The research aims to find out lexical and contextual meaning in the lyrics of Maroon 5 songs. This research chose five songs from Maroon 5; titled Maps, Leaving California, In Your Pocket, New Love, and Sugar. The research method used descriptive qualitative. The focus of this research is describing the context found lexical and contextual meaning theory by Mansoer Pateda to conduct this research. The step to obtain the data is collecting source of the data from Maroon 5 songs taken from the internet. After that, the writers select, read and listen the songs which contain lexical and contextual meaning the content of the songs. As a result of this research, it found 34 dates with lexical and contextual meanings. The result of this research is a complex romantic love story, or the bitter sweetness of a relationship of happiness, betrayal, struggle, and even loss.

Introduction

Semantics is the study of the organization and expression of meaning in language (Hao 2018). The study of semantics is interesting when applied to literary works such as songs, poems, and prose (Asrifan et al. 2021). According to Charles W. Kreidler, dimension includes reference and representation, connotation, meaning relation, lexical and grammatical meaning, compound words, homonyms, polysemy, lexical ambiguity, sentences and meanings include lexical and contextual meanings, and referential meanings (Sari 2020). Semantics is a branch of linguistics that focuses on meaning (Papafragou 2021). In this study, the writers examined the lexical meaning, the contextual meaning in "Semantic analysis of the song Maroon 5". The lexical meaning of words is understood as the meaning of words in the sense of the sentences in which they appear (Kriz et al. 2018). Word meaning is a topic that deals with the relationship between words and meanings (Bahodirovna n.d.). It also deals with denotation, connotation, synonyms, antonyms, antonyms, homonyms, polysemy, and figurative language (Triana et al. 2022).

A lyric is a literary expression of a person about something he has seen, heard or experienced, typically words and language (Adilah And Rahmadani 2022). Lyrics have the form of messages in the form of written words and sentences (Asrifan et al. 2021) that can be used to create a certain atmosphere and imaginary image for the listeners so that they can also create various meanings.

A song is a composite of music and lyrics (Naseri et al. 2022). Tonality and rhythm in regular speech can augment the production of musical sounds with the voice (Jiam and Limb 2020). Singers were then referred to as a singer or vocalists. Singers perform songs that can be done with or without accompaniment. Singing in a group with other musicians is a popular activity.

In this research, the writers take literary works like songs. it was" Maroon 5" song. The writers chose "Maroon 5" song because it is very interesting to examine and research in more detail. Besides that, the writers have some reasons to analyze this research. First of all, this song tells about love story. Then, the writers take five songs in one album. The five songs are about love story that have same story with the writers in the daily facts. It is the introduction for the reader and listener, that if we want to make a good relation with our partner, we must know about all of the physical, characteristic, and about inherit of family and also problem in relationship, ancounters, approaches and loses. Besides that, this song gives a lexical meaning and contextual meaning. It is also gives a message for someone who loves their partner until the end of life.

In addition, the writers chose the lyrics because the lyrics are one of the popular media plays with words. Interestingly, each word in the lyrics has some meaning variation, but this study focuses only on lexical and contextual meanings. Previous studies can be related. The first one, Contextual and Contextual Meaning Analysis in Christina Perri's Lyrics by (Vida, 2017). "Department of English, Faculty of Arts and Humanities, Sunan Ampel Surabaya State Islamic University This research focuses on lexical meaning and contextual meaning in the lyrics of Cristina Perr's song, this study uses how this descriptive and qualitative approach uses Charles W 's Theory of Meaning and Context. Books by Kreidler and Daniel Josh Parera.

Second, from (Marina & Cristina,2021) An Analysis of Lexical and Contextual Meaning in Lewis Capaldi's Song Lyrics". This research aimed to find out the lexical and contextual meanings, describing both meanings in each data, and classifying the types of context that are found in each data. There were three songs as the object of the research taken from Divinely Uninspired to a Hellish Extent's album entitled "Leaving my Love Behind, Lost on You and Hold Me While you Wait". This research used the descriptive qualitative method since the writers analyzed and interpret Lewis Capaldi's song lyrics. Mansoer Pateda's theories are used in this research. The data were found in the form of words and phrases which have lexical and contextual meaning in song lyrics.

The third is "Semantic analysis of Iwan false songs" by Nila Kurniasari (Kurniasari, 2005), thesis of the Department of English Language and Letters, Faculty of Humanities, Islamic State University of Maulana Malik Ibrahim. Research is limited to meanings and messages and hence the title of his thesis is Semantic Analysis of Iwan Imitation Songs. The issues to be discussed are: (1) what is the meaning found in the songs of Iwan Fals? (2) What is the message found in Iwan Fals songs? The goal of the study was to uncover the hidden meanings and messages that exist in Iwan Fals' songs. In this study, The writers took ten songs, randomly all of the songs by Iwan Fals from the album "In Collaboration With". Research is descriptive qualitative. During the course of the study, The writers used several books in their work to support this thesis. Based on the previous research above, the previous study and this study are different because, this study focuses on lexical meaning and contextual meaning on Maroon 5 lyrics, this study uses qualitative method. descriptive properties and used Parera's theory of lexical and contextual meanings to carry out this study.

Methodology

In carrying out this study, a descriptive qualitative approach was used. Some researchers believe and advocate that qualitative description is a viable and acceptable label for qualitative research design.

A qualitative method is a research process that results in descriptive data, both oral and written, from research objectives, whether book or social. Descriptive method was used in this study. The data source for the study was the text of the Maroon 5 lyrics.

The writers then provided a code for each data found, for example, "data 1 / LOY / S1 / 1" meaning that data 1 is found in the song Maps in the 1-line stanza 1. Finally, the writers identified and interpreted lexical and contextual meanings.

Findings

The data presentation is divided into five categories which were in accordance to the number of the songs used as the data sources of this research; this study used Maroon 5 lyrics as data. The writers chose Marron 5 albums and only used five song lyrics in the album. They are Maps, Leaving California, In Your Pocket, New Love, and Sugar. Below is the examples;

He doesn't want his affair to be found out by his girlfriend, and the proof of his affair is on the phone, so he doesn't want his girlfriend to check the phone

The fourth data is about "New Love", this lyrics story tells about a new love or a love slave, he is willing to do anything to please and win the heart of his lover. And also to prove real and sincere love and feelings that he loves her, but he also wants his lover to forgive him if he makes a mistake, because he will not calm down when his lover is angry.

There are so many terms that have the different meanings between lexical meaning and contextual meaning. Having discussed the data, the writers find that the lexical and the contextual meanings used in the lyrics of Maroon 5 Song. The lexical meaning of the terms used in the lyrics of "Maroon 5" songs describe in the lexicon or dictionary. The writers explained those as suitable as written in general dictionary. The writers want to show that the meaning of the term used in the lyrics of "Maroon 5" songs from the lexicon or general dictionary is fairly different from the meaning in the context.

The contextual meaning, on the other hand, is the terms explained the actual meaning according to the situation in which they were used.
