The May meeting of the University Senate was held at 4:05 p.m. on Thursday, May 1, 1986, in room 7, Gamble Hall. Ed Chute presided.

Mr. Hisey moved that the minutes of the April 3, 1986, meeting be approved as distributed. Ms. DeMers seconded the motion which was voted upon and carried unanimously.

4.

Mr. Nielsen presented the tentative list of Candidates for Degrees in May, 1986, and moved that the list be approved for recommendation to the State Board of Higher Education for the awarding of the degrees indicated, upon satisfactory completion of the work of the present semester. Ms. Clark seconded the motion which was voted upon and carried unanimously. (See attachment # 1.)

5.

In the absence of Chair Lynn Kubousek, Mary Wright presented the report of the Curriculum Committee. Ms. Hampsten moved to receive the report. Mr. Kinghorn seconded the motion which was voted upon and carried unanimously.

Mary Wright presented the new program in Peace Studies and said that the credit for P.S. 370, Nuclear Weapons should be changed to read, 6 credits. Ms. Hampsten moved approval of the new program in Peace Studies. Mr. Perrone seconded the motion. Discussion followed. The motion was voted upon and carried by a vote of 41 for, 4 against and 3 abstaining. (See attachment # 2.)

6.

Zena Beth McGlashan, Chair of the Faculty Research Committee, presented the committee's annual report. Mr. Akers moved to receive the report. Mr. Gurule seconded the motion which was voted upon and carried unanimously. (See attachment # 3.)

7.

The list of Senator's Committee Preferences from the Committee on Committees was presented. Mr. Akers moved to remove the name of Duane Ollerich as the Medical School representative on the Curriculum Committee, as he is not eligible to serve because of his position as administrator, and to add the name of John Martsolf. Ms. DeMers seconded the motion which was voted upon and carried by a vote of 46 for and 1 abstaining.

Mr. Chute called for a vote to break the tie between Richard Johnson and A. Hasan for membership on the Faculty Instructional Development Committee. A vote was taken and Richard Johnson was declared elected by a vote of 24 to 18 with 8 abstaining.

Mr. Chute called for a vote to break the tie between Ernest Norman and William Bolonchuk for membership on the Funding or Enrollment Emergency Committee. A vote was taken and Ernest Norman was declared elected by a vote of 28 to 12 with 9 abstaining.

Mr. Schwartz moved to amend the list by adding an X by the name of Patricia Warcup on the Honors Committee since 3 people must be elected to that committee to replace the 3 members who are going off the committee. The motion to amend was seconded, voted upon and carried by a vote of 41 for, 1 against and 4 abstaining.

Mr. Chute called for a vote to break the tie between Sharon Lambeth and Sukhvarsh Jerath for membership on the Student Academic Standards Committee. A vote was taken and Sharon Lambeth was declared elected by a vote of 30 to 12 with 6 abstaining.

Mr. Lee moved adoption of the ballot. The motion was seconded, voted upon and carried unanimously. (See attachment # 4.)

8.

F. D. Holland, Jr., Chair of the Library Committee, presented an interim report of the Library Committee. Mr. Warner moved that the report be received. The motion was seconded, voted upon and carried unanimously. (See attachment # 5.)

9.

Mr. Hamerlik moved to receive the report of the Student Policy Committee regarding the misuse of computer facilities. The motion was seconded, voted upon and carried by a vote of 44 for and 2 abstaining. Mr. Hamerlik moved to adopt the recommended policy regarding the misuse of computer facilities. Mr. O'Kelly seconded the motion which was voted upon and carried by a vote of 45 for, 1 against and 1 abstaining. (See attachment # 6.)

10.

Mr. O'Kelly, Chair of the Committee on Centennial Fund Procedures, presented the committee's report and moved that the University Senate establish a committee to be known as the UND Foundation Faculty Grants Committee with the guidelines as follows:

Membership: One faculty member from each of the centers, colleges, and schools offering baccalaureate degree curricula and the Law School

Director of Research and Program Development
(non-voting, advisory)

Director of Instructional Development
(non-voting, advisory)

Terms: Faculty--three years with approximately one-third elected each year

Directors--concurrent with office

Selection: Faculty--elected by and from the faculties of the respective centers, colleges, and schools and assume responsibilities May 1

Directors--ex officio

Functions and

- Responsibilities:
1. Receive and review faculty/staff requests for project support from unrestricted income of the UND Foundation or from income restricted as to purpose (where relevant) but not as to unit; transmit proposals with appropriate recommendations to the Vice President for Academic Affairs and the President for their recommendations and transmittal to the Executive Vice President and Board of the Foundation.
 2. Meet at least once each year with the Foundation Executive Vice President and Board (or its representatives) to discuss short-range and long-range fund-raising needs of the academic sector and establish, in preparation for these annual meetings, mechanisms for receiving and reviewing suggestions about those needs from the academic departments, the deans, and the Vice President for Academic Affairs.

The motion was seconded, voted upon and carried by a vote of 46 for and 1 abstaining.

11.

