are less than \$90,000."

In response, Elias said developers are doing a variety of things to accommodate those needs.

"A number of the building permits are for one-bedroom structures, which we haven't seen very much of in the past 10 years," Elias said. "We continue to see a need for duplexes and triplexes."

Many of the single-family homes are being purchased and rented and then become multi-family dwellings," Elias said. "We haven't seen a lot of homes in the \$45,000-\$50,000 range and that is a concern of ours."

Elias pointed out that many of those seeking smaller homes are retired couples or young couples without children.

"We feel this market needs to be addressed," he said.

Currently, Elias said the majority of the residen-

Preacher's death caused by snake bite

Kentucky State Police were investigating the death of a mountain preacher who was bitten by a rattlesnake, but a scholar who worked with Kale Saylor said Thursday that authorities should back off.

"He died practicing what he believed in," said Dave Kimbrough, who studied with the 77-year-old Harlan County preacher for 10 years while working on a doctoral thesis.

Kimbrough considered Saylor a friend and mentor and called him one of the "wisest people I ever met." He was concerned that people know Saylor and other snake handlers "are not a freak show."

"My personal opinion is that I think the law should stay out of these type of things," said Kim-

brough, of Stanford, Ind. "We're only here for a short period of time. We want a religion; we want something looking for that better world."

But the death has reopened discussion of the obscure Appalachian practice, which was made illegal in Kentucky in 1942.

Saylor, of Bledsoe in Kentucky's southeastern coal field, died around 1:30 a.m. EST Wednesday at the Pineville Community Hospital, according to Clay Howard of the Mount Pleasant Funeral Home. Neither Howard nor hospital officials would release a cause of death.

Saylor was minister at a pentecostal church that bears his name at Stoney Fork, just across the line in Bell County. The incident allegedly occurred Sunday, but Trooper Johnny Collins of the state police post in Harlan said it was unclear whether it happened

during a religious ceremony.

Bell County Deputy Coroner Bill Biscaglia said his office was not notified. Collins said state police did not find out about the death until late Wednesday.

"We looked at the body and took pictures last night," he said.

Two of Saylor's sons, Kale Saylor Jr. and Stratton Saylor, declined to comment. Attempts to reach other family members were unsuccessful.

Under Kentucky law, it is illegal to handle or display any reptile in a religious ceremony. The punishment is a fine of between \$50 and \$100.

Trooper Tony Young, a spokesman at state police headquarters in Frankfort, said Thursday that the crime has no violation code and cannot easily be accessed on the agency's computer system. He said the Harlan

post knew of only two similar incidents being reported.

"It's not something that we deal with on a daily basis," he said.

Ruth Farler of Perry County tried to get authorities to crack down on the practice last year after her son, Virgil Gibson, was bitten by a snake at a Leslie County church. He spent several days in the hospital.

"It's so sad," she said when told of Saylor's death. "They'll just keep on handling them, of course. Why don't the police do something about that?"

But Collins, from the Harlan KSP post, said there is no practical way to crack down on the practice.

"Nobody complains at the time anybody's handling snakes," he said. "People don't

Sommers' trial may not include exhumation

HICKMAN, Ky. (AP) — The defense has made no decision on whether to exhume the bodies of two young girls before David Sommers is tried a second time on charges of killing them.

Investigators who testified at the original trial contended that 13-year-old Carrie VanMeter and her 12-year-old sister, Stephanie, were dead before the fire started that destroyed Sommers' home in December 1988. The prosecution also contended Sommers may have burned the house to conceal the crime.

After examining slides of tissue samples from the girls' bodies, Dr. Cyril Wecht said in a letter to Sommers' attorney, Don Muir, that he could not confirm whether the girls inhaled smoke.

However, Wecht, a forensics expert from Pittsburgh who was hired by Muir, said there is evidence the girls inhaled hot air.

"That would indicate that they were alive at the time of fire," Muir said.

