Patton orders racial profiling information

FRANKFORT, Ky. (AP) — State law enforcement agencies will begin collecting information about arrests, stops and searches to determine if the race of an individual is a factor under an order issued Friday by Gov. Paul Patton.

Patton said the information will be compiled to determine if "racial profiling" takes place, a practice among some law enforcement authorities to base their actions in part on the race of an individual. A bill that would have required the compilation of such information was defeated in the 2000 General Assembly session.

"Stopping or searching individuals on the basis of race is not an effective law enforcement tool nor is it a defensible strategy for public protection," Patton said in a release explaining his executive order. The information will be used by the Justice Cabinet and the state law enforcement council to craft a policy that prohibits racial profiling, Patton said. Once a state policy is adopted, local police and sheriff's offices will be encouraged to adopt the state plan or devise one of their own.

The information will also include the gender and ethnicity of those who are stopped and searched.

Seminary head hails document elimination

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (AP) — The president of the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary says a vote by trustees to eliminate a document that acknowledged the school's shift to the conservative right was a "powerfully symbolic act."

Trustees unanimously voted last week to kill the "Covenant Renewal," a seven-page document approved in 1991 that stipulated that the school would hire only "conservative evangelical scholars."

"It is a powerfully symbolic act," said seminary President R. Albert Mohler.

The adoption of the document reflected the shift in the seminary — and in the Southern Baptist Convention as a whole — toward a fundamentalist view that the Bible should be taken literally and that Christianity is the only path to salvation.

All but 14 of the 73 professors currently at the seminary have been hired since the Covenant Renewal was approved. Most of the moderate faculty resigned, some under pressure, during an emotionally wrenching period that lasted through most of the 1990s.

"I'm not saying it was a mistake" to approve the covenant at the time, Mohler said. But it is now unnecessary when "this faculty is fully committed to the full authority and inerrancy of the Scriptures."

Whitfield touts legislation

First District U.S. Rep. Ed Whitfield, R-Ky., is taking his latest legislative proposals to the people they will affect the most — the Kentucky tobacco farmer.

Whitfield was in Calloway County Friday morning at the Smotherman Farm near Lynn Grove to discuss two pieces of legislation he is proposing to help area tobacco farmers.

"I know that neither one of these initiatives is going to answer all of the problems that our farmers face, but I believe that if we're successful in implementing them at least it will be a small help," Whitfield said to the group of farmers at the meeting.

The first piece of legislation, H.R. 4344, has to do with filing of lawsuits by H-2A migrant farm workers. The new legislation would prohibit H-2A workers from filing lawsuits against farmers in courts outside the state where they were employed.

Since the Legal Services Corporation, which aided in the filings of many of the migrant workers' lawsuits, is a federally subsidized organization, Whitfield introduced a bill last year that would cut its budget by approximately \$50 million to try and discourage the number of lawsuits.

That bill was defeated on the House floor, but Whitfield said he will still try and send a message to the organization.

"It was never intended that they, through subcontractors like the Texas Legal Aid Society, would go out and solicit clients to file lawsuits just for the sake of filing lawsuits," Whitfield said.

"Furthermore, when they're getting some of their lawsuits dismissed local-

ly, then they go to Texas and they file them in federal court in Texas and our farmers have to go all the way to Texas to defend themselves," he said.

Whitfield said legal costs plus the expenses of having to try and make a defense so far from home often leads to farmers agreeing to settlements without

Patton signs controversial pension bill

FRANKFORT, Ky. (AP) — Gov. Paul Patton on Friday signed into law a bill he said earlier could potentially double legislative pensions and that he had promised to veto.

Patton said the underlying bill was too important to overturn. It creates a medical savings plan for judicial and legislative retirees who live outside Kentucky and cannot take advantage of ordinary health care plans. Patton was encouraged to sign the legislation by Chief Justice Joseph Lambert.

Patton said he tries not to meddle in the affairs of the other branches of government and legislators will have to answer to voters about the pension increase and how it came about.

Also Friday, Patton vetoed four measures, including one that would have let more schools hire the spouses of education officials and another that tried to expand legislative control over regulations.

House Bill 389 was changed late in the session to include a vague provision about legislative pensions. It appeared to add an annual cost-of-living raise to the pensions retroactive to 1998. Patton said initially the provision could double legislative pensions. It was sponsored by Republican Sen. Albert Robinson of London.

