## Parks to get \$50,000 for southwest site

Murray-Calloway County Parks & Recreation has been approved for a \$50,000 grant for development of a new park in southwest Murray.

Gov. Steve Beshear announced the grant Thursday along with eight other grants for developing parks or recreational facilities across the state for a total \$347,118.

The Land and Water Conservation Fund Advisory Committee funds were approved through the Department for Local Government from federal sources.

"Parks and recreational areas play a vital role in the overall health and welfare of every community in our Commonwealth," Beshear said. "They provide a place for friends and families to gather while promoting an active lifestyle. It is important that we continue to develop more outdoor resources as well as maintain the quality of our existing facilities for use by generations to come."

The grant, which must be matched with an equal amount of local funds or in-kind contributions, gives the parks department \$100,000. Parks Director Matt Martin said the funds must and will be used towards capital investments.

"Murray is going to use the money to develop a new park in the southwest area of town," Martin said. "Initial plans call for a large ADA-accessible playground, picnic pavilion and walking trail."

Martin said he applied for the grant through the City of Murray three times.

"The third time truly was the charm in this case," he said. "We want thank the governor's office for supporting our effort to provide quality parks and recreation opportunities to our citizens and to expand our parks inventory."

Plans are to use the funds to develop a park at the intersection of Doran and Wiswell roads in southwest Murray. The new park was first proposed in 2006.

City Administrator Matt Mattingly said Friday that the city would match the funds using in-kind donations through provided equipment and manpower. However the city is still negotiating for the land.

"The state felt comfortable we were going to reach an agreement with the land owner," Mattingly said.

The LWCF is a grant-matching reimbursement program for the development and maintenance of public outdoor recreation areas and facilities such as campgrounds, sports and playfields, swimming and fishing areas, boating facilities and trails. Administered by DLG, funds for the program are allocated to Kentucky by the National Park Service and the U.S. Department of Interior.

## Still no final plans on Beshear meeting here

There is still no final information on the time or location for Gov. Steve Beshear's planned town hall meeting in Murray next month.

According to Sara Charles with Beshear's Frankfort office, the town meetings are scheduled through Aug. 11. Murray's meeting is scheduled for Aug. 19.

Beshear opened his state-wide meeting tour in Virgie in eastern Kentucky Thursday night. He's scheduled similar meetings in Somerset (July 21), Winchester (July 24), Ashland (July 28), Madisonville (July 31), Shepherdsville (Aug. 5), Bowling Green (Aug. 6), Owensboro (Aug. 11), Hazard (Aug. 12), a city in northern Kentucky (Aug. 13), Henderson (Aug. 16) and Paducah (Aug. 20).

Beshear, a native of Dawson Springs in Hopkins County, will make at least two more trips to the Purchase area in the near future. He is slated to speak at the 81st Murray-Calloway County Chamber of Commerce Dinner next Friday, July 25, at the Curtis Center, then will return for the weekend festivities surrounding the annual Fancy Farm Picnic on Aug. 2 in Graves County.

## Showing His Roots

With willow as inspiration, Murray native's sculpture heading to Beijing exhibit the same time as Olympics

Not everybody can say they're an artist. And not every artist can say they have a piece of work en route to China. But Brad White, Murray native and Louisville resident, can say both.

With his Salix sculpture in the hands of UPS on its way to be part of the Chinese Biennial in Beijing, which will run concurrent with the 2008 Summer Olympics there, White reflected on the creation of the piece and how it was chosen for the display.

Salix was created in February and March of this year, he said, for a show in Louisville called "Convergence." There were 12 pieces total in the show, all created by White.

The inspiration for Salix was centered around "the idea of willow limbs and graceful shapes and how relentless a willow can be," said White. "No matter what you put them through the roots are always there."

Using that motivation, White said "this is what this piece was about."

Throughout his artistic career, White, 34, has made connections with two particular curators, Kean Jeff Baysa and Pan Xing Lei.

White was invited by the curators to choose a piece for their show, called the First International Chinese Biennial in Beijing. The show's theme is the exhibition of Chinese character spatial art, derived from hanzi, a traditional Chinese writing.

White felt that Salix would best artistically convey the structure of Chinese writing.

"I think he was looking for sculptural representation of (Chinese writing)," he said. But White said there hasn't ever been sculptural representation of Chinese brushwork.

After e-mailing the curator pictures, he "loved the shapes and forms," said White.

"(Salix) is as smooth a stroke as I've ever made," he said.

## Banks reminding customers their money's safe

Officials representing Murray's banking institutions want customers and the public to know that the bank of their choice is strong, their money is safe and all deposits up to \$100,000 are federally insured.

However the situation is different in other parts of the country. According to a report in the Los Angeles Times earlier this week, some banks in the U.S. have suffered a series of "runs" because customers were fearful about the security of their money. News that the U.S. government is stepping in to aid mortgage finance giants Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac, which together own or guarantee \$5.16 trillion in home loans, had some customers worried.

Last week, federal regulators took over IndyMac Bank of Pasadena, Calif., after the lender had collapsed under the weight of \$32 billion in bad home loans and withdrawals of up to \$100 million per day by worried depositors. The closure of IndyMac was cited as the second-largest bank to fail in U.S. history. Subsequently, many IndyMac customers wanting to withdraw funds were greeted by closed doors.

John Peck, president and CEO of Heritage Bank, said some customers have approached local managers about the situation, but that office doors are always open to customers concerned about their money.

"We have had a few customers ask those questions, which we feel like are legitimate questions," Peck said.

"Heritage Bank has been in Kentucky since 1879 and is very stable. We are considered well capitalized according to evaluations by FDIC — a very significant evaluation. We certainly encourage any customer of ours that has a question about it to come in and let us share with them."

Ronnie Gibson, president of The Murray Bank, said the business never has been — and never will get — into the business of sub-prime lending so customers have nothing to worry about. He says he's encountered questions from some concerning the bank's solvency as well as customers from other banks in Murray.

"We're in as good a shape as we've ever been," Gibson said. "I also think most people in Murray and Calloway County are educated to the point that they know their deposits are insured."

