1. The effect of extracorporeal membrane oxygenation on the properties of red blood cells is only minor (this thesis)
2. A higher aPTT is associated with the occurrence of hemorrhagic complications in patients on extracorporeal membrane oxygenation (this thesis)
3. When bridging to lung transplant on extracorporeal membrane oxygenation is accomplished, the outcomes seem to be comparable with the general population undergoing lung transplantation (this thesis)
4. Most of the costs associated with extracorporeal membrane oxygenation support are related to the overhead cost of ICU stay (this thesis)
5. Reported hospital costs differ mainly on indications for extracorporeal membrane oxygenation, and the way they are charged (this thesis)
6. Costs for extracorporeal membrane oxygenation are high in the following first year, but so is the quality of life (this thesis)