"The leadership of the Senate should have been more sensitive to this kind of backdoor attempt to increase legislative compensation without the knowledge of the people," Patton said in a statement released

Court: Attorney general should have access to records

FRANKFORT, Ky. (AP) — The attorney general's office has the right to inspect documents relating to incentives the state gives to companies in its role of protecting the state treasury, the Court of Appeals ruled Friday.

The decision is a defeat for the Economic Development Cabinet and Secretary Gene Strong, who argued they were the only ones allowed to see the records and sole determiners if companies are meeting their obligations to receive the incentives.

The state for many years has had a variety of programs to provide direct loans or, more recently, credits and other tax benefits to companies that bring or create new jobs in Kentucky. The incentives are usually tied to employment and investment promises made by the company.

In 1997, after the announcement by Alliance Research Inc. that it would close its facility in Radcliff, the attorney general's

office asked the cabinet for documents to see if Alliance was keeping up its obligations on some state incentives it had received.

The cabinet denied the request and said that, under the Kentucky Open Records Law, confidential and proprietary information provided to it by companies was exempt from public disclosure.

"The secretary maintained that he and only he can determine the accessibility of the records," the appeals court said Friday.

The cabinet also hired private attorneys to defend its policy. Spokeswoman Pamela Trautner said Friday the records of how much money has been paid to lawyers in the case will not be available until next week.

Trautner also said officials in the cabinet have not seen the ruling and were unable to comment on whether there would be an appeal.

State offices were closed for a holiday Friday afternoon.

Sex offender's return concerns neighbors

LEXINGTON, Ky. (AP) — After serving 13 years for sodomizing two young boys, Johnny May returned to his mother's house and shocked some of the neighbors.

They didn't know he had been released from prison and were upset. Things would have been different last week.

On April 11 a revised version of Megan's Law went into effect, and sheriff's deputies are no longer required to alert people that high-risk sex offenders have been released and are living nearby.

Now, the names and some photos of sex offenders are posted on an Internet site maintained by the Kentucky State Police.

Lawmakers say more people will receive notification of the release of sex offenders via the Internet. But that doesn't sit well with neighbors of May, 52, who was released from the Kentucky State Reformatory in La Grange on Sunday.

Not everyone has a computer, said one resident, Bill Faulkner. "We should have been notified of his release," he said.

"Three little boys live in that house. And there are two others living there," Faulkner said, pointing out houses on the dead-end street. Many older residents also have grandchildren who visit them often.

Federal agents seize Elian in pre-dawn raid

MIAMI (AP) — Armed federal agents seized Elian Gonzalez from the home of his Miami relatives before dawn today, firing tear gas into an angry crowd as they left the scene with the weeping 6-year-old boy.

More than 20 agents arrived at

the home shortly after 5 a.m. and used rams on the chain-link fence and on the front door. A short time later, a woman and man brought Elian out of the home and put him in a white van that drove away.

"Assassins," yelled some of the approximately 100 protesters, some

of whom climbed over the barricades in an attempt to stop the agents. The agents, wearing Immigration and Naturalization Service shirts, were armed with automatic weapons.

"The world is watching!" yelled Delfin Gonzalez, the brother of the

little boy's caretaker and great-uncle, Lazaro Gonzalez.

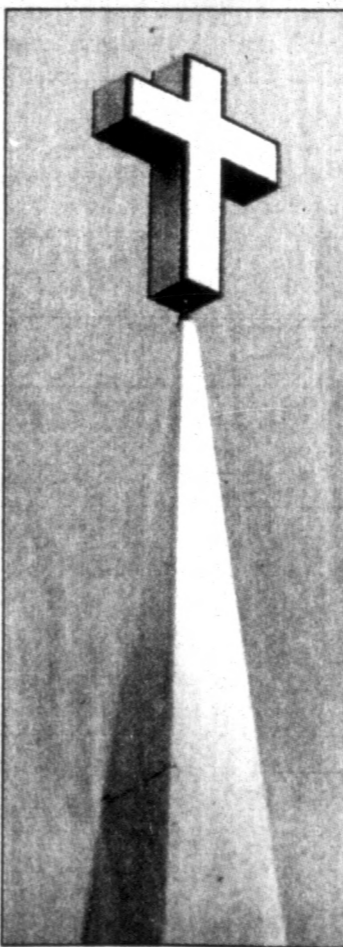
"They were animals," said Jess Garcia, a bystander. "They gassed women and children to take a defenseless child out of here. We were assaulted with no provocation"

Within an hour of the raid, the crowd in Little Havana quickly swelled to about 300.

