Dear Sir:

On request of the Advisory Committee of the Turtle Mountain Band of Indians, I am sending you a copy of a resolution adopted December 23, which is self explanatory.

We received surplus potatoes, dried fruit and other commodities last year and appreciated your efforts in assisting us in securing this surplus food. We are again faced with general relief needs this winter and with our limited funds it is necessary to use the surplus foods to supplement our allowances. The commodities are issued according to instructions received.

The Indian people appreciate your efforts in securing the surplus food commodities for them.

I wish to thank you for your personal interest and cooperation in the past.