Gibson said Murray Bank's business is primarily local and centered on a local market that is very strong. "Most all our investments are government agencies. Our loans are here in Calloway County or fairly close to proximity with Calloway County. This is our general lending base and the economy in the county is very strong."

## KSP, others discuss many burglaries in the region

Investigators with the Kentucky State Police and various other law enforcement agencies met Thursday to discuss the multitude of burglaries believed to have been carried out by Mason Courtney. Last week, Mason Courtney, 27 of Fancy Farm, was arrested and charged in connection with a burglary in Ballard County.

This arrest comes after the execution of multiple search warrants in Graves County on July 8-9. These search warrants ended with the arrest of six individuals after officers located stolen property in their possession. ■ Joseph Holmes, 53 of Mayfield, was charged with receiving stolen property and possession of a handgun by a convicted felon.

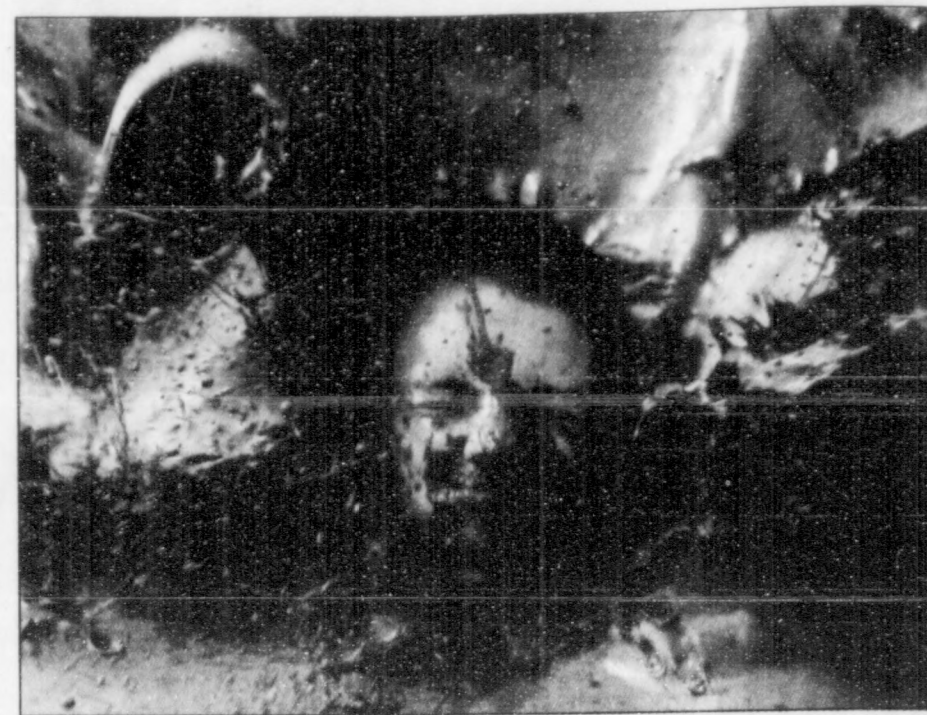
■ Debra Morfield, 51 of Wingo, was charged with receiving stolen property.

## McConnell slams Senate foe on Ky. gas taxes

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (AP) — U.S. Sen. Mitch McConnell went on the attack Friday with a TV ad slamming his Democratic challenger on gas taxes — a combustible issue for voters fuming over record-high prices.

The ad links Democrat Bruce Lunsford to a state law that has automatically raised Kentucky's gas tax, and even shows Lunsford claiming that the taxing formula gave Kentucky "a budget that could grow."

The 30-second commercial airing across Kentucky says the automatic fuel tax increases have cost residents hundreds of millions of dollars through the years.

Lunsford campaign spokeswoman Allison Haley called the ad a "smoke screen" to divert attention from McConnell's support for policies that "put us in this mess." She called McConnell an ally of big oil companies and said gas prices have risen \$2.50 per

gallon since the senator started his fourth term nearly six years ago.

"On gas prices," McConnell isn't just part of the problem, he's helped create the problem," Haley said.

McConnell, the Senate's top-ranking Republican, lived up to his reputation as a hard-hitting political tactician by delving nearly 30 years into Lunsford's past to link him with the formula triggering the gas tax increases.

"We are educating voters about Bruce Lunsford's work to increase taxes on gasoline in this state," said McConnell campaign adviser Scott Jennings.

This month, the state tax rose 1.5 cents to 21.1 cents a gallon

for gas and 18.1 cents for diesel. Consumers also pay an extra 1.4-cent-per-gallon fee for a fund to remove abandoned underground fuel tanks.

The gas tax has increased, on average, by a little more than a penny every year since 2004.

Kentuckians are paying an average \$4.06 per gallon for the regular self-serve gas, auto club AAA said Friday.

McConnell's ad says Lunsford played a key role in passing the fuel tax formula as an aide to former Gov. John Y. Brown. The gas tax goes toward the state road fund and is reset at least once a year based on the state's average wholesale price of gas. It could decrease if prices fall.

Lunsford has rallied against rising gas prices, pumping gas at filling stations as part of his "On the Job" tour of Kentucky.

McConnell's ad includes a snapshot showing Lunsford smiling as

he fills a vehicle's gas tank.

The ad was the first salvo in a potential slugfest between McConnell and Lunsford, a wealthy Louisville businessman. Both candidates have deep pockets to fill the airwaves.

McConnell's latest campaign finance filing showed him with more than \$9 million in the bank. Lunsford has been a big political spender, pouring about \$14 million of his own money into two failed runs for governor.

McConnell is pushing a boost in domestic production. The measure would allow states to seek lifting of the federal offshore drilling moratorium off their coasts, 50 miles from shore.

Being represented in China and its impact is something White said he doesn't fully understand.

"I've already seen a change locally," he said. "I've sold pieces here and there and people are aware of who I am locally, but as soon as this happened I got a commission to make a sculpture for a client I'd never heard of."

White said people are also coming to look at some of his older works.

"There's a snowball effect of getting out of the community," he said. "Putting it out there on this scale will be a new experience."