The raid came amid reports of progress early today to immediately transfer custody of the boy from his

Miami relatives to his Cuban father. Attorney General Janet Reno was at her office early this morning engaged in an extraordinary, long-distance negotiation that began Friday afternoon.

The settlement was first proposed by civic leaders in Miami serving as intermediaries. Proposals and counterproposals flew through the night by telephone and facsimile machine between the Miami house, the Justice Department and the Washington office of the father's lawyer.

All of that ended early today. Carlos Gonzalez said he and several others tried to form a human chain in front of the door but were forced back at gunpoint.

The government and the boy's father, Juan Miguel Gonzalez, insisted that any deal contain an immediate transfer of custody of Elian to him, but the Miami relatives had defied Reno's order switching custody.

The relatives have cared for him since November, when he was

found clinging to an inner tube in the Atlantic after a boat carrying his mother and other Cubans capsized, killing her and 10 others. They and the Cuban exiles in the street do not want the boy returned to a Cuba ruled by Fidel Castro, whom they fled.

The deal under discussion called for Juan Miguel Gonzalez and Elian, Lazaro and his daughter, Marisleysis, to move to one of two foundation-owned conference centers near Washington — either Wye Plantation, a center on Maryland's Eastern shore that has been used for Mideast peace conferences, or Airlie House near Warrenton, Va., according to a government official, who spoke on condition of anonymity.

The plan called for formal custody to transfer immediately from the Miami relatives to the boy's Cuban father, but it was not clear that the relatives had accepted that, the official said.

Another sticking point was the length of the joint occupation of the compound. The intermediaries proposed that all family members stay until a court appeal is completed, in late May at the earliest. But Juan

Miguel Gonzalez faxed a counterproposal back in late evening that called for a much shorter joint stay, the official said.

Reno, Immigration Commissioner Doris Meissner and other officials waited in Reno's Justice Department office past midnight for the relatives' reply to the counterproposal.

The Miami relatives lost a U.S. District Court battle to get a political asylum hearing for Elian. An appeals court has ordered Elian to stay in this country until it hears that case, but did not bar Reno from switching custody.

Reno met for 15 minutes Friday at the Justice Department with Juan Miguel Gonzalez. During the emotional session, the father said he had a very good 25-minute telephone conversation with his son on Thursday, the government official said. He also asked Reno to give him a date certain when he would get his son back.

But afterward, Reno said she told him "that I could not commit to a particular course of action or timetable."

much of a trial. Whitfield is also attempting to remove the 10-acre lease cap placed on farmers for dark and air-cured tobacco.

"We don't have nearly as many tobacco farmers as we did when the 10-acre cap was put in place 50 years ago," Whitfield said in a press release issued Friday morning.

Whitfield has worked with the U.S. Department of Agriculture and the Western Dark-Fired Tobacco Association to draft language that would allow farmers to grow dark and air-cured types of tobacco on up to 50 percent of their farm acreage.

"I'm not sure if we're going to try to do it by legislation or

an amendment or by regulations," he said.

Whitfield said Friday that his intentions in proposing the new legislation were to try and reduce the financial burden already being placed on the American tobacco farmer by the national government.

"With everything that's been happening in the area of tobacco, it really seems that farmers have come up on the short end of the deal," he said. "Most of it was about money, and very little of it was about protecting children."

Whitfield was especially critical of the Clinton administration and the trial lawyers that have been used to handle the majority of tobacco cases over the last year.

"I, for one, think it is dangerous when a group of trial lawyers working with the government decide they are going after a par-

ticular industry," he said. "I think all industries need to be aware of the precedent this is setting."

In addition to the new legislation, Whitfield said he is looking into the salaries of migrant workers established by the U.S. Department of Labor.

"We know they're including some wage scales that are not in the tobacco industry," he said.

Migrant workers are paid \$6.39 for field work and stripping and \$7 for cutting, but farmers are also responsible for paying for their lodging, transportation and workman's compensation claims.

"Most of these guys will tell you, when you add up the bus trip, the housing and workman's comp, it adds up to closer to \$11 an hour," said Will Ed Clark, director of the Western Kentucky Dark-Fired Tobacco Growers Association.

after an inquiry by The Associated Press.

In another statement released Friday, Patton again said he agreed with the notion of increased compensation for legislators, but criticized the way it was done and said there could be political consequences.

"I do not disagree with the results of the bill but rather with the apparent effort to accomplish in a clandestine way what the legislature had refused to do in a straight

up vote on the subject with the press, the public and the members fully aware of what the issue was," Patton said.

