Water exploitation threatens ecosystem and causes a great damage to environment. One of the causes of the water exploitation is capitalism. The movie entitled *Rango* reveals some causes and effects of water exploitation caused by capitalism inside the movie.

ABSTRAK

Eksplorasi air mengancam ekosistem dan menyebabkan kerusakan besar terhadap alam. Salah satu penyebab utama dari eksplorasi air adalah kapitalisme. Sebuah film berjudul *Rango* mengungkap beberapa sebab dan akibat dari eksplorasi air yang disebabkan oleh kapitalisme.

Untuk mendapat hasil yang tepat sesuai fokus kajian, penelitian ini menggunakan pendekatan Eccocriticism. Penelitian ini juga menggunakan konsep kapitalisme dan kajian film.

Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa eksplorasi air telah menyebabkan banyak akibat. Di dalam film *Rango*, Mayor yang menjadi antagonis utama mengeksplorasi sumber air untuk keuntungannya sendiri. Eksplorasi air menimbulkan efek buruk pada tiga aspek yakni, tanaman, hewan, dan penduduk dari Kota Dirt.