McCracken County Coroner Jerry Beyer said Wecht's finding comes as no surprise.

Beyer contends that what Wecht noted can be attributed to the fact that the girls' bodies had not been embalmed and that two weeks had passed before the first exhumation.

A McCracken Circuit Court jury convicted Sommers in 1989 and sentenced him to 1,000 years in prison, but the Kentucky Supreme Court overturned the conviction and ordered a new trial. It starts April 3 in Fulton Circuit Court.

ROTC program in limbo

After more than 40 years of operation at Murray State University, the foundation of the Army ROTC Program is beginning to crumble.

Because of the low number of students completing the program, as of Sept. 30, MSU's program will be downgraded from a host school, meaning a loss of approximately \$100,000 in funding.

"The Army has decided to make us an extension center of Austin Peay," said Maj. John Harbison, chairman of the military science department. "Basically, if the Army looked and determined that the program was not cost effective, it was downsized."

MSU has been a host school since the program was founded in 1952. In fact, Harbison said that many of the people in western Kentucky graduated from the program, especially since it was mandatory for all males

until 1972.

"What really caused the problem for us was the past four to five years," Harbison said. "For 1994, we had five graduates of the program. Our quality of graduates has been high, but we have been lacking in quantity."

According to information compiled by the military science department, in 1990, the program produced 21 officers. After that, the number sharply declined to only four in 1991, four in 1992 and then increased to 11 in 1993:

"Once we become an extension center, we have to produce 10 graduates per year just to get out of hot water," Harbison said. "In order to get our host status back, we would have to have 15 graduates for three consecutive years, which would show the Army that we would be cost effective."

Harbison said one of the main problems in getting students to enter the program is that many of them have no concept of what the Army is all about.

"There is a lot of misinformation out there," he said. "Maybe there is a little of Vietnam hanging on or maybe there is the fear that you will have to go and fight."

In addition, he said that many people think of Rambo, Gomer Pyle or G.I. Joe when they hear about the Army.

"I'm trying to shift away from making the Army a

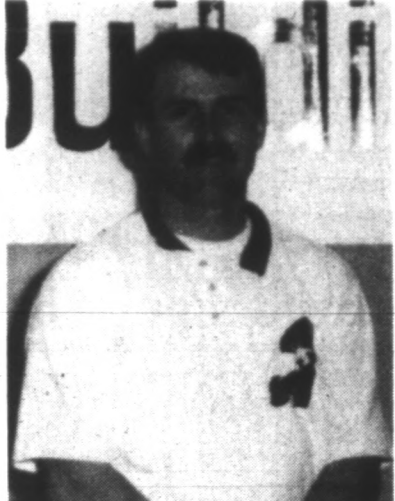

Tornado wipes out Lakers' dream ride

PTHS blitzes Calloway 69-56

Calloway County had to know that its season would come to an end somewhere, sometime. The Lakers had grand visions of that end coming in Rupp Arena, the 24,000-seat behemoth in Lexington that houses the Boys Sweet 16 state tournament. Somehow, losing at Racer Arena just wasn't part of the plan. But Calloway, which sported the best record in the eight-team First Region tournament (23-5), unexpectedly found itself finished for the season Friday night with a 69-56 loss to Paducah Tilghman in the regional semifinals, thus bringing to a close one of the most memorable seasons in

recent Laker history. "It was a good ride, but it had to come to an end," Laker coach Ron Greene said. "We just didn't want it to end tonight." Tilghman (21-10) now moves into tonight's regional championship game against Marshall County (20-11) at 7. The teams split their regular season meetings. Tilghman took the lead late in the first quarter and never lost it. The Blue Tornado ruled the boards (35-20) and held Calloway to just 40 percent shooting

from the field (23-57) and a meager 6 of 22 from three-point range. "Their athleticism showed tonight," Greene said. "We were very poised before tonight, and now wasn't the time to lay an egg. It's tough for the seniors, but we were in a tough bracket." Calloway seemed destined all night long to make a scoring run at some point, but it never came. The Lakers' final sign of life came at about the 3:30 mark when Thomas Hornbuckle canned a jumper to slice Tilghman's lead to 58-51. But by the time Calloway scored again, the game was