The bill passed overwhelmingly in both chambers — 91-4 in the House and 32-6 in the Senate. Perhaps significantly, all 20 Republicans in the Senate voted for the bill, while the opponents were all Democrats like Patton.

The four items Patton vetoed covered a range of subjects. Because the General Assembly session is over, the Patton's vetoes cannot be overturned.

The legislature and governors have engaged in a long dispute over administrative regulations, the rules adopted by state agencies to implement the laws passed by the General Assembly. The courts have limited the power of the legislature to change regulations when it is not in session, but efforts to do so take place almost every session.

Patton said Senate Bill 287 would have allowed more schools to hire the spouse of a school principal.

he added.

Although they are concerned about the lack of notification, Faulkner stopped short of saying May shouldn't be able to move back home.

"No one wants to harass him,"

he said. "Everybody deserves a second chance."

Sheriff Kathy Witt said she understands the residents' concerns, but she thinks that once the public is educated on the new law, it will be more effective.

State Rep. Bob Damron, D-Nicholasville, who sponsored the

bill, said he's convinced the bill is more effective than the earlier Kentucky version.

It also brings the state in compliance with federal guidelines, preventing the loss of \$750,000 in federal funds yearly, he said.

May said his neighbors have nothing to fear from him.

Stamp to benefit breast cancer research efforts

Report: Agents held fire

ST. LOUIS (AP) — Federal agents did not fire at Branch Davidians in the 1993 siege that ended in a deadly blaze at the group's compound in Waco, Texas, according to a preliminary report from last month's simulation of the confrontation.

Vector Data Systems, the British firm that conducted the simulation, provided the written report to U.S. District Judge Walter S. Smith Jr. earlier this month.

The test was performed March 19 in Fort Hood, Texas.

Vector found that flashes produced by sunlight reflecting off debris were considerably longer in duration than flashes produced by gunfire, the St. Louis Post-Dispatch reported today, citing informed sources.

That finding would support the government's claim that similar flashes seen on a 1993 infrared tape were the result of sunlight reflecting off debris from the crumbling complex, not gunfire.

Patton signs resolution calling for posting of commandments

FRANKFORT, Ky. (AP) — Gov. Paul Patton has signed into law a resolution that calls for the Ten Commandments to be posted in public schools and for a 7-foot monument to the commandments to be returned to the Capitol grounds.

Patton had long indicated that he would sign the resolution because of the strong legislative support be-

hind it. The House adopted the resolution 77-17 and the Senate 33-2.

Patton also said his staff attorneys believe the measure to be constitutional.

Supporters of posting the Ten Commandments reacted happily to the governor's signature, while opponents warned that the resolution likely will end up in court.

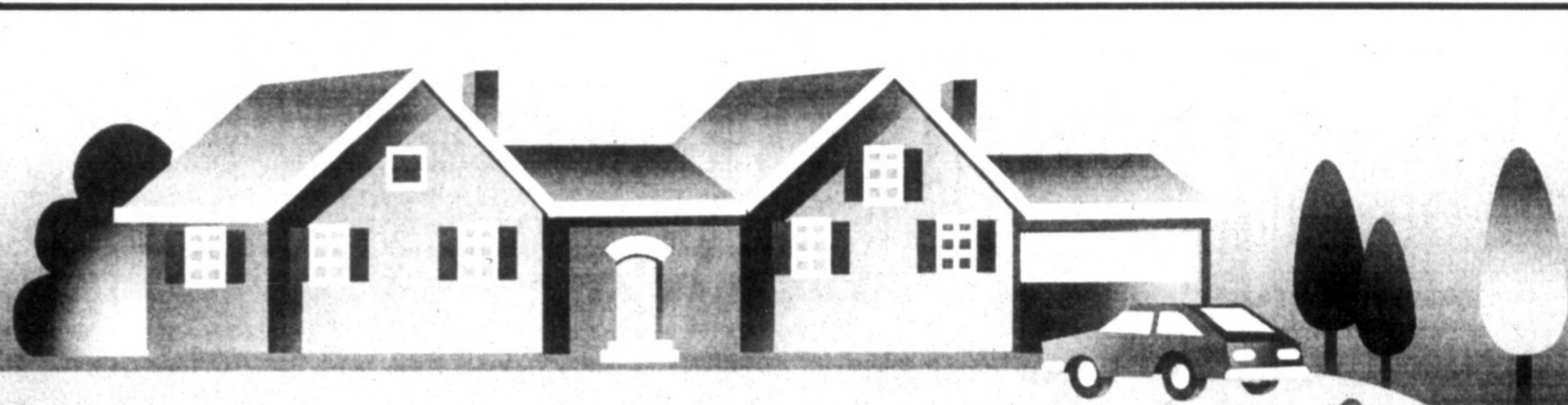

Three local investigators receive commendations

Investigators Brian Wilburn, David Wilson and Billy Ray Coursey of K.T.I. & Associates Inc., a Springfield, Mo., based private investigations firm with Kentucky offices in Murray and Eddyville, received commendations this week from two large manufacturing and distribution firms (one in Kansas City, Mo., and the other in the Purchase Area of Kentucky) and their insurance companies for their work in combating insurance fraud.