White said he has always been interested in art and won a drawing contest in the first grade.

"It was like that little bit of encouragement saw me through," he said.

And it's seen him through a lot in the almost 10 years he's been in Louisville. "It's hard," he said. "It's not like any other occupation. Paper doesn't make you an artist...the degree can only do so much to let them know you've studied a certain amount."

White said there is no way to judge somebody's level of creativity.

"It's really what you're willing to put in for very little return."

White said at the time he starts to think that he's done everything he's capable of, another opportunity is made available to him.

He was at that point when he was showing two vintage paintings in a consignment store and they were purchased to be used as props in a popular movie.

"When they were shooting 'Elizabethtown,' they came in to buy some clothes and one of the prop guys was with them," he said. The paintings were purchased and used in the L.A. apartment scene in the movie.

White said that was a boost. "Okay, now what? Here's another stepping stone laid out in front of me."

The consideration of not doing art is not an option for White.

"I don't know what effect it would have on me to just stop creating these things that are floating in my head."

The show in China will be up for a month, said White.

"Then I'm hoping (Salix-tension) sells and stays there," he said. "And if it doesn't, I hope it comes back."

Brian Anderson of his bank's financial health. "We have about \$250 billion in assets. We just announced second-quarter earnings and we've made a little over \$950 million."

Anderson said he is not aware of any customer inquiries concerning financial security at the bank, so far.

Don Leibe, president and CEO of The Bank of Cadiz, says the business is doing "extremely well" because its local focus and prime lending requirements precludes the severe financial upturns and downturns sometimes seen in the national market.

"The banking community in this area is obviously not a national deal and overall I think it is very strong," Leibe said. "We just don't anticipate any difficulties whatsoever. It is good when you don't have credit standards that get into sub-prime lending."

Some local bank managers were not to speak to the Murray Ledger & Times concerning the security of funds

as a matter of corporate policy; however spokesmen from corporate offices located in other areas did.

Dr. A.C. McGraw, media relations manager for BB&T Corporate Communications, said very few of the bank's customers across several states have asked about the safety of their funds and any fears they have had have been calmed. Regions Bank spokesman Tim Deighton could not say whether or how many customers have made inquiries concerning the bank's financial health.

In a news release this week, officials of the Community Financial Services Bank also assured customers that their deposits are safe.


"We understand that during these difficult economic times some people are concerned about the safety of the money they have in their bank savings or retirement accounts, but they shouldn't be," said CFSB President Betsy Flynn.

The federal government has insured their funds held in an FDIC-insured community bank for up to \$100,000 and \$250,000 for certain retirement accounts.

All those responding pointed out that customer deposits are federally insured by FDIC which covers each depositor's account, dollar-for-dollar, up to the insurance limit, including principal and any accrued interest.

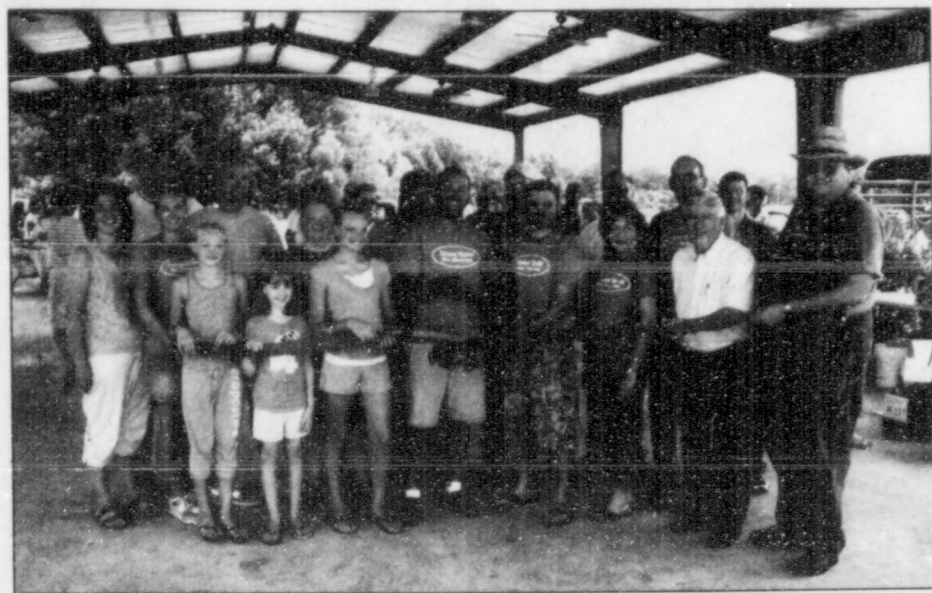

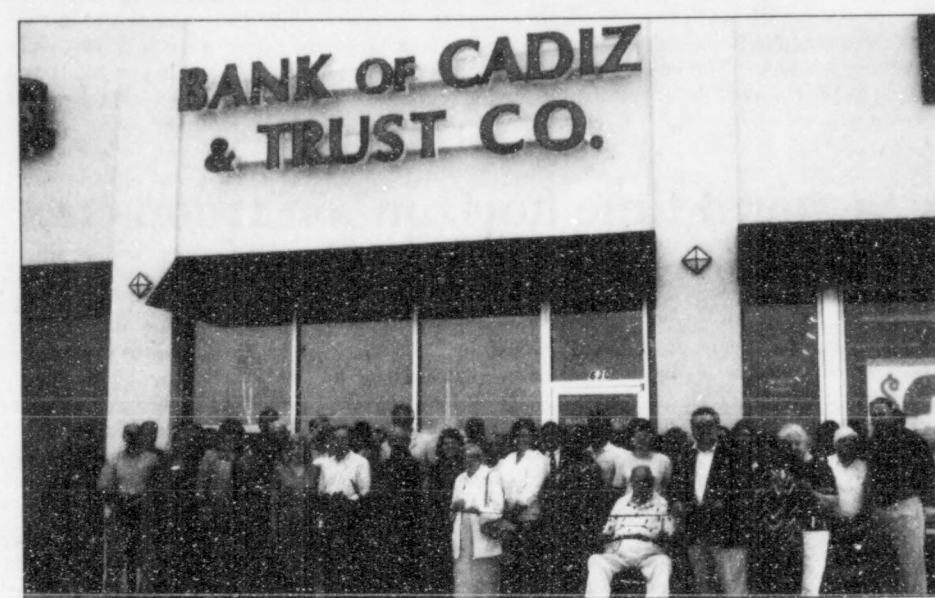

## New Baby Boomers not retiring in Kentucky

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (AP) — Many Baby Boomers aren't retiring in Kentucky.