UK gets Gators next

ATLANTA (AP) — Rick Pitino watched his third-ranked Kentucky Wildcats get pretty sloppy toward the end of a 93-81 victory over Auburn on Friday. He wasn't upset at all. "I'm glad it happened," Pitino said. "This was great for us. If

we win by 25, then we get our butts kicked by Mississippi State or Florida." Trailing 85-67 with four minutes remaining, Auburn took advantage of mistakes by Kentucky to put together an 11-0 spurt that cut the deficit to 7 points with 1:49 left, but then the Tigers ran out of gas.

"Everything's been going our way recently," Pitino said. "You don't want to lose this time of year, but this game taught us that the game's never over." Walter McCarty had 22 points and Mark Pope 19 for the Wildcats, and both players grabbed 10 rebounds. "It was a tough game," said Pope, who had his high game since he transferred to Kentucky from Washington. "They've played good basketball, especially during the second half of the

season." The Wildcats (23-4) took control with a 17-7 run in the final four minutes of the first half to build a 12-point lead, then withstood a late rash of turnovers and an 11-0 run that drew the Tigers within 85-78 with 1:49 left. Moochie Norris led the Tigers with 20 points and Chris Davis added 17. Kentucky, which won its 37th SEC regular season title this season, will take a six-game winning streak into Saturday's semifinal

against Florida. "They can go all the way," Auburn coach Cliff Ellis said of the Wildcats. "They are well-coached, they play hard, they pull together and they create with defense. Anything can happen in the NCAA tournament or the SEC tournament, but on any given day, they are as good as any team in the country." "I thought their big men played very well," Auburn's Pat

Louisville advances past VCU

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (AP) — Virginia Commonwealth stopped Louisville's Samaki Walker but it wasn't enough to knock the Cardinals out of the Metro Conference tournament.

While Walker went scoreless, taking just one shot, guard DeJuan Wheat came through with 18 points to lead Louisville to an 84-61 victory in Freedom Hall on Friday night.

"We felt like that if we could come in here and shut down Samaki Walker, we could win the game," said Virginia Commonwealth coach Sonny Smith. "They hurt us with the press and second shots. We made turnovers at an alarming pace."

Wheat hit seven of 10 shots, including all four 3-point attempts, and handed out three assists to offset Walker's first non-scoring effort.

Second-seeded Louisville (17-13) will play No. 3 Tulane, a 73-64 winner over South Florida, in Saturday's semifinals in Freedom Hall.

"I thought we would be focused and ready to go, and we were," said Louisville coach Denny Crum.

Hogs survive Vandy scare

ATLANTA (AP) — Corey Beck's free throw with 4.2 seconds remaining gave fifth-ranked Arkansas a 73-72 comeback victory over Vanderbilt in the quarterfinals of the Southeastern Conference basketball tournament Friday.

The Commodores, who had led by 10 points in the first half and 55-46 with 10 minutes remaining, failed to get a shot off after rebounding the ball when Beck's

second free throw try missed. It was the ninth victory in a row for the defending national champions, lifting their record to 26-5. Vandy ended the season 13-15. Dwight Stewart, Arkansas' 265-pound senior with an outside touch, started the Razorback comeback with a pair of 3-point baskets from the left side, the second cutting Vandy's lead to 55-49.

Arkansas twice cut the deficit to 1 point, first on a layup by SEC Player of the Year Corliss Williamson with 5:33 to play and moments later on Scotty Thurman's deep 3-pointer with 4:57 left that made it 61-60.

Williamson led the Razorbacks with 16 points, Thurman added 13 and Stewart and Beck 11 each.