The Senate heard the first reading of a recommendation from the Senate Executive Committee to change Senate Bylaws, under Officers, the first sentence being changed to delete the words in bold face and brackets: At the first meeting following the seating of the new members of the Senate, a Chairman and Vice-Chairman shall be elected from among the elected members. They shall serve terms of one year. Nominations shall be made from the floor. **[and the balloting shall be secret.]**

The Chair announced that the vote on the Senate Bylaws Change would be held at the next regular Senate meeting.

12.

Mr. Lee presented the recommendation from the Senate Executive Committee to add the following to the Standing Rules of the Senate to change the voting procedure to conform to state law:

All votes of the Senate shall be open, public votes.

(a) All non-procedural votes shall be roll call votes, with the votes of each member present being made public at the meeting. The vote of each member present shall be recorded in the minutes. At the conclusion of the call of the roll, the Secretary shall announce the result, which shall be the official vote of the Senate on the matter unless challenged by a

Senator before the next item of business is begun. Unless the Secretary accepts the result claimed by the challenger, the roll shall be called again and the Secretary shall announce the result of the recall. The result of each roll call vote of the Senate shall be recorded in the minutes.

(b) Procedural votes, including votes on motions to receive reports, may proceed without roll call, by voice or hand according to the direction of the Chair; the Chair shall announce the result of the vote, which result shall be recorded in the minutes and, unless challenged by a Senator prior to the commencement of the next item of business, shall be the official result. Upon a challenge, the Chair may proceed to a re-vote, or may instead call a roll call vote; should the Chair call for a roll call vote, the voting shall proceed as governed under subparagraph (a), above.

He moved approval of the recommendation. The motion was seconded, voted upon and carried by a vote of 43 for, 1 against and 1 abstaining.

13.

Mr. Akers moved to adjourn. The motion was seconded, voted upon and carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 4:57 p.m.

Number of Meetings of the Committee

Twenty-two committee meetings were held during the period from September 3, 1985 to April 15, 1986.

General Activities of the Committee

The Committee reviewed and acted upon undergraduate and graduate course and program proposals. Thirty-one courses were dropped and 129 minor changes in existing courses were approved. These minor course changes were reported in the University Letter and forwarded as Agenda "B" items to the North Dakota Board of Higher Education, according to defined procedures. In addition, the Committee approved changes in program requirements and the change in title of four programs. These items were also listed in the University Letter.

The 82 new course proposals approved by the Committee were presented to the Senate for action. After approval by the Senate, the courses were sent to the North Dakota Board of Higher Education according to their prescribed procedures, at their November and April meetings. Three new program proposals approved by the Committee were presented for Senate action. These programs have been approved by the Senate.

A manual containing revised UND and State Board curriculum forms and the procedures for curriculum change requests was prepared under the direction of Don Wermers, the former Registrar. The manual was distributed to all departments chairs and deans in mid-July, 1985.

The committee reviewed and provided input regarding the Undergraduate Curriculum Evaluation draft document which is being prepared through the Office of the Vice President for Academic Affairs. Committee members also served with several deans on an ad hoc committee of Double Majors/Double Degrees, which presented a proposal to the Office of the Vice President for Academic Affairs this spring.

Re: INTERIM REPORT

A matter of some importance was recently considered and endorsed by the University Library Committee, which is hereby presented as an informational interim report.

The Committee has urged that the Director enter into detailed planning discussions, with various University officials, relative to creating a computerized system integrating public access catalog, circulation, and various other library functions online, and particularly to pursue the notion of a locally-based system.

The system would be inaugurated and maintained with investment income from a portion of the Chester Fritz bequest together, it is hoped, with foundation and appropriated funds.

The understanding of the Committee is that the proceeds from the first one million dollars received from the bequest is dedicated to collection enhancement, interlibrary access to materials, and the like; whereas, earnings on amounts received in excess of the first one million dollars could be committed, to the extent necessary, to the automation effort. This approach is within the policy guidelines adopted by the Library Committee and reported to the Senate in last year's Annual Report, which provide that income from the endowment be used for collection enhancement and automation.

MISUSE OF COMPUTER FACILITIES

Individuals who use the University of North Dakota computer facilities assume the responsibility of seeing that these resources are used in an appropriate manner. Misuse of computer facilities is considered a violation of University policy and regulations and may also be a violation of law if data of other computer users are disturbed or the privacy rights of individuals are violated.

Users are expected to abide by the following rules:

1. Files, signons, usernames, passwords, and computer output belonging to an individual or to the institution are considered to be personal property. Users will not examine, change, or use another person's or institutional files, output, or usernames for which they do not have explicit authorization. Attempts to circumvent the protective mechanisms in the computer system will be considered violations of the right to privacy.
2. Users will not deliberately attempt to degrade system performance or capability. Loopholes in the computer systems, knowledge, or special passwords will not be used to damage the system, to change information in the system and files, to take resources from another user, or to violate privacy rights.
3. No obscene or offensive material will be entered into the computer or sent through the institutional electronic mail system.
4. Unauthorized copies of copyrighted material will not be created, distributed, or knowingly utilized.
5. The University's computers will not be used for commercial purposes without written authorization of the Director of the Computer Center.