Census data shows older workers are one of the fastest-growing segments of the state's workforce.

University of Louisville demographer Ron Crouch told the Courier-Journal the state has a growing older work force and a decline among younger workers.

U.S. Census Bureau statistics show 111 of Kentucky's 120 counties had an increase in the percentage of workers over 55 years of age.

The report covers the period from 2001 to 2004.

Kentucky Education Cabinet labor market analyst Justine Detzel said companies will be faced with large decreases not only in personnel, but in experience as older workers eventually retire.

## Murray State reps to participate in Chinese Institute initiative

Murray State University will maintain a prominent presence in China over the next year as two representatives from the university's International Center for Economic Development and Cultural Studies (ICED) leave in August for a partnership with the Institute of Vocational Technology (IVT) in Suzhou, China.

Dunn said when his credentials were submitted to IVT for a student internship, the last thing he anticipated was to be selected as a full-fledged professor. Wissam "Ak" Krutonen, ICED coordinator, agrees. Terry has shown great leadership skills and a dedication to the collegiate curriculum that made this opportunity possible."

## US, Iraq seek 'general time horizon' on troop cuts

WASHINGTON (AP) — The United States and Iraq have agreed to seek "a general time horizon" for deeper reductions in American combat troops in Iraq despite President Bush's once-inflexible opposition to talking about deadlines and timetables.

Iraqi officials, in a sign of growing confidence as violence decreases, have been pressuring the United States to agree to a specific timeline to withdraw U.S. forces. The White House said Friday that the timeframe being discussed would not be "an arbitrary date for withdrawal."

Bush and Iraqi Prime Minister Nouri al-Maliki talked about the timing issue as part of discussions over a broader security agreement to keep American troops in Iraq after a U.N. mandate expires on Dec. 31.

The White House says the two leaders, in a conversation on

Thursday, agreed that the accord should include "a general time horizon for meeting aspirational goals, such as the resumption of Iraqi security control in their cities and provinces and the further reduction of U.S. combat forces from Iraq."

Iraq has proposed requiring U.S. forces to fully withdraw five years after the Iraqis take the lead on security nationwide — though that precondition could take years to meet.

Earlier this month, Iraq's national security adviser, Mouwaffak al-Rubaie, said Baghdad would not accept any security deal unless it contains specific dates for the withdrawal of U.S.-led forces. Al-Maliki also has said he expects the pending troop deal with the United States to have some type of timetable for withdrawal.

Bush has vetoed legislation approved by the Democratic Congress setting deadlines for

American troop cutbacks.

The White House statement said the timing of further reductions would be linked to improved security conditions. In recent weeks, Iraq's government has expressed increasing confidence about its authority and the country's improved stability.

The United States has handed control of 10 of 18 provinces to Iraqi officials.

The White House tried to make a distinction between talking with Iraqis about withdrawals and attempts by Congress to force cutbacks.

"I think it's important to remember that the discussions about timeline issues previously were from Democrats in Congress who wanted to arbitrarily retreat from Iraq — without consideration for conditions on the ground," White House deputy press secretary Scott Stanzel said.

"All of the discussions that we have always had have been based on conditions on the ground and making progress in the country and we are doing just that. We are making progress on the security situation," he said. "The number of attacks has dropped dramatically in recent months."

The U.S. military buildup in Iraq that began more than 18 months ago has ended. In recent days, the 3rd Infantry Division's 2nd Brigade, the last of the five additional combat brigades sent in by Bush last year, left the country. There are still 150,000 U.S. troops in Iraq — as many as 15,000 more than before the buildup began.

Adm. Mike Mullen, chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, said on Wednesday that he is likely to recommend further troops reductions this fall because security has improved.

## Poll: McCain backers' excitement lags Obama voters

WASHINGTON (AP) — John McCain is facing an excitement deficit.

While overall interest in the presidential campaign has swelled since last fall, backers of Barack Obama are more fired up and express more loyalty to their candidate than McCain's do, a poll by The Associated Press and Yahoo News showed Friday.

In addition, individual groups backing Obama — African-Americans, Democrats and liberals — are more enthusiastic than whites, Republicans and conservatives, who are more aligned with McCain, the GOP senator from Arizona.

Obama faces hurdles of his own. The poll shows lagging fer-

vor for the Democratic senator from Illinois by supporters of his vanquished rival, Hillary Rodham Clinton. And there are lots of dispirited and undecided independents, who are expected to be pivotal on Election Day, now less than four months off.

The passion and interest shown by blocs of voters are important because they affect who will be motivated to vote. For now, the numbers favor Obama: 38 percent of his supporters say the election is exciting compared with 9 percent of McCain's. Sixty-five percent of Obama's backers say they are hopeful about the campaign, double McCain's, and the Democrat's supporters are three times likelier

to express pride. "Being African-American, you know, I do have some biases," said John Douglas, 67, of Villa Rica, Ga., an Obama supporter. He said the pride and thrill he feels about the possibility of the first black president "has been building up for my lifetime, it's been building up since the inception of our country."

Half of McCain's supporters say the race makes them frustrated, more than double Obama's backers who say so. By 2-to-1 or more, McCain backers are likelier than Obama's to say the campaign makes them bored, angry and helpless. And while 16 percent of those preferring Obama say they may change their candidate, 24 percent of McCain's say they might do the same.

"I don't feel I have a choice I can really get behind," said Carol Hall, 63, a Republican from Yorktown, Va., who prefers McCain but said he isn't conservative enough. But she doesn't trust Obama. "I think they're pitiful choices."