No. 15 Bulldogs fall to surprising Gators

ATLANTA (AP) — Andrew DeClercq and Greg Williams hit consecutive 3-point baskets to stop a Mississippi State comeback as Florida upset the 15th-ranked Bulldogs 80-64 in the Southeastern Conference tournament Friday night.

Florida (17-11) advances to a semifinal game against third-ranked Kentucky Saturday.

The Bulldogs (20-7) had won 10 of their previous 12 games before catching a Florida team that remembered blowing a 16-point second-half lead at Mis-

issippi State on Feb. 1 when the Bulldogs used a 48-9 run in the final 15:30 to rout the Gators 70-47.

Greg Williams led the Gators with 18 points and Dacetri Hill added 17.

Darryl Wilson scored 21 for the Bulldogs, but Erick Dampier scored only 6 before fouling out with 4:33 remaining.

The Gators led by 15 in the first half and by 12 in the second before State rallied, cutting the lead to 52-48 on a three-point play by Wilson with 8:33 to play.

already well in Tilghman's possession.
The Lakers missed eight straight shots over the next two minutes, including four threes, while the Tornado finally found its free throw shooting touch. Tilghman canned eight of 13 free throws during Calloway's dry spell, including five of six from Brandon Moore, to take the upset win.
"We're not a great free throw shooting team, but we're not a bad team there either; we hit them down the clutch," Tilghman coach Bill Chumbler said. "We were focused tonight, and I couldn't be prouder."
Brad Cleaver carried the Lakers in the first half, scoring 21 points, but Tilghman clamped down on him in the second half, allowing him only three more.
"I'd like to say we did something different, but we really didn't; we did put some special interest on him though," Chumbler said. "We knew where he was because we didn't want to let him

control the game."
Cleaver scored 12 points in the first quarter, but Tilghman's 6-6 big man, John Smith, countered with eight points of his own as the Tornado consistently worked the ball inside. Tilghman led 16-15 at the end of the first period.
The second quarter was much of the same, with Cleaver leading Calloway's charge and Tilghman dumping the ball inside time after time. Cleaver added nine more points in the second while Hornbuckle tossed in six more, but the Tornado still managed to hold a 31-30 edge on the strength of layups and offensive rebounds.
"We never could get a lead," Greene said. "We talked about getting off to a good start, but we gave up more layups in this game than we maybe gave up all season. They also had a big edge in rebounding; they killed us on the glass and got a lot of second shots."
Tilghman pulled out to a 40-32 advantage early in the third quarter on a three by Moore, but nine

seconds later, Smith went to the bench with four fouls.
But instead of letting Smith's absence break their momentum, the Tornado turned it up a notch, stretching their lead to double digits.
"We've really got six starters, so when Smith went out, we were still all right," Chumbler said. "I knew when we had three players going for a rebound, we were in good shape."
Brandon Moore turned a steal into a layup before John Moore scored twice inside on offensive rebounds, making it 48-36 Tilghman. But a free throw by Hornbuckle and a three by Cleaver, his only points of the second half, kept the Lakers within striking distance, as they trailed 48-40 heading into the fourth period.
Brandon Warfield then opened the fourth quarter with a four-point play to make it 52-40, a hole that proved too deep for the Lakers to work their way out of.
Cleaver wound up with 24 points in his final game as a Laker, while Hornbuckle, also a

senior, finished with 19.
For Tilghman, Brandon Moore led the way with 17 points while Jamal Avery added 15. Smith had 14, Warfield scored 10 and John Moore tossed in eight. The Tornado was 24 of 47 from the field and 19 of 31 at the free throw stripe.
Greene pointed to Tilghman's overall athleticism in leading to his team's off shooting night and ultimate defeat.
"They were quick and they made us take a little different arch on our shot," he said. "Brad had a great game and our overall guard play was good, but we needed to get more done inside."
"We weren't as patient tonight; if it didn't come in the first couple of passes, it didn't come at all," said Greene, who will also lose Tyler Bohannon, Jason Leet and Jay Paul Herndon to graduation. "We didn't do some of the things that got us here, but when you go from being the hunter to being the hunted, teams will play their best games against you."