Investigators Wilburn, Wilson and Coursey were recently assigned to investigate the validity of three disability/worker's compensation claims, two in Missouri and one

in Kentucky, totaling \$3.8 million. They conducted extended surveillance on the three claimant's during the months of February, March and the first week in April, 2000. As a result of the investigation and surveillance efforts, evidence was gathered that would lead a reasonable and prudent person to conclude that the claims made were greatly exaggerated and fraudulent. All evidence gathered during the course of the investigation was turned over to the clients for their use in resolving the claims and for possible distribution to the Missouri and Kentucky Insurance Commissions' Fraud Divisions.

Manpower Inc. releases quarterly income report

Manpower Inc. [NYSE:MAN] reported that net income for the three months ended March 31 rose 24 percent to \$25.6 million, or 33 cents per diluted share, from \$20.6 million, or 26 cents per diluted share, a year earlier.

Revenues for the first quarter were up 18 percent from the year-ago period to \$2.6 billion, while Systemwide Sales rose 16 percent from last year's first quarter to \$3 billion.

Operating profit rose 37 percent to a record first-quarter \$50.5 million, reflecting these revenue gains and a companywide emphasis on efficiency and productivity improvement.

"As our first-quarter results show, our disciplined, focused growth strategy is being rewarded," Manpower President and Chief Executive Officer Jeffrey A. Joerres said. "Revenues in France grew

at 26 percent in local currency while our operating profit grew at 75 percent in local currency. In the U.K., we're combining sales gains with margin improvements and we're getting good earnings leverage from our new office investments in Europe. In the U.S., revenue growth combined with effective control of SG&A expenses contributed to continued gains in our profitability. And in other countries, notably Japan, we are starting to see economic expansion and rising demand for the workforce-management solutions Manpower provides.

"In short," Joerres said, "we have momentum in all key markets in which we operate. Our revenues and earnings are well diversified, and barring a sweeping shift in economic conditions worldwide, we expect to extend our progress in the second quarter and throughout the year."

Budget Billing available

Budget Billing, which enables consumers to pay their electric bills in equal monthly amounts throughout the year, is now available to West Kentucky Rural Electric's 29,044 active members in Graves, Marshall, Calloway, Carlisle, and Hickman counties, according to Michael Alderdice, general manager of the electric cooperative.

This type of billing enables members to know in advance the amount of their electric bills, and to better budget for timely payments.

"The Budget Billing Plan is available to all residential members in our system," Alderdice said, "Anyone desiring to participate should come into one of our offices and sign an agreement."

Budget Billing Plan agreements can be signed and completed at either the home office in Mayfield, or at West Kentucky R E C C offices in Benton or Murray, during the month of April.

According to Alderdice all consumers must have a 12-month history at their present address to participate in this program.

"The monthly budget bill," he said, "will be based on the average Kilowatt Hour use plus an adjustment amount to compensate for such factors as expected changes in consumption, wholesale power cost fluctuations, and degree-day changes."

"A review of all budget bills will be made at least once during the 12-month Budget Billing period," Alderdice said. "When circumstances make it advisable, the review will be conducted on a more frequent basis."

The 12-month standard Budget Billing period begins in May and ends the following April, and those desiring to participate this year are urged to sign an agreement before May 1, 2000.

In an effort to encourage conservation of power, the Cooperative will also reflect on the monthly bill, the charges based on the actual KWH usage that would otherwise

have constituted the bill.

Alderdice said "the member's account will be reconciled in the final month of each standard budget billing period."

"In March of each year the difference between the accumulated amount due from the actual KWH sales and the amount paid from budget bills during the same period is calculated. The difference is added to or credited from the new budget amount that starts in April," Alderdice explained. "If a credit balance results, the credit will be applied to future bills, unless the member requests a refund of such balance."

The Budget Billing agreement may be terminated at the end of any billing month by either the member or the distributor.