The AP-Yahoo News poll, conducted by Knowledge Networks, has measured the political sentiments of the same 2,000 adults since November. While 45 percent expressed a great deal or quite a bit of interest in the campaign back then, 60 percent say so now, but it's Obama supporters whose energy has grown more.

—More than twice as many Democrats as Republicans have gotten more excited about the campaign since the fall, 22 percent to 9 percent. Forty-seven percent of Republicans and 29 percent of Democrats express frustration.

—Blacks are three times likeli-

er than whites to be more excited about the election than they were last fall, 33 percent to 11 percent. They are also six times likelier to be more proud, 43 percent to 7 percent, and twice as likely to be more interested and hopeful. Right now, 44 percent of whites and just 11 percent of blacks say the election frustrates them, and whites are far likelier to say they feel angry and helpless.

—Liberals are three times likelier than conservatives to be more excited than they were and twice as likely to be more proud. Nineteen percent of conservatives feel more helpless, compared to 9 percent of liberals.

—Overall, 44 percent of Obama voters have grown more interested in the campaign since the fall, compared to 35 percent of McCain's. Currently, seven in 10 Obama backers say the campaign interests them, as do six in 10 of McCain's.

"It's exciting because it looks like we've got a winner," said Susan Gates, 55, a Democrat from Chelmsford, Mass.

All Democrats don't feel that way. Overall, 31 percent of those supporting Obama are Democrats who preferred Clinton during the party's prolonged primary battle this spring, and they are less enthused than those who have backed Obama longer.

Just 12 percent of former Clinton supporters say they are excited about the campaign, one-third the excitement level among Obama's longer-term backers. A fifth of them say the election makes them feel frustrated and helpless, and about as many say they may still change their minds, double the number of longtime Obama loyalists who say that.

## Warmer temps cause fish to stage in deeper waters

We finally received a good ground soaking rain which helped everyone. The farmers to the fishermen were all glad to see the amount received.

Kentucky and Barkley Lakes were reaching the ninety degree mark and this amount of hot water was causing the gamefish species to stage in the deeper, cooler waters. However, during the early morning hours there is still good top water activity with the bass and bluegill. The shady areas during the mornings offer some of the best activity because that is where much of the shad baitfish activity can be found.

You may find some differences but the pattern is based on the ability of the baitfish to hide in the shade and also feed on the surface. Once that shade is gone along the eastern side of both Barkley and Kentucky Lakes, the schooling baitfish move down into the depths that offer security!

Now a wide variety of lures are capable of attracting the bass which are on the move looking for something to eat.

I think the best catch of bass by one angler was the day Chad and Conner Linnville were with me and the winds were perfect! Just enough to stir the surface with a little ripple and disguise the minnows movements a bit.

The effect was perfect and I had Conner casting a shallow running crankbait which was near the size of the baitfish. I kept the guys in the shade as long as possible and the bass responded perfectly. More and more each day the shad are on the move and this provides the bass with a break-

fast they can't refuse!

Chad was using the same brand lure and did catch some really nice bass himself, one was the largest smallmouth he has caught to date!

We decided it was Conners day to be the best angler and enjoy it to the fullest! They are really great guys to fish with. You can tell from the photos that Conner is one happy young man!

I fished again with Tony Fowler and the conditions were about the same except there wasn't any current. The water mark along the banks indicated that the elevation had been lowered during the night by four inches. That isn't much and would have been the right speed of current if it had been allowed to continue all day. Any current movement activates the gamefish species into using the current to ambush their food for the day. We can still catch fish but its best to have the current for all species of gamefish.

Tony and I traveled the shady banks again and found the bass to be pretty active in the cooler water areas! This worked pretty well for us except the bass were not the big ones on the move! It is difficult sometimes to entice the larger bass into feeding after they have been feeding all night.

We traveled a bit and located bass on the move everywhere but they were slowing down on their attacks. The sun has an effect on the action some but the main reason is the slowing and stopping of the current.

There seems to be good schools of shad baitfish throughout the lake so food is not a problem. You might locate a school of bait and position your boat where you can still cast into them but not spook the school away! You will scare the entire school when you become close to them, remain at least fifteen yards away and make longer casts into them! Tony and I had a blast doing

this each place we stopped so I know it works well. Hopefully Tony can come back in the fall and we can

fish some better areas with a current stacking the bass into larger schools! Happy Fishing!

## Park Service seeks to reach changing population

HARPERS FERRY, W.Va. (AP) — She'd spent a lifetime less than an hour's drive away, but it had never crossed Joquetta Johnson's mind to visit Harpers Ferry National Historical Park. What she wondered when a friend suggested it, could a park in rural, tily-white

West Virginia hold for a black teacher from Baltimore?

More than she could have imagined.

She found herself enthralled by the place where white abolitionist John Brown tried to start a slave uprising, the place

where the Niagara Movement, forerunner of the NAACP, first met on U.S. soil. It is the home of Storer College, which began educating newly freed slaves in 1865, the 40-year-old library media specialist at Milford Mill Academy learned.

Yet Johnson, like many peo-

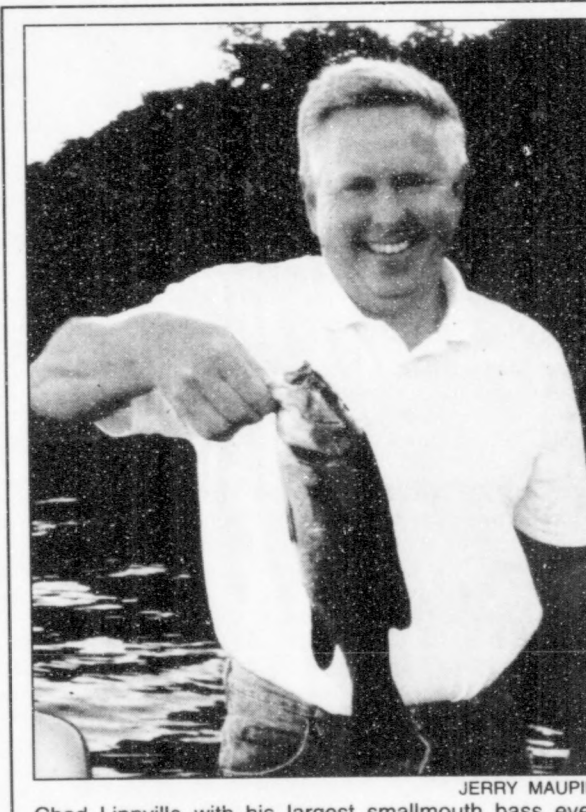
ple of color, hadn't gotten the message that the National Park Service admits it's struggling to deliver.