Marshall tops Graves in regional semifinals, faces Tornado for title
Marshals end Graves' 2-year grip on region

For the first time in three years, the First Region will have a new boys champion.
Marshall County took advantage of several turnovers caused by its defensive pressure to down Graves County 62-47 in Friday night's semifinals, ending the Eagles' two-year hold on the First Region championship. The win was also Marshall's third triumph over Graves this season.
Marshall (20-11) now moves into tonight's regional championship game against Paducah Tilghman (21-10), which surprised Calloway County 69-56 Friday night. The title game is set to tip off at 7 p.m. at Racer Arena.
Marshall took a 9-7 lead in the

first quarter, but Graves managed to hang in, and took a 15-10 lead midway through the second quarter.
But Marshall recovered, and when Rory Brewer drilled a three-pointer just before the buzzer, he gave his team a 21-17 halftime edge.
In the third frame, Graves reclaimed the momentum, cutting Marshall's lead to 31-30, but Marshall again regrouped to take a 38-30 lead heading into the final period.
Graves got to within 38-34 early in the fourth frame, but by the five-minute mark, Marshall had gone ahead 45-36 on their way to the 15-point final margin of victory.
Jeremy Story led Marshall with 22 points while Brewer added 15 and Todd Clevidence had 11. The Marshals were 19 of 25 at the free throw stripe.
For Graves, which ended the year at 20-9, Jamie Darnell led the way with 17 points.

Changes coming into lakes

The forecast we have been looking for came Wednesday evening and many anglers made their plans for the weekend.

Highs in the 70's sounds good but don't expect the fish to be jumping in the boats just yet. The water level is climbing rapidly on Kentucky Lake and bringing in some more stained to muddy colors.

We expected the influx of water from Alabama and Tennessee to be much warmer by the time it gets here so some are disappointed at the present temperature of 48.

A few non-residents I spoke with reported finding 50 degree water that was holding fish.

Several areas which normally are good for crappie and bass were four to five degrees cooler and didn't show any fish at all.

Blood River, Cypress Creek, Jonathon Creek and Little River are some of the largest tributaries which run into the Tennessee and Cumberland rivers and they usually start producing crappie first.

Local rainfall doesn't usually affect either lake unless the elevations are down and a lot of mud flats or islands are exposed to create muddy

water. When the current is as strong as it is now the darker water passes on through quickly and leaves a deposit layer of silt on the banks.

This could help move the crawfish around in the rocks as they search for fresh food coming in and also get the bass going for a crawfish snack.

The actual food chain in our area is quite lengthy and intricate. Biology students from all parts of the U.S. come here to do research in fisheries at the Hancock Center and they encounter many things not available elsewhere.

Bass anglers are enjoying more and larger catches this week as

conditions are better. Most bass are taken on crankbaits of various shapes and sizes and colors. A few are the bandits, pocs, rapalas, bombers and rattletails. I don't want to leave out the good baits from Allen lures because they are great rattle lures with UMC hooks.

The rogue twitch bait is producing some huge bass if you have the patience to stay with it. You probably need to throw this one inside a cave or bay because of the current. Pig and craw combos are not as strong as these others but they will produce around cover better.

Crappie anglers are tossing the

multi-colored tube and curltail jigs in just about every possible fashion and many are doing very well. Minnows are still good over these same areas so you can work both if the wind isn't too bad.

Lots of the fish taken this week were in the 1 3/4 to 2 pound class and they were very healthy.

I haven't seen any evidence of the white stripes spawning yet but it shouldn't be too much longer before they get going.

