

As far as musicals go, *Song & Dance* is probably one of the most difficult shows for a company to produce. You need a powerhouse singer/actress for the first act, you need a core of dancer/actors versed in numerous dance styles (jazz, tap, modern, musical theatre), you need musicians of the highest caliber and an artistic and design staff of equal caliber. To our relief, we found who we needed in all of those areas!

It's also difficult because audiences either know and love the show, or have never heard of it. I've found very little middle-ground on this idea. Those who haven't seen or heard it tend to be stunned by the sheer "unexpectedness" of the style of the show and its performances. Those who have seen it, or heard the recordings, have a certain expectation of what they're going to see.

Those who have seen it know that Act One (the "Song" act) has traditionally been performed by the singer/actress playing the character of "Emma"...alone onstage for the entire act! When asked to direct the show, I asked the question, "Why is Act One always done that way?" Through research I found the reason. Simply, it was considered very untraditional at the time (early-mid 1980s). It was an attempt at being on the cutting edge, and at the time, it succeeded! However, every production since the original has done it that way, making the untraditional route the traditional way to perform it. Therefore, I decided to put other performers in the Act. "Emma" is still the only person to sing or say anything, and it is still very much "her act," but I believe the audience benefits from being able to put faces with character names and will enjoy seeing interactions and relationships take place.

The challenges for Act Two (the "Dance" act) were entirely different. The biggest was this: although we knew the act was supposed to tell the story of "Joe," one of Emma's boyfriends from Act One, there is no script provided for Act Two. Oh, sure, you get the musical score, but considering nothing is spoken or sung in the act, it's just the music with no story. So, our choreographer, Michael J. Walline, and I sat down and conceived the entire storyline for the act before rehearsals began. Then, Michael took the ideas and came up with choreography and movement unlike anything you've ever seen on the MusicalFare stage. This production truly cements his reputation as one of the finest choreographers in the region.

Hopefully, Michael & I, along with our actors, designers, musicians and our sublimely talented music director, Michael G. Hake, have put together a show with something for everyone, whether it's song, dance...or both!