"We do not reflect the changing face of America," said David Barna, a park service spokesman in Washington. "The national parks are still a middle-class Caucasian visit, primarily."

The agency has been working for years to change that, an effort that is taking on a sense of urgency with the browning of America.

From Florida to California, the Park Service has brought minority children from cities to places they've never seen, hoping they will return with their parents. To make its staff more reflective, it has begun recruiting high school students for summer jobs that can be the springboard to a career.

And it looks for ways to make historical exhibits like those at Gettysburg National Military Park more relevant, refocusing on the role of slavery in the Civil War rather than battle strategy.

To obtain hunt applications, call (270) 924-2065 by July 25, 2008. Applications are also available at LBL North and South Welcome Stations, the Golden Pond Visitor Center, state fish and wildlife agency offices, and from some sporting outlets.

Applications must be postmarked or hand-delivered by Thursday, July 31. The results

of the drawing will be mailed to all quota hunt applicants by September 30.

Deer harvested on LBL are bonus deer and do not count toward statewide bag limits. New this year are changes to balance the sex ratio of the herd and allow more bucks to reach older age classes. All quota hunt permits will be either-sex permits. Also, there is an LBL-wide one (1) antlered buck limit.

Land Between The Lakes is managed by the Forest Service, U.S. Department of Agriculture, in partnership with Friends of LBL, to provide public lands outdoor recreation