One of the best areas which is fairly close to all of us is Little River. The whites are native river fish and will go upstream to spawn much like a salmon. They will strike anything white, yellow, silver or gold if it moves in front of them.

Once they drop their eggs they return to the lakes until the shad bait fish get large enough for a meal. When the young shad fry reach an inch in length the chase begins and lasts until cold weather again.

They are an important fish in our area since the tourists can usually catch a lot of them easily.

We need them all so lets keep the waters clean and free of trash. Happy Fishing!

Crappie fishermen find some success

Crappie fishermen were enjoying moderate success early this week until colder temperatures and high winds kept area fishermen off the lake. For the few that battled the colder temperatures, they still brought enough fish home to put in the freezer.

On Monday, I set out on my first fishing trip of the year to check the equipment and hopefully find out what the fish were doing before my first guiding trip later in the week.

The first hour or two produced one short crappie out of a brush pile in nine feet of water. I then decided to try some ledges with tubes and curly tails. I started fishing ledges toward the mouths of the bays. I first started casting 1/8- and 1/16-ounce jigs on some of the steeper drops I could find. This also proved to be unsuccessful

without a single bite.

I was picking up a lot of fish on my locator and decided to try vertical fishing tube jigs on the same ledge. It wasn't long before I had my first fish in the livewell and was on my way to a fish dinner.

I experimented with different depths and different colors of tubes, but there wasn't any consistency. Fish were at all depths from 10 to 20 feet and hit every color jig that I tried. This is probably why anglers are having a hard time catching their limit because the fish are scattered up and down the ledge. The fish were, however, around brush, but not all at the same depth. Some of the fish I caught were right on the bottom while others were suspended several feet above the cover. Right now it is important that when you fish these ledges you keep trying different depths.

There is no doubt that a spider rig is the way to go right now. These rigs allow the fishermen to fish four to eight poles at the same time. With this many poles in the water, fishermen can try a lot of different depths and different color tubes to see what is working best.

These rigs are usually homemade to custom-fit your boat. If you are not interested in making one, you can lay your rods down on the gunnel of your boat and it will serve about the same purpose.

One product that seems to be very beneficial are fly rods or crappie poles. They range from nine to 12 feet in length and are a light action pole. This allows the angler to fish light line and light jigs that will enable the angler to detect biting crappie. Eight-pound line is the standard size

that anglers use when fishing spider rigs. This light line allows the jig to hang straight down when fishing. This could be the single most important aspect when fishing spider rigs.

This is what I found out on Monday, the crappie only hit the jig when it was dead still in the water. If I was moving the boat too fast and the line started to swing with the boat you would not get a bite. This was the only factor I had to watch carefully in order to catch the fish.

It was obvious that other anglers were having good success at doing the same technique. Just about every time I looked at a few boats, someone had a crappie on the line. With warmer weather forecasted this weekend, fishing should steadily increase and bigger catches are just around the corner.

MSU professor studying paddlefish

What five-foot long, 100-pound fish gathers below dams to spawn and has frightened divers as it cruises by with its shark-like fins and tail? Fortunately, the paddlefish, often called the "spoonbill catfish," are toothless and strain tiny food organisms from the water. Dr. Tom Timmons, professor of biological science at Murray State University, has been awarded a Presidential Research Fellowship from the university to help him finish a study of the paddlefish.

Once abundant in the Mississippi River and its large tributary rivers, paddlefish have declined since 1900. Loss of habitat for the fish and unregulated fishing by anglers and commercial fishermen, may be the problem, Timmons said. The increase in popularity of the paddlefish came with the demand for their eggs that make a world-class caviar. When imports of Iranian sturgeon caviar stopped, intense fishing

evolved, including large-scale poaching in midwestern states, Timmons said.

"Reduced imports resulted in a rocketing of the price of caviar paid to fishermen from \$25 a pound to more than \$50 a pound during the 1980s," he said. "A ring of poachers in Missouri killed hundreds of paddlefish for their eggs and left the carcasses to spoil."