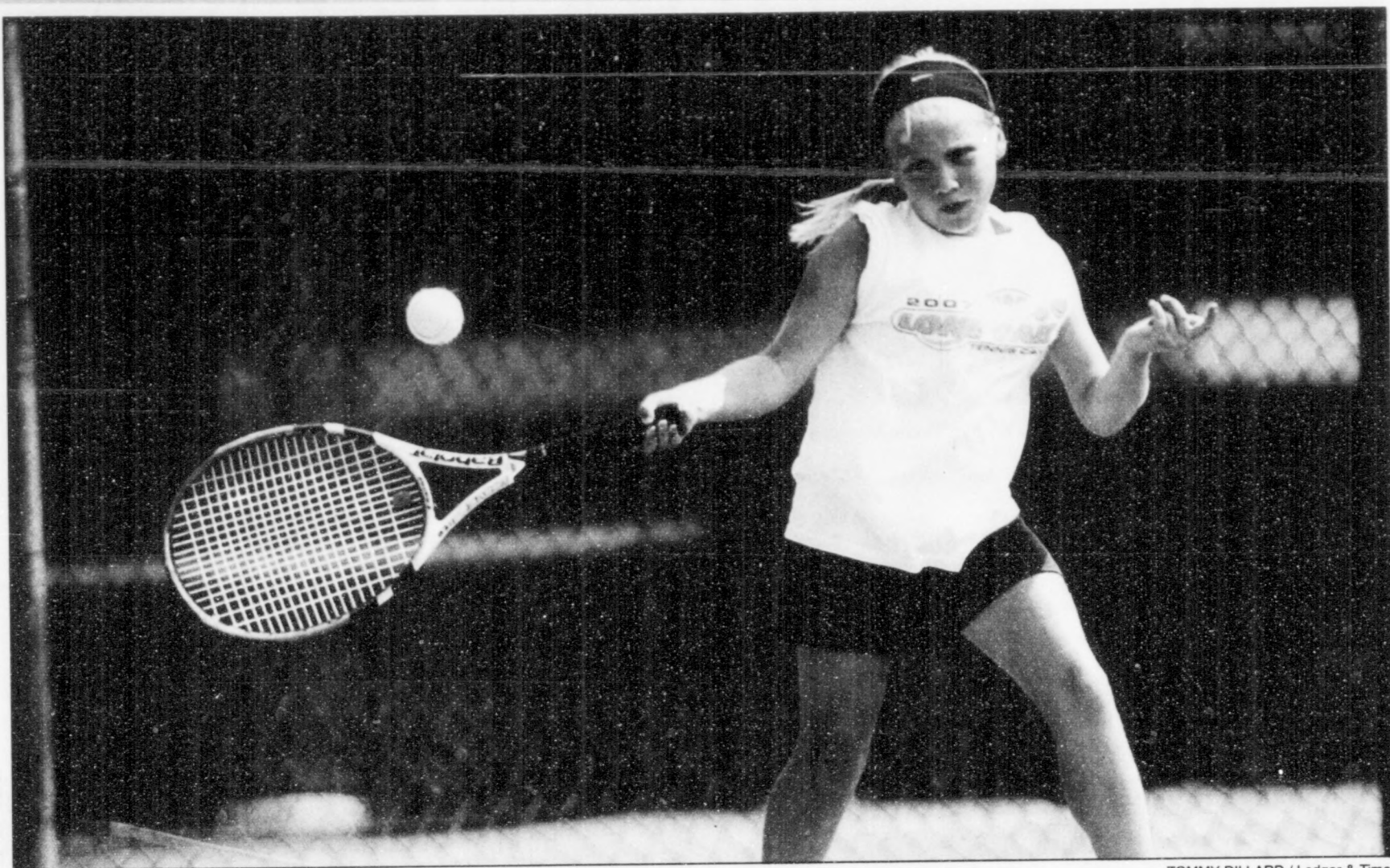

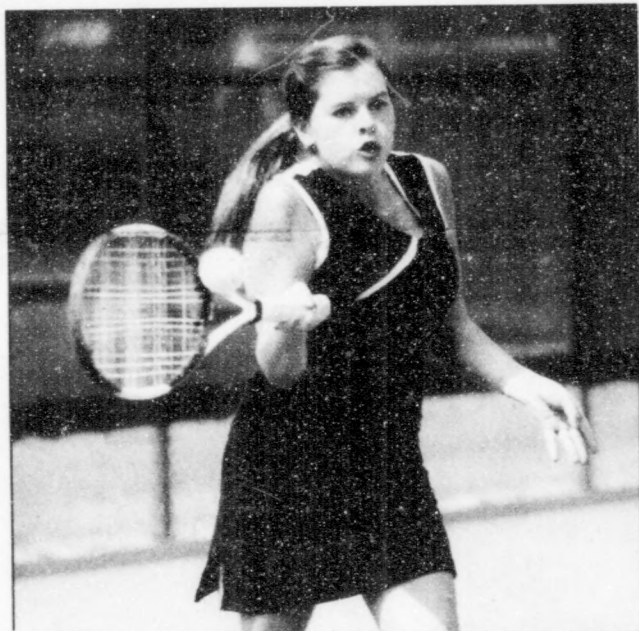

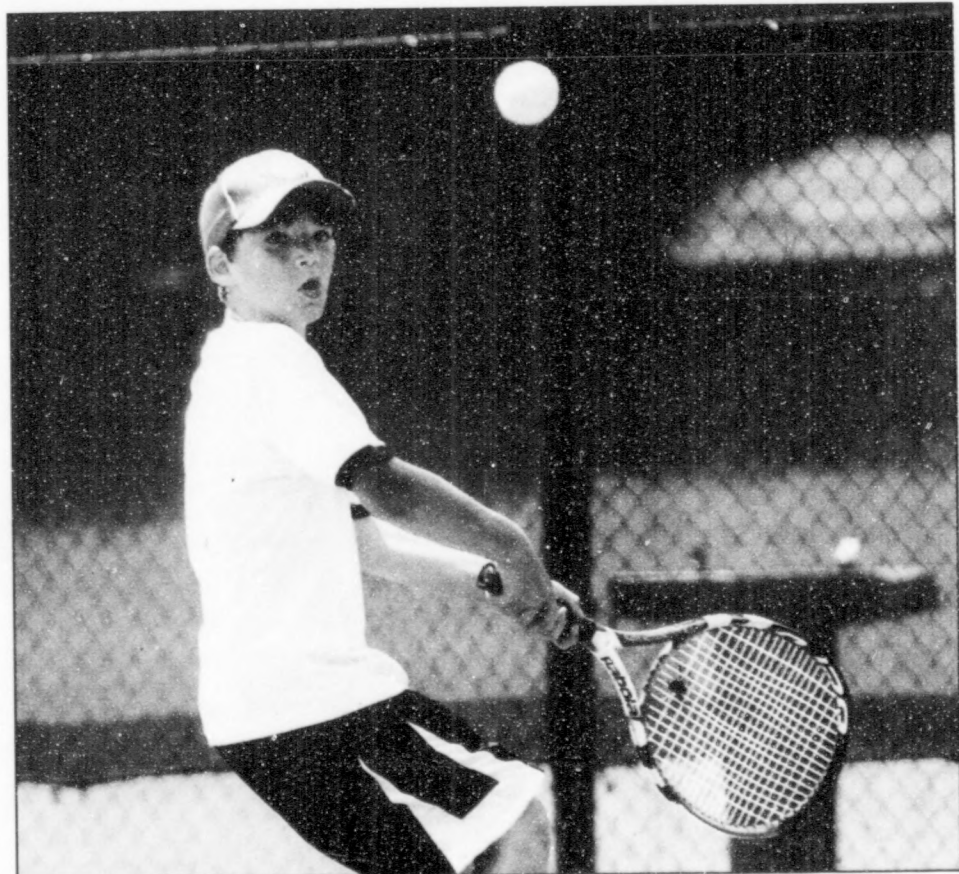

## Death of Sandlot

UNORGANIZED BASEBALL  
BECOMING NEARLY EXTINCT

OMAHA, Neb. (AP) — Sandlot baseball, a slice of American life enjoyed for decades by boys from coast to coast, appears on the verge of extinction.

Many men over 40 remember those summer days when they headed to the park or vacant lot and played ball all day — or until Mom sent word that it was time for dinner.

Nowadays, most neighborhood ball fields sit empty on summer afternoons, the idea of unsupervised play having gone the way of the rotary-dial phones kids once used to round up the fellows for a game.

The reasons for the sandlot's demise, baseball coaches and sociologists say, go back to the changing family structure, video games, parents' fear of crime, and the proliferation of organized and so-called "select" teams for more-talented kids.

Johnny Damon of the New York Yankees says the structured environment of select ball sacrifices the fun kids get from playing on their own.

"I think nowadays kids are getting so worn out playing baseball year-round that by the time they get to the high school level they're kind of tired of it, instead of just going out there and playing baseball," Damon said.

Dan Gould, director of Michigan State's Institute for the Study of Youth Sport, put it bluntly: "The end of the story is, the sandlots ain't coming back, as much as we would like them to."

The number of ballplayers in the United States has remained fairly constant throughout the

years, though studies have shown fewer youngsters from the inner city are picking up the game.

There were 16.1 million participants in 2006, according to the most recent Sporting Goods Manufacturers Association International survey. But almost 12 million of those play in organized leagues, while the remaining 4 million said their most common form of play was "casual."

"That number should be higher," association spokesman Mike May said of the sandlot players.

Don Weiskopf, a 79-year-old retired college professor from Eugene, Ore., advocates a revival of sandlot ball on his Web site, Baseball Play America.

A former player in the Cleveland Indians' organization, Weiskopf said youngsters learn the game best in an unstructured setting.

"The fundamentals of baseball must be practiced continually, even at the big league level," Weiskopf said in an e-mail.

"The lack of pickup games and sandlot ball today has hurt the development of young players."

Many kids, he said, have missed out on the simple pleasure of playing catch with a parent or sibling.