Through an elaborate 10-year study of the paddlefish in the lower Tennessee and Cumberland rivers, biologists of Murray State University's Hancock Biological Station have been working to determine the status of the paddlefish and the effects of fishing.

Murray State and the Tennessee Wildlife Resource Agency (TWRA) formed a partnership to evaluate paddlefish and determine what regulations were necessary. In 1993, for the first time ever, the TWRA closed the fishing season on

paddlefish between Feb. 16 and April 15, as part of the fish's spawning period. Results of the study found paddlefish of the Tennessee and Cumberland rivers, to live more than 21 years, not going through a period of spawning until they were between 8 to 12 years old.

Although the Tennessee and Cumberland rivers have been impounded, the paddlefish has found a favorable feeding habitat in the reservoirs. "In addition to food, the reservoirs have a sufficient length of flowing river below dams for the paddlefish's exacting spawning requirements," said Timmons. Through the cooperation of commercial net fishermen, biologists were able to gather a great amount of information from the harvested fish.

"We also began collecting paddlefish ourselves with nets," Timmons said. Throughout the last eight years, the department has caught 2,000 paddlefish, placed a plastic tag on their back, and returned them unharmed to the river.

DR. GOTT

DEAR DR. GOTT: As a teacher, I am seeing more and more children being placed on Ritalin. Parents have indicated the children are placed on this medication because they day dream or don't stay on task. Is there a testing procedure for ADD or are they prescribed Ritalin lightheartedly?

DEAR READER: No one knows the consequences of the long term use of stimulants, such as Ritalin, in children with attention deficit disorder. As a physician who works with young people, I am concerned — as are many teachers and health professionals — about the increasingly prevalent use of Ritalin and similar drugs in school children who have trouble learning and concentrating.

Unquestionably, there are children (and adults) with ADD who are immensely helped by medication. However, the diagnosis of ADD is tricky. There is no foolproof test for the disorder, so I am certain that a significant number of youngsters are being prescribed Ritalin in hopes of improving their school performance

— when they don't have ADD at all, or suffer from mild cases.

People with bona fide ADD usually exhibit impulsivity, poor learning patterns, fidgetiness, poor self-esteem, and a variety of other symptoms — all of which can be helped by Ritalin and similar medications. The cause of ADD is unknown.

Do all children with learning disabilities and short attention spans need drugs? I think not. Yet more and more practitioners are prescribing medicine for these problems. Twenty years down the road, will we be forced to deal with an entire generation of stimulant-dependent people? I hope not.

Therefore, I urge patients in my practice to take ADD seriously but to make sure that extensive performance tests have been administered and interpreted by qualified professionals before they allow their children to be put on powerful drugs that may produce undesirable side effects, such as overstimulation, insomnia and high blood pressure, to name a few.

At present, the pendulum appears to be swinging toward giving more medicine for what seem to be inconclusive indications. I hope that, in the

future, the pendulum will swing back — as the diagnosis of ADD becomes more accurate, scientific and defined.

DEAR DR. GOTT: What recommendations can you give to a patient who has been diagnosed as having a hiatal hernia with occasional internal bleeding?

DEAR READER: Where the esophagus joins the stomach, there is normally a ring of muscle that prevents the stomach from sliding up into the chest cavity. This muscular valve also stops reflux, the backwash of gastric acid into the esophagus.

In patients with hiatal hernia, this muscular ring doesn't function properly and allows the upper stomach and lower esophagus to become irritated and inflamed, sometimes leading to intestinal bleeding.

The goal of therapy is to reduce the concentration of gastric acid. Antacids often help, but most patients need stronger prescription drugs, such as Zantac or Prilosec. In some instances, surgery may be necessary to tighten the muscular ring and prevent the consequences of the hernia, especially if the weakness is pronounced or if persistent bleeding occurs.