"Since they are not playing enough catch, the throwing skills of young children have diminished," Weiskopf said.

"They need to make playing catch fun and challenging. Young players need more skill-based, fun-resulting experiences, as opposed to high-pressure organized league play."

Major League Baseball's RBI program — Reviving Baseball in Inner Cities — is probably the

best-known initiative to increase interest and participation in the game. But RBI features structured league play.

Batter's Up USA is taking a more informal approach to rekindling interest in the game. The goal is to introduce youngsters to baseball and have them play in a safe and stress-free environment with limited adult involvement.

Started three years ago, Batter's Up provides equipment to city recreation departments, Boys and Girls Clubs, and after-school programs.

Batter's Up USA executive director Jess Heald of Taos, N.M., said 35 organizations in 18 states are participating.

The 74-year-old Heald, a retired bat designer for Rawlings Sporting Goods Co., said manufacturers donate much of the equipment. Contributions from benefactors help purchase additional gear.

Norman, Duval turn back  
clock at Royal Birkdale

SOUTHPORT, England (AP) — Greg Norman turned back the clock. So did David Duval. And K.J. Choi found himself in a familiar position — leading the final group of the British Open heading to the weekend.

Three weeks after marrying tennis great Chris Evert, Norman kept up the honeymoon at Royal Birkdale with his second straight par 70 on Friday, leaving him one stroke off Choi's lead.

Norman won the Open twice in his prime but never thought it was still there for the taking at age 53.

"My expectations were almost nil coming in," he said bluntly. "I hadn't played a lot of golf."

Talk about low expectations. There's no way Duval could have expected much, not after missing the cut 10 of 11 times on the PGA Tour this year.

Suddenly, he's playing like the guy who won the 2001 British Open and seemed ready to challenge Tiger Woods as the world's best player. After that, injuries and erratic play sent his career into steep decline.

Duval shot a 69 — his first round in the 60s at the British Open since he won at Royal Lytham & St. Annes — and was three shots behind Choi in a large group that included defending champion Padraig Harrington.

The Irishman wasn't even sure he could play because of his sore wrist, yet Harrington looked just fine in playing the final four holes 4 under for a 68 that gave him a chance to become Europe's first repeat winner of the British since 1906.

Choi finished with back-to-back birdies for a 67, rolling in a 20-footer at No. 18 to push his two-round total to 1-under 139. He was the only player in the field under par.

"I'm very surprised," the South Korean said.

He shouldn't be. A year ago, Choi was just two strokes off the lead at the 36-hole mark, playing in the final group Saturday with Sergio Garcia. He couldn't keep it going and tied for eighth.

With two days to go, Norman still considers himself the longest of long shots, and he's got players half his age — such as 26-year-old Camilo Villegas, who shot the best round yet with a brilliant 5-under 65 Friday — poised to challenge.

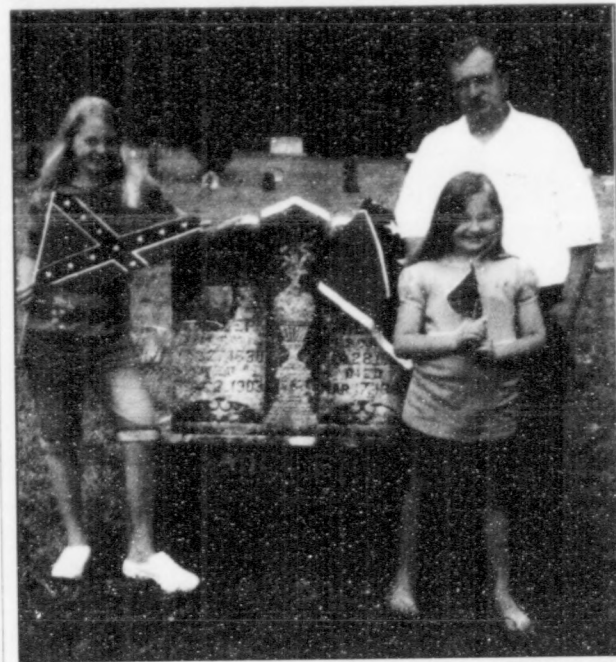

## Bloody stool has many possible causes

**DEAR DR. GOTT:** I am a 78-year-old woman in good health. Recent laboratory blood tests were normal. However, during a routine fecal occult test, blood was found in all three slides. I followed the instructions carefully,

Two and a half years ago, I had the same test for the same reason. All three endoscopic tests were negative. The two physicians who performed these tests could not give me any advice as to the source of the blood in the stool samples.

This is a worrisome problem for me. Should I seek further medical advice or simply forget about it?

**DEAR READER:** Rectal bleeding and positive fecal occult testing can result from numerous causes, with the two most common being hemorrhoids and anal fissures. A hemorrhoid is a swollen vein in the anal area. Straining during defecation or rubbing too hard with toilet tissue can cause a hemorrhoid to leak and bleed. Anal fissures are cracks in the skin around the anus that bleed, again resulting from straining or

excessive rubbing. Arthritis is often treated with aspirin or nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory medications. Excessive amounts of these medications can irritate the stomach and small intestine that can ultimately cause ulcers or lesions that can bleed.

Inflammatory bowel disease is a disorder of the digestive system without known cause. However, it is often associated with pain and bleeding, as are polyps (small growths) and cancerous tumors (malignant growths of tissue).

Diverticulosis is a weak spot in the colon that can bleed. The difference here is that this condition will produce a significant bleed rather than appear as a few drops of blood on toilet tissue.

I am sure your physicians considered all these possibilities when they ordered the extensive testing you had. You should be encouraged by the fact that the testing has remained normal. If you are on medication for a different medical condition, you might want to check with your physician to determine whether rectal bleeding is a side effect. If you use aspirin or anti-inflammatories in excess, attempt to reduce the dose.

I am sure you are worried and would like resolution of what could be a serious issue. Begin with a visit to your primary care physician who can help with testing and referrals to appropriate specialists.

You might consider a referral to a gastroenterologist. He or she could zero in on the testing done and provide the answers you require.
